Discussion

- 1. Timed warm up procedure Keep the same 4 minute warm-up procedure but change the horn times to the following times. 17:00, 13:00, 9:00, 5:00, 1:00. At 1:00 on the clock teams report to their benches for final instruction and report to the end line at 0:00 for introductions.
- 2. Make sure the regulation stating there will a 25 minute warm-up following the JV match is enforced.
- 3. 20 matches 1 tournament No action
- 4. Allowing teams to run around full court to begin warm-ups
 - a. Recommend that teams when running out for the initial warm-up stay on their side of the court and refrain from running onto the opponent side of the court
- 5. Add a survey to officials at the end of September where they declare if they want to be considered for post-season play
- 6. Highly recommend that officials put their photo on the NDHSAA website as several coaches will utilize this feature in order to select officials for post season assignments
- 7. Place a slide onto the VB clinic explaining how coaches can access officials photos
- 8. POE Warm-up procedure when Team A has their 4 minutes on the floor it is highly encouraged that Team B remain clear of Team A's warm up
- 9. POE Workshop slide on ball handling and tightening things up especially on second contact
- 10. POE- administrating the unnecessary delay and not allowing it to take time away from the match administer penalty and move on
- 11. TV contract when will TV timeouts be taken
- 12. Out of state officials for post season leave regulation as is.
- 13. NFHS rules changes review
