

Recommendation: Codify coaching on super tiebreakers and the first change over during a short set.

Vote: Yes 12 No 3

Rationale: This is not a change over what we currently do as a gentleman's agreement, but it puts it into regulations.

Change 1: Add to the end of Regulation 2 under Play before a: Changeovers in a super tiebreaker may be up to 30 seconds and coaching is allowed. Players are not allowed to sit during these changeovers.

Change 2: Add to end of Regulation 2 a i 1 under Play: The first changeover in a short set can be up to 30 seconds and coaching is allowed. Players are not allowed to sit during this changeover.

Recommendation: Codify our region and state team and individuals tournament.

Vote: Yes 12 No 3

Rationale: This does not change anything we currently do, but it puts it into regulations.

Change 1: Add in front of current Regional and State Tournaments 11 b: Region and state team competitions consist of an 8-team bracket. If more than 8 teams in a region, play-in matches determine the regional qualifying teams and will be played prior to Thursday of the regional tournament with #8 hosting #9, #7 hosting #10, etc. Region tournament winners of consolation semifinals...(keep the rest of b as is)

Change 2: Replace 12a under Regional and State Tournaments:

- a. The regional and state individuals tournament consist of one singles tournament and one doubles tournament where individual players can only play in one or the other. Tournaments are double elimination. Winners of the quarterfinals will play for 1st through 4th place. Winners of the consolation quarterfinals will play for 5th through 8th place.
- b. All teams may enter three singles players and two doubles teams into the regional individuals tournament. Finishing in the top 8 at regionals qualifies the singles player or doubles team for the state individuals tournament.
