- **All native grass areas are to be played as lateral relief**, two club-lengths no closer to the hole, penalty drop.
- Out of bounds is marked by fence left of #10, #12, #13, #7, #8, and #9.
- Lateral water hazards marked by red paint #11, #15, #18, #3, and #8.
- There are designated drop areas on #3 and #11.
- Ground under repair is marked with white paint. If unusual ground conditions are encountered consult with your group and take relief with the consent of your playing partners.
- Maintenance shed and maintenance trails right of Hole #2 are in bounds, nearest point of complete relief, no closer to the hole, one club-length, no penalty. This does not mean you bring it out of the trees and into play, closest grassy surface.
- Please play two balls and record both scores if there are any ruling questions.
- Please replace divots, repair ball marks on the putting greens, and rake bunkers.
