There is currently not a cooperative agreement in place for the New-Salem –Almont student to be able to participate in Boys Ice Hockey at the High School level. Aside from this information, the student has been participating in the Hazen-Beulah youth hockey program for the last six years. If the New Salem-Almont school district were to establish a coop agreement with closer schools such as Mandan or Bismarck, it seems unlikely the student would have an advantage to play due to sheer numbers.
