2024 State Wrestling Tournament Information Sheet

Fargodome

Enclosed you will find a diagram of the Fargodome area and one showing the parking lots. We are requesting that you enter the dome area from the University Avenue entrance on the east side of the dome. You may drive your bus to the east lobby area and unload. Teams will enter the dome through the main east lobby and proceed to the lower level by using the escalator. Your name tag will serve as a ticket or pass to enter the dome. After you have unloaded, please have your bus parked in lot B along the north side of that area.

- Dressing rooms: Male participant dressing rooms are on the east lower level of the dome. Female
 participants will dress in the west lower level. Cheerleaders will have meeting room 104 available for
 their use. Signs will be posted directing you to these areas and to the designated dressing rooms. The
 locker room areas and meeting rooms will <u>not</u> be locked and secured so individuals should take care to
 secure their valuables.
- Athletic Trainers: Sanford Orthopedics Sports Medicine will provide athletic trainers for all sessions. The athletic trainer will be located in northwest corner of the lower level of the arena. Water coolers and ice will be available for your use. Please bring your supply of tape.
- **Hospitality Area:** There will be a hospitality area for school officials, coaches, and administrators on the east lower-level room 101 & 102 (at the bottom of the escalator).
- **Dome mats:** There will be eight mats used for the tournament. On the backside of the south bleachers four warm-up mats will be available. Athletes can get to this area by walking through hallway just south of the east locker rooms or using the entrance at the south end of the east hallway. We are encouraging teams to be seated in the upper levels of section 21 (west side) and section 32 (east side).
- Coaches Meeting: The annual wrestling coaches meeting will be on Wednesday, February 14, at 6:00 pm at the Fargodome. The meeting will be in the Bison Theater below the east lobby. Please enter the dome from the east main lobby and take the escalator to the lower level. There will be signs directing you to the meeting rooms.
- **FCA Huddle:** The Fellowship of Christian Athletes is planning a gathering Friday morning after weighins. A special guest speaker has been arranged for those who wish to attend. The gathering will be in the warm-up area near the mats behind the south bleachers.

• Passes and name tags:

- The NDHSAA limits the number of passes at the state tournament: In addition to the qualifying wrestlers, participating schools at the state tournament with 1-5 contestants will be allowed 5 passes and 3 coaches' badges. Teams with 6 or more contestants will receive 7 passes and 3 coaches' badges. If a school requests extra passes, such request will be granted and the cost of \$40 for each individual tournament pass and \$20 for each dual tournament pass will be deducted from the school's team payment.
- Schools not having an entrant in the State Tournament do not receive any passes.
- Each participating athlete, cheerleader and manager will also receive a personalized nametag and lanyard. These passes serve as a parking pass and admission to the event. All participants,

cheerleaders, coaches, managers, and school officials are required to show their pass or purchase a ticket for admission. The passes will be in the team packet and are to be picked up at ticket window #11 in the east lobby of the Fargodome. School official and guest tickets are not included in the team packet and should be picked up at ticket window #11 by the person listed on the request.

- Coolers: Reminder Coolers will be checked through the east lobby lower-level escalator. This area is located next to the Metro Tournament team check-in table in the east lobby. Once inside the dome athletes should store their coolers in the east locker room area or in the team camp area behind the south bleachers. Signs designating these areas will be posted. No coolers are to be taken into the main arena seating area. Please inform your athletes of this policy. Thank you for your assistance.
- Cheerleaders: Banners and signs are to be hung using string, zip ties or wrestling mat tape. When you arrive, please check with tournament management for designated sign area(s). The east lower-level meeting room 104 is set aside for the cheerleaders. Cheerleaders are reminded to secure any valuables as the room will not be locked. Restroom facilities are available in the lower level on the north end. As per NDHSAA regulations, only four (4) cheerleaders are allowed near the mats during a bout.

- Skin Checks/Official Weigh-ins: Skin checks/weigh-ins will begin at 8:00 am each day. We will organize teams and individuals on the floor of the south end of the Fargodome and then usher in teams and individuals for skin checks and weigh-ins. At the Wednesday evening coaches meeting, the schedule and procedure for skin checks and weigh-ins will be reviewed. We are encouraging coaches to have any doctor's slips for skin testing with them at the weigh-in. Weigh-in and skin checks will be in the following order: Class B Boys, Class A Boys, Girls Wrestlers. Team managers and statisticians are asked to stay out of the skin check/weigh-in area.
- **School Responsibility:** Each school must be responsible for both athletes and students attending tournaments. Each school participating in the tournament should have a school administrator report to the tournament management or to guest services on the east side of the dome in case of a problem with students at the tournament.
- Workout/Practices: By NDHSAA rules, teams are not allowed to practice on the tournament site the
 day prior to the tournament. We suggest that you work out at your own facility prior to leaving
 because the Fargo schools & West Fargo schools will not have mats available to practice.
- **Team video areas:** All team and individual bouts that a school wants to video tape should be done from the spectator seats. If a school needs assistance in locating an area to set up a camera they should contact a floor captain or the tournament management.
- **Team personnel on mat area during Bouts:** Each team will be allowed two (2) coaches and one manager on the floor and at the mat when they have a wrestling bout scheduled. A chair for the manager/stat person is reserved at each mat scoring table. A staging area for wrestlers and stats that are on deck and in the hole is located in the NE corner of the dome.
- **NOTE**: Wrestlers and coaches are not to wear caps or bandannas when representing their school in the awards ceremonies or anytime in the wrestling area. Only school issued uniforms or warm-up (both top and bottom) are acceptable apparel for the awards stand. Awards will be presented only to wrestlers in compliance.



Wrestling Coaches:

You will find information in the following paragraphs concerning the process we will use to provide the best functioning main arena wrestling area for the state wrestling tournament. We ask that you please review this information with your athletes, statisticians, managers and coaches.

Procedures

- We will not have runners escorting wrestling from the staging area to the mat.
- The staging area supervisors will have a screen that provides up-to-the second information on the matches in progress and will send the wrestlers to the mat when they are officially on deck.
- Please speak with your wrestlers about this and reinforce that the supervisors will send them to the mat at the appropriate time, they should not go no their own.

Wrestlers

- A staging area with warm-up mats will be established in the northeast corner of the Fargodome.
 All wrestlers in the two current weight classes to be contested will be called to the staging area where they may continue their pre-match preparations.
- The wrestlers name is highlighted in yellow, signifying they are on-deck. The supervisors in charge of the staging area will send the on-deck contestants to the mat.
- Please inform your wrestlers that they need to report to the staging area when their weight
 class is called so they may be checked in for their match. <u>They do not report to the mat!</u> When
 their match moves to the on-deck match they will be released to go to their assigned mat.
- Wrestlers will access the main arena through only the staging area.
- Wrestlers may exit the main arena wrestling area to return to their team camp through the walkway along the bleachers on the east side of the main floor.

Statisticians

- There will be chairs for the statisticians in the staging area. This is where they are able to sit
 between matches if they are in the main arena wrestling area. The chairs in the main arena are
 reserved for coaches.
- There will be two chairs at the mat-side head table designated for the statisticians. The official statistician for each team will sit at the head table during the match. **By rule, they are not allowed to sit along the edge of the mat.**
- Statisticians will access the main arena wrestling area through the staging area. Statisticians
 may exit the main arena wrestling area and return to their team camps through the walkway
 along the bleachers on the east side of the main floor.

Coaches

- Chairs will be lined up along the north and south walls in the wrestling area (the same as previous years) for coaches to use when they don't have a wrestler currently on the mat. These chairs are only for coaches.
- Coaches who wish to be with their wrestlers during their warm-up time for the matches may do so in the staging area.
- Coaches may move back and forth directly from the camp area to the wrestling area with their
 official tournament badge without leaving the arena area. They may go through the walkway
 along the bleachers on the east side of the main floor.

Weigh-in Area

- The skin checks and weigh-ins will take place on the south end of the main arena (the team camp side). Skin checks are now done daily as a new NFHS rule.
- Official weigh-in process is as follows:
 - 1. Hair & Nail Check
 - 2. Skin Check
 - 3. Official Weigh-in
- Because weigh-ins take place on the main arena floor, coaches are asked to use their judgment concerning the presence of non-participants (i.e. Managers, Statisticians, etc.) in this area during weigh-ins.

Order of Weigh-ins

- Day 1
 - Class B Boys
 - o Class A Boys
 - o Girls Wrestlers
- Day 2
 - Class B Boys
 - Class A Boys
 - Girls Wrestlers
- Day 3
 - Class B Dual Teams
 - Class A Dual Teams
 - o Girls Dual Teams

Name Badge Request - Due 9:00 PM Saturday February 10th

Name badges will be created for all individual qualified wrestlers and all wrestlers/alternates listed on the dual roster.

Please do NOT request badges for those athletes.

Floor access passes will be provided to qualifying wrestlers, coaches, statisticians, cheerleaders and the cheer advisor.

Guests will receive a General Admission ticket, floor access not granted to guest tickets.

Please note (per NDHSAA policy): high school student media passes are reserved for students only & must be submitted for by school administrators.

Media badges will not be accepted through the Metro Tournament Committee request form.

Dear Coaches and Athletic Directors:

Sanford Sports Medicine will be providing Athletic Training services for the 2024 North Dakota State High School Wrestling Tournament. We would like to assist you in ensuring this is a safe and exciting tournament for your team. There are a few details to allow appropriate care to occur in the area of Sports Medicine.

- We will be performing skin checks beginning at 8:00 AM each day. If you have an athlete that is using medication for a skin disease, please have her/him bring the medicine along with the prescribing physician's note concerning application/use. We will have a Physician in attendance on Thursday morning skin checks, the physician will have final say on any possible skin lesions that may be contagious and your wrestler will be disqualified from the tournament. Please have with you a completed Physician Release for Wrestler to Participate with Skin Lesion form from the National Federation of State High School Associations.

- Sanford Sports Medicine's headquarters will be located in the northwest corner of the Fargodome. If you are not bringing medical staff with you, please utilize the athletic training staff to assist you with your medical needs. We are available to assist you with taping and other pre-match/post-match needs. We ask that you please bring the necessary tape, pre-wrap, and other supplies for your athletes. We will have some stock supplies on hand, but would like your cooperation in this matter.
- If there is a conflict in the management of injury, the State/Metro Area Tournament Committee assigned Sanford medical staff has jurisdiction.
- If you wish to have your own team medical provider be responsible for your athletes, please complete the North Dakota High School Activities Association's Transfer of Care Form and return it to the medical staff at the tournament prior to the start of the tournament.

- There will be Athletic Trainers stationed throughout the mats of the ongoing matches. Their main role will be handling on-mat injuries. Spit buckets and blood kits are available for your use at each mat, but we ask that you and your athletes try to manage any blood injuries first. If you need additional help controlling the blood, we are there to assist.
