Mr. Hall,

The Roosevelt School Board, at it's February meeting passed a motion for the dissolution of it's extracurricular activities co-op with the Elgin School District for:

Basketball (Girls')

Volleyball

Drama (One act Play)

Music

Speech

Elgin passed a motion, with a unanimous vote, to dissolve our academic co-op, effective the end of this school year. That has put us in a position to form an academic co-op with the Flasher School District. This would entail having our 9-12 students attending the Flasher School and our K-8 students remaining in the Roosevelt School for their education.

For these reasons, The Roosevelt School Board has passed a motion to request that the NDHSAA Board waive the eligibility rule for our 7-12 students and allow our 9-12 students to become immediately eligible at Flasher High School, 7-122 coop applications are submitted to provide an opportunity for our 7-8 grade students. Due to timelines, we request applicable late coop fees be waived.
