

Members of the NDHSAA Board of Directors:

In addition to my regular season, full 14 event state qualifier on January 11, and the Region I Competition on April 5, I plan to host another tournament at North Sargent on March 1. This tournament will be run as a state qualifier for the ten NDHSAA events that I plan to offer, but no draw events will be held in an effort to make it a quick and easy tournament for me to host, and to provide a closer venue than Grand Forks for the schools in our area. I have hosted a 'no-draw' tournament in the past after getting the go-ahead from Mr. Bubach.

The reason for my letter is to request approval to offer an additional non-qualifying event on March 1. Keep in mind that this is not an event that I am trying to get added as a state-qualifying/state-wide event, it is simply for fun. I would like to offer a unique competitive opportunity for those interested - a 4 person interp. Rules would basically be the same as those for dramatic duo (no looking at or touching partner unless during the intro) and each team would use the same piece. There would be one round with three judges, and two sections (one serious and one humorous). I would provide the scripts the Monday prior to competition for those that register. Coaches/teams could cut the piece as they see fit. The 4 person interp would not count towards a student's maximum number of entries for the regular events, but there would be a limit of one entry per school per section of 4-person interp. The participation fee would be \$10 per team entered and medals would be given for 1st place.

Please let me know if this is something that could be allowed for this casual and fun tournament to be held on March 1. If approved and the kids enjoy it, I would like to offer it in the future as well - just for fun! My administrator is aware of this request and has also signed below. Thank you for your consideration.
