**New England Public School has sponsored a boys' cross country program for the past four seasons; however, participation numbers have remained low, resulting in student-athletes competing primarily as individuals rather than as a full team. During the current season, Mott/Regent Public School had student interest in boys' cross country participation. In response, a memorandum of understanding was established between New England Public School and Mott/Regent Public School, allowing Mott/Regent student-athletes to practice with New England and share coaching services. All Mott/Regent participants competed under their respective school designation at interscholastic meets.**

**The Hettinger County Co-op Committee discussed bringing the schools together to address these ongoing participation challenges. By forming this co-op, the intent is to combine student numbers in order to provide a sustainable cross country program that allows students to compete as a team rather than solely as individuals, while ensuring continued access to the sport for student-athletes from all participating schools.**




