Thank you for your time and efforts on behalf of the student athletes of North Dakota. I am writing this letter as application for membership for Capstone Classical Academy in the NDHSAA. Capstone Classical Academy opened in August of 2022 and is an NDDPI-approved nonpublic school in North Dakota.

Capstone currently offers grades Pre-K through 7 for 2023-24 and will be adding one grade per year moving forward, with our first graduating class in May of 2029. We are hiring our first AD this month, and he should begin his work in April. In the meantime, I need to be able to set him up to accomplish building next year's program.
