Pairings: Pairings for 2025 have been done using iwannamaker team rankings for the 18 qualified teams and individuals.

DRIVING RANGE: Driving Range will open at 8:30 on Monday

8:30 - 9:10 - Players starting on Regions 1-3

9:10 - 9:40 - Players starting on Regions 4-6

<u>Coaches Tournament Carts:</u> One cart will be available for one coach with a full team. Cost is paid by the school! \$25 per day for cart.

Spectator Carts: A Limited number of Spectator Carts will be available. Spectators using carts must provide a ND Handicap Parking Permit, or Doctors letter.

TOURNAMENT MANAGEMENT: South Heart High School will serve as the host school. NDGA staff will serve as the Tournament Officials.

FOOD/BEVERAGE: PCGC Restaurant will be open at the clubhouse. Please do not bring food into the clubhouse from other eating establishments.

<u>LUNCH:</u> Lunch each day will be free to Players and Coaches Sponsored by the North Dakota Petroleum Council. The kitchen will have team rosters to check off each day. Breakfast sandwiches will also be available for purchase at the restaurant.

SCORING: Live scoring using iwanamaker software will be used for this tournament. One player in each group will do the live scoring. Players will validate at the scoring tent. Make sure your players have a charged phone for keeping score and verifying. Paper Scorecards will be the official score at the end of the round and be verified with the Iwannamaker!

AWARDS: There will be an awards presentation immediately following the competition of play on Day 2.

CELL PHONES: Cell phones will be permitted by players to input scores during play.

PARKING: You may drop off your athletes and bags at the clubhouse and then park your vehicle in the south parking lot by driving range.

SPECTATOR GUIDELINES: Please communicate guidelines with your players, parents, and fans who may be in attendance.

30 yards from any competing player, one shot ahead of group they are following!
Walk or drive on the cart paths only!!!!
Carts may be rented if available (Handicapped ONLY) and they must stay on the cart path and in the rough, please do not drive down the fairways. Must be 18 to rent a cart.
May assist players looking for lost balls, and cheer for all players!
Spectators are not allowed to be in verbal contact with players during the rounds of competition. This includes by use of cell phone.
