Re: Midway/Minto Coop for 7/8th grade Boys Basketball

NDHSAA Board,

The Midway and Minto districts have cooped for HS basketball since the 2005-06 season. Until now, we each able to maintain our own 7/8th grade basketball teams which we considered to be in the best interest of these young students. We had intended to have separate teams again this year but, unfortunately, several families have moved away and the migrant students do not stay through the winter so numbers do not allow for Midway to have a 7/8 boys basketball team. Our current numbers are:

Grade 8: 4 boys/2 players

Grade 7: 4 boys/1 player

Grade 6: 3 boys/1player

Total= 11 boys/4 players

We've met with the boys on several occasions and this is all that will go out. It's not practical to expect all boys to go out for a team so, even if we got two-thirds of the boys to play, we would still have only 7 players and some of those would be 6th graders. This is barely enough players which to allow for injuries, illness, ineligibilities or other absences. But, the fact is, that we have only 4 boys who are interested in playing. For this reason, we are asking that the NDHSAA board approve a 7/8th grade coop for Midway and Minto boys basketball. Minto currently has 10 players so the extra 3 from Midway will not present a problem. In fact, it could increase playing

time for all players because they could do some 7^{th} grade games and 8^{th} grade games. This coop will not include any 6^{th} grade boys. That's OK because they have their own season.

We have been told that late requests have often be rejected. We understand this when it involves high school teams that could have an impact on regional and state results. This doesn't change anything on the high school level. This coop merely allows a very small group of young students who are in their formative years to develop their basketball skills in preparation for when they get to high school. Without this coop, these students will not have a team this year and might decide to not play high school basketball at all when they get to that level. That's would be bad for these students and it's bad for interscholastic participation.

Midway will pay the \$500 late fee, if necessary. We hope you see this as a situation in which interscholastic participation is enhanced in a manner that is not harmful to anybody. Thank you for considering this request.
