Dear Mr. Fetsch,

This letter of appeal addresses the decision reached by the NDHSAA Executive Board. Mandaree School has received the NDHSAA letter dated April 3, 2017. Specifically, the penalty for violating Part II, Article III, Section VII of the NDHSAA Constitution and By-Laws for unsportsmanlike behavior.

At the April 11, 2017, Regular School Board meeting the School Board made a motion to appeal the decision reached by the Executive Board. This appeal is based on the breakdown of penalties received by Mandaree School basketball players which shows an unfair number of penalties being called on our student athletes. This unfair treatment has appeared to trigger fan behavior that has been deemed unsportsmanlike. This data is attached for your review.

The Mandaree School board requests that the penalty be reversed based on the unfair number of penalties.

Superintendent Bluestone:

The Executive Board of the NDHSAA met on April 3, 2017 to establish penalty against Mandaree High School for violation of Part II, Article III, Section VII of the NDHSAA Constitution and By-Law's, which states: "High Standards of courtesy, fair-dealing and sportsmanship must be featured in all Association contests. The Board may rate schools or students in these respects, recognizing high attainment and penalizing low".

The Executive Board determined that the following penalties are to be administered:

- 1. The administration of Mandaree High School shall submit a plan of action to the NDHSAA Executive Director prior to September 21, 2017 that details the following:
 - a. Protocol to address safety of game officials before, during, and after contests.
 - b. A preseason parent meeting with all basketball parents that includes detailed expectations for spectators throughout the basketball season.
 - c. Spectator expectations that shall be printed in game programs for all home contests.
 - d. A sportsmanship code that shall be read by the public address announcer prior to all home contests.
 - e. The hiring of additional security at all home contests is strongly encouraged.
- 2. The administration of Mandaree High School shall submit a report to the NDHSAA Executive Director prior to March 15, 2018 that details a summary of the implementation of the 2017-18 action plan. A carbon copy of this report shall be sent to the Williston Basin Official Association.

- 3. Mandaree High School is placed on probation through the 2018-19 academic year.
- 4. Any subsequent violation of NDHSAA By-Law's or regulations prior to June 30, 2019 may result in a monetary fine, loss of home games during future basketball seasons, and/or suspension from NDHSAA membership for a period of time to be determined by the Executive Board.

If you wish to appeal this penalty to the NDHSAA Board of Directors you may do so within thirty days in accordance with Part II, Article VI, Section XIV of the NDHSAA Constitution and By-Law's.

Dear Mr. Fetsch,

Mandaree School has received the NDHSAA letter of findings dated February 17, 2017. Specifically, that on February 3, 2017 and February 10, 2017 the fans at two home basketball events exhibited unsportsmanlike behavior.

This letter of appeal is to provide background information to the Executive Board for use in its decision making.

After the February 3, 2017 basketball game I received several telephone calls regarding the officials and questionable calls made during the game which the fans had issue with. Mandaree School also received an email from Larry Grondahl, Williston Basin BB Official Association, asking for intervention with fans because of the behavior exhibited at the game. Michael Jensen, Mandaree Athletic Director, and I determined that letters home regarding sportsmanship and a meeting with student athletes and coaches would be a beginning step with additional steps to be taken over time to increase positive sportsmanship.

At the February 10, 2017 basketball game fan behavior escalated due to calls made by officials. There was also an allegation that one of the officials called one of the Mandaree players "an asshole." This inflamed and escalated the situation. The events at the game resulted in another email from Larry Grondahl stating that Mandaree would have to find their own officials in the future.

This letter of appeal by the Mandaree School Board would ask that the NDHSAA Executive Board direct game officials to follow the same guidelines to provide fair and impartial officiating at all sporting events conducted at Mandaree School. The Mandaree School Board feels that historically there has been prejudicial officiating that has led to the fans present at home basketball games to become verbal and results in complaints to the Superintendent and Athletic Director by parents. The fans at the February 3, 2017 were reacting to several calls by the officials. At the February 10, 2017 game the fans were also reacting to the comments allegedly made by one official in particular towards a Mandaree player. While fouls may not be a sole indicator of what is going on during a game, during the Beach game there were 26 fouls called on Mandaree and only 10 against Beach.

Superintendent Bluestone:

I have completed an investigation into whether or not unsportsmanlike behavior was exhibited during Mandaree Public School home basketball contests on February 3, 2017 and February 10, 2017.

Upon weighing all information, it is my opinion that your fans crossed the line and exhibited unacceptable behavior directed at game officials. According to the NDHSAA Constitution and By-Laws Part II, Article III, Section VII: "High Standards of courtesy, fair-dealing and sportsmanship must be featured in all Association contests. The Board may rate schools or students in these respects, recognizing high attainment and penalizing low".

NDHSAA Constitution and By-Laws, Part Two, Article VI, Sections IX and X state:

SECTION IX: If the Executive Secretary determines a violation has occurred, the Executive Board shall set the penalty and the Executive Secretary shall provide written notice of the determination to the party charged with the violation, including a statement of the following right to appeal:

- a. If the violation has not been admitted, the Executive Secretary's determination that a violation has occurred may be appealed to the Executive Board (see Section X);
- b. If the violation has not been admitted, the Executive Board's written decision to the party (see Section VIII) may be appealed to the Board of Directors with reference to the determination of the violation or the penalty imposed or both (see Section XIV); or
- c. If the violation has been admitted, the Executive Board's determination as to the penalty may be appealed directly to the Board of Directors; (see Section XIV).

SECTION X: A written notice of appeal by a party to the Executive Board must be postmarked or received by the Executive Secretary within fourteen (14) days after notice of the decision is postmarked or personally delivered. The notice of appeal must be addressed to the Executive Secretary.

As per Due Process Procedure you have 14 days to appeal my decision in writing. If I do not hear from you before that time, I will request the Executive Board to review and set penalty at their March 7, 2017 conference call meeting.
