To the NDHSAA board members,

I am writing this letter on behalf of the Emergency Coop for Wing to join Washburn and Wilton Coop for the football coop. The Emergency Coop will give the students in grades 9-12 the opportunity to play football. Currently, if you grant us this great opportunity it would allow two sophomore boys to play football again. The two boys played Jr. High football and were not able to play as freshman. Both students have expressed they would like to play football again but are concerned that if they have to sit another season they would be too far behind.
