- 2. We also brought up to talk again about seeding more than 4 teams. Maybe 8 with cross bracketing starting in the quarters.
- 3. Potentially being able to Zoom All State meeting. The year of Covid we did and worked well. We also did our meeting virtually this year and used Menti. I think the biggest driver of this from A.D.'s was the cost of sending 3 reps to fargo from the region.
- 4. Only other thing that was brought up is to have the competition committee meeting earlier in fall after the first year(2023). This way schedules could be set earlier withthe movement that will take place on a biennial basis.
- 5. Get rid of the dress limit for the playoffs. Why penalize programs that have large numbers of students participating in an extracurricular activity? Telling an athlete that has dressed all year and possibly played varsity minutes is not good for them, the relationship you have with them and their family, or for the health of your program.
- 6. Rank the top 8 for the playoffs. You could continue to place the region champs as 1-4 and allow the QRF or the 4 region champs to rank 5-8. Our region feels this would lead to better matchups as the tournament progresses.
