In the space provided, please list the reasons for requesting this coop application:

It has been difficult creating a full roster in our girls' soccer program since our split with WF Sheyenne High School. We are continually recruiting our hallways and seem to have 12-16 students participating in girls' soccer each season who have never played competitive soccer before and most of these students are not able to commit to playing every day due to social-economic issues and responsibilities at home. The coop with Kindred has as assisted with increasing our numbers of student/athletes who can be at practice and games everyday and has given the young ladies in Kindred the opportunity to play soccer. Northern Cass High School is now in the same situation as Kindred was with a growing number of students who want the opportunity to play soccer at the high school level.

Is the reason for this application to improve competition levels or make participation available. Explain:

WFHS roster continues to have over 1/3 our roster consisting of students who have never played competitive soccer before. There is concern on their safety playing competitive soccer and feel the coop allows WFHS to place students on a team that gives them the best chance to participate at a skill level equal to their ability. We also feel the opportunity for the student/athletes at Northern Cass High School to participate in a high school soccer program will benefit their high school experience as it has for the student/athletes from Kindred High School the past 3 years.

## Other information that be useful for the NDHSAA Board of Directors in reaching a decision:

We have a large number of ELL students at WFHS who cannot participate or not commit to playing every day due to family commitments and religious circumstances. We feel moving forward it will be very difficult to sustain the numbers of participants to put our student/athletes in a safe playing environment that is equal to their experience and skill level. The coop with Northern Cass High School will allow for us to move forward with a program and provide an opportunity for the female student/athletes at WFHS, Kindred HS and Northern Cass HS to participate in the game of soccer.
