## **NDHSAA BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS FOR REGULAR AND POSTSEASON COMPETITIONS:**

- Respect the American flag and the National Anthem.
- Contesting schools shall each have an authorized faculty representative present who shall be responsible for his/her school's participants, students, and fans throughout the contest.
- Spectators must wear appropriate clothing. Those who do not comply or who wear clothing that is vulgar, obscene or that in some other way inappropriate, as determined by school/tournament personnel, will be removed from the facility if they do not cooperate with this behavior expectation.
- The use of appropriate language is expected at all times. Profanity, negative chants, trash talk, name-calling, personal attacks or other acts of disrespect are unacceptable and must be immediately addressed by school/tournament administrators. Any discriminatory slur will result in immediate removal from the facility.
- Any attendee ejected from a NDHSAA tournament venue will be banned from the venue(s) for the remainder of the event.
- Respect the game/contest. Under no condition shall anyone other than the members of the official squad enter the playing surface. No one may interfere with the contest in any way.
- Handheld signs and flags, which do not obstruct the view of others, are permitted provided they are in good taste. Signs or other similar items contest/tournament officials deem to be in poor taste will be removed. Message or "white" boards are prohibited. The carrying of flags around the playing surface is NOT allowed.
- Artificial noisemakers of any kind (i.e. megaphones, cowbells, sirens, whistles, thunder sticks, and other similar items) are not allowed at any indoor events, including outdoor sports played at indoor venues. Exception – Megaphones appropriately used by cheerleaders are permitted if allowed by contest officials.
- Laser lights or any other lights deemed distracting to participants are strictly prohibited.
- The use of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAV), also known as drones, is prohibited at all contests.

# 1975 NDHSAA Class A Girls Basketball State Champions

United in its desire to improve upon the team's third-place finish in Region 2 during the 1974 season, the Mayville-Portland girls basketball team had plenty of potential to put together a special season in 1975.

After an unblemished 14-0 regular season, the Patriots, coached by Sheryl Solberg, earned a first-round bye in the District 5 Tournament, which they ultimately won defeating Grandin 44-26 in the championship game played at Mayville State.

Next up was the Region 2 tournament in Larimore and with it the ultimate prize of a trip to Minot to play in the NDHSAA Class B State Tournament.

With wins against Luverne in the quarterfinals and Crary in the semifinals, Mayville-Portland would meet Lakota in the Region 2 final. Bolstered by excellent team defense, which had been their strength all season, the Patriots built a 17-4 halftime lead and held on to win 36-27 despite a fourth quarter run by Lakota. Led by senior Kathy Meyer's 14 points,

Mayville-Portland celebrated both a region championship and a state tournament berth.

Fairmount, Granville, Pingree, Rock Lake, Binford, New England and Grenora would join No.-1 ranked Mayville-Portland at the 1975 NDHSAA Class B State Tournament played at the Minot Auditorium.

The Patriots' quarterfinals opponent was Region 1 champion and No. 2-ranked Fairmount. Mayville-Portland and Fairmount were knotted 20-20 after three quarters of play, but the Patriots pulled away with an 8-0 run to help seal a 32-24 victory.

A 63-51 win over Rock Lake in the semifinals would send the Patriots to the state championship game where they would meet Granville.

In the title game, senior guard Laurie Kloster served as the Patriots' sparkplug scoring 12 of her game-high 20 points in the fourth quarter to help Mayville-Portland to a 52-41 win. Granville took an early 14-10 lead at the first quarter break, but the Patriots recovered and led 26-23 at half-

time despite Meyer picking up her third personal foul with six minutes, 59 seconds left in the first half.

Senior bench players Glenda Lee and Marcia Hoplin played big roles in the Patriots' victory. Lee scored eight points and Hoplin finished with four points in substitute of Meyer.

Granville scored the first four points in the second half to lead 27-26, but the Patriots used a 12-0 run fueled by two big field goals by Meyer to regain the momentum.

Granville pulled to within one point of the lead (42-41) with just under four minutes to play before Kloster exploded for eight consecutive points that included a perfect six-for-six shooting display from the free-throw line.

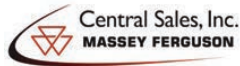
Kloster finished the three-game tournament with 50 points and earned a spot on the All-Tournament team along with Meyer.

Mayville-Portland finished the season undefeated with a 22-0 record.

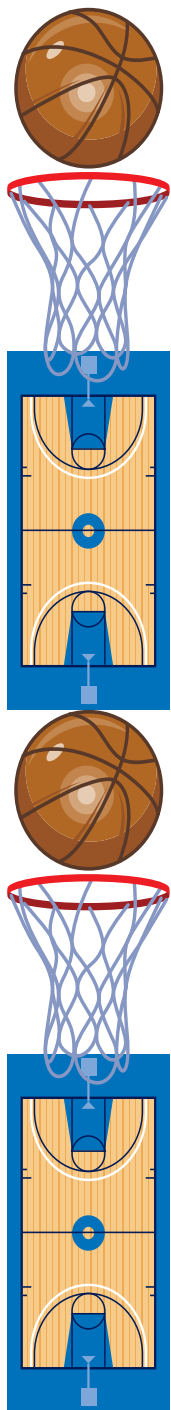

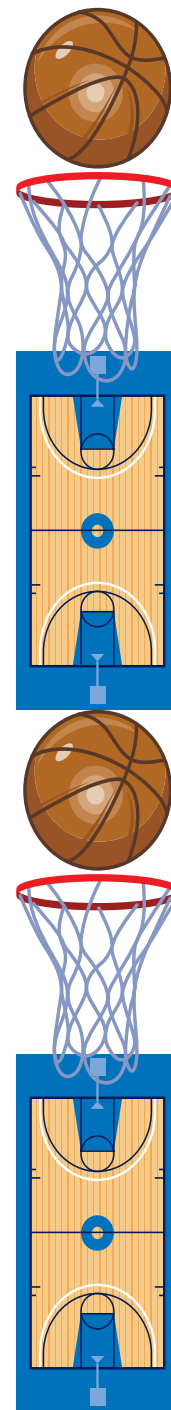
