### **Team & Event Management Information**

**Bench:** Home Team will be on the West bench and Away Team will be on the East Bench.

**Playing Field:** Playing field is Turf. No metal cleats are allowed. All other cleats will work on the surface.

No food, sunflower seeds, tobacco, gum, etc. is allowed on the turf field.

**Sideline Personnel:** Please restrict the bench area to include coaches, players, managers, and team personnel

only.

Halftime: 10 Minutes

**Uniforms:** Highest seeded team will be home and wear dark uniforms. Lower seeded team will be

visitors and wear white uniforms.

If like seeded teams are playing, the WDA team will be the home team (for example, if #2 from the west is playing #2 from the east, the West team would be considered home).

**Warm-Up:** Higher seed are to use the West half of the field. Lower seed use the East half of field.

Warms ups will be on the Game field if no game is going on OR the practice field on the

west side of the locker rooms.

**Warm-Up Balls:** All teams are to furnish their own warm-up balls (game balls provided by NDHSAA).

**Officials:** Selected and assigned by the NDHSAA

**Hydration:** A water cooler will be provided at each team bench.

Teams are asked to bring their own water bottles.

Team Bus/Drop Off: Buses will drop off teams on the lower Southwest corner of the Community Bowl. Busses

may park in the Lower SW parking lot or along the road on the South side of the

Community Bowl.

**Locker Rooms:** Locker rooms will be available to teams on the West side of the field.

**Starting Line-Ups:** Coaches are to have their starting line-ups in to the press box at least 30 minutes prior to

the start of their game. We will introduce the entire squad prior to the semifinal and

championship matches.

**Team Packets:** Nametags will serve as tournament passes and will be available at the lower Southwest

gate upon arrival. Each team will be provided a maximum of 34 nametags. Additional

tickets have to be purchased and will be charged to your school.

Players, managers, coaches, school officials, and tournament officials must present passes

or tickets for admission to all sessions.

**Programs**: Programs will be digital. **Qualifying teams will be sent a link to complete required** 

information. (Roster, School Info, Coaches Picture) Team pictures will be taken off of

the NDHSAA website – please make any changes by October 4th.

**Sports Medicine:** Sanford Orthopedics Sports Medicine will provide athletic training coverage for the

tournament. Only licensed and certified medical practitioners will be allowed to evaluate

and

treat injured athletes – this includes on the field. Please bring your own tape and supplies. If you wish to have your own team/personal medical provider be responsible for your athletes, please complete the attached Transfer of Care Form and present it to the training

staff at the

tournament. In the absence of a Transfer of Care Form, all decisions on the athlete's fitness

to compete will be made by the Sanford staff.

**Coaches Meeting:** The coaches meeting will take place on Friday, October 13<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 am. Location is to be

determined, more information will be shared.

**Hotels/Lodging:** Rooms have not been reserved for teams. All teams are responsible for securing their own

hotel rooms.
