

NDHSAA Artificial Intelligence Sanctioned Competition Guidance:

Generative Artificial Intelligence (AI) engines including but not limited to ChatGPT may be used as tools for practice prior to contests in sanctioned Debate, Speech, and Student Congress activities.

- i. AI is not a database and may not be cited; however, it may be used to locate and vet potential articles or other sources relevant to each competitive activity.
- ii. AI is a tool that may help competitors/coaches develop talking points or main questions; however, competitors must develop the language surrounding these points on their own with help and feedback from their coach.
- iii. As AI continually evolves, competitors must remember it is a tool and liken it to a powerful thesaurus as they may, at times, be called upon to prove their work and/or citations. Coaches must facilitate student use of this tool and its opportunities while teaching skills mastery so students may successfully compete in circumstances where internet or AI engines are unavailable.
