- Unlimited Subs
 - Unlimited subs received some support from both Class A and B coaches.
 Advisory was invited to request a rule change proposal form from the NFHS and NDHSAA if there was a desire a change.
- Mandatory 3rd Set Sub-Varsity (in favor)
 - Advisory has asked Kevin Morast to ask the NDHSAA board of education to keep the mandatory three set rule in VB.
- Go back to switching sides/benches
 - Advisory recommends that the regulation revert to pre-Covid regulation that requires team to switch sides between sets.
- Discuss official's sit out year; why is there one and how do we know who's turn it is?
 - Kevin provided history of the sit out rule and will provided information prior to coaches' survey as to whom is on a sit out year.
- We have more teams with the addition of schools in Class A, which means more kids/athletes playing than ever before. Can we expand the numbers on All-Region and All-State teams? (proposed 12 - 1st team and 12 2nd team for both All-Region & All-State)
 - NDHSCA rule and Brianna was visited with Randy Johnson.

Class B

- Mandatory 3 sets for sub-varsity
 - Majority of coaches in attendance were in favor of keeping the mandatory 3 sets
 - If we were to move to optional 3 sets
 - Visiting team would get to choose
 - Consideration for teams that travel and time constraints
 - o Possible cap on the 3rd set?
 - See above regarding discussion.
- Printed state tournament programs
 - Majority would like to see printed programs
 - Discussion regarding at least providing schools in attendance and coaches determining all-tournament team a program. Opportunity to print at home.
- 3 Class System
 - o Kevin talked
 - Nothing to effect volleyball at the moment
 - Kevin updated advisory that board will meet December 1.

- Unlimited Substitutions
 - o Many coaches in favor of unlimited subs
 - More opportunities for athletes to participate
 - o Concerns: more to track for officials, time to sub in more athletes
 - See Class A discussion
- Switching Sides
 - o Coaches seemed indifferent to this topic
 - Reasons to switch: different views for officials and line judges, visual advantages/disadvantages
 - See Class A discussion
- All-State Team
 - o Many are in favor to change our voting system similar to the Class A system
 - o More opportunities to recognize our athletes
 - Breanna and Jessica have had discussion with NDHSCA

Regulation change proposal

- Re-implement the switching of team benches between sets.
 - Rationale:
 - Small intricacies in gyms provide an advantage to teams not always known
 - Officials support switching of sides as it allows for alternate views of setter
 - Line judge issues on same side perception
