

Swim Advisory 1-21-24.

1. Head coach that assists with tournament have access to meet entries early.
 - a. Not an issue with advisory as all entries are already locked.
2. People on state meet deck with no credentials.
 - a. Kevin will visit with Logan regarding better door security not allowing anyone on deck without a pass.
3. Club coaches on deck with passes but no affiliation to a team but have access to their club athletes.
 - a. Determining who is a volunteer coach and which coaches should receive a pass is difficult if not impossible to determine. As long as the member school issues a pass they will be allowed on deck.
4. 10 lanes for preliminaries in pools that can accommodate.
 - a. Boys opposed due to small numbers.
 - b. Girls' advisory members will determine, if necessary, by looking at next season's numbers.

5. Entry deadline for dual/tri meets.
 - a. Advisory strongly recommends coaches use professionalism and courtesy regarding getting meet entries to host management in a timely manner with their most updated information without trying to manipulate the system.
6. WF permanent site.
 - a. The NDHSAA tournament committee will be reviewing the use of the Hulbert Aquatics Center as the site for swim and dive until another facility can accommodate the rise in attendance.
7. E-dive program.
 - a. Talia will do some research into the viability of using E-dive and also explore the option of creating a tutorial on how to use E-dive.
