- 1. Change to Mercy Rule for Class B Yes
 - a. When the point differential reaches 30 or more points in the 4^{th} quarter, the clock will continue to run.
 - b. The clock will only be stopped for all free throws, time outs, and injuries c. Any time a foul is called that will result in free throws, the clock should stop. If the clock continues to run following a foul call, as soon as it is determined you will be shooting free throws, the clock should be stopped and shoot the free throws. Officials will not put time back on the clock that may have run off prior to recognizing free throws are to be shot. The clock will resume upon the touching of the last missed free throw or when the last free throw is made, when the ball is legally touched following the throw-in.
