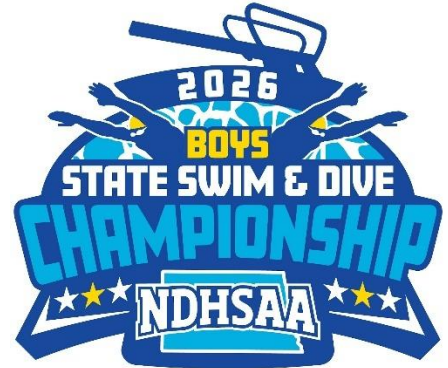

Award Presentations

Individual Awards for each event will be presented on Saturday immediately following the completion of the next event. Awards for each event will be announced to the top 16 individual event swimmers/divers & top 8 relays. Please inform your athletes that all place-winners are to report to the assigned staging area behind the awards stand as soon as possible, upon completion of their event. They will be placed in order of finish and then taken as a group to the podium.

The Senior Athlete of the Year, Coach of the Year and Team awards will be presented at the end of the meet. All-State Athletes will also be announced at the conclusion of the meet, please keep your school's all-state athletes on the deck near the bulkhead for an efficient awards ceremony.

Parking

Fargo/West Fargo Athletes, Managers & Coaches are to park in the North Berger Elementary School parking lot and enter in the North door. Buses are to drop off at the front doors of the Hulbert Aquatics Center and park in designated Bus parking areas.

FRIDAY: Buses can park at WFHS and along 7th street (East of the HAC). Buses can pick up at Berger Loop at end of the day.

SATURDAY: Buses can park in the Berger Elementary Bus Loop. Buses can drop off & pick up at Berger Bus Loop on Saturday.

(Do not park in Berger bus loop on Friday as school is in session)

Team Camps

Each team will have an assigned team area on the pool deck. Teams are responsible for cleaning up their camp area. If any beverages are spilled, it is your team's responsibility to clean up the mess. Garbage cans are placed around the pool deck area. Please make sure everything is picked up and thrown away. Cooler should be carried into team area.

Team Banner/Poster

Each team will be able to hang their team banner/poster on the railings above their team camp. HAC staff can assist to hang each team's banner/poster. Banner/poster should have grommets. Facility has a NO TAPE policy.
