

MINIMAL BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS FOR REGULAR AND POSTSEASON COMPETITIONS

- Respect the American flag and the National Anthem.
- · Contesting schools shall each have an authorized faculty representative present who shall be responsible for his/her school's participants, students, and fans throughout the contest.
- Spectators must wear clothing that covers the entire torso. Those who do not comply or who wear clothing that is vulgar, obscene or that in some other way inappropriate, as determined by school/tournament personnel, will be removed from the facility if they do not cooperate with this behavior expectation.
- The use of appropriate language is expected at all times. Profanity, negative chants, trash talk, name-calling, personal attacks or other acts of disrespect are unacceptable and must be immediately addressed by school/tournament administrators.
- Any attendee ejected from a NDHSAA tournament venue will be banned from the venue(s) for the remainder of the event.
- Respect the game/contest. Under no condition shall anyone other than the members of the official squad enter the playing surface. No one may interfere with the contest in any way.

- Hand held signs and flags, which do not obstruct the view of others, are permitted provided they are in good taste. Signs or other similar items contest/tournament officials deem to be in poor taste will be removed. Message or "white" boards are prohibited. The carrying of flags around the playing surface is NOT allowed.
- Artificial noisemakers of any kind (i.e. megaphones, cowbells, sirens, whistles, thunder sticks, and other similar items) are not allowed at any indoor events, including outdoor sports played at indoor venues. Exception - Megaphones appropriately used by cheerleaders are permitted if allowed by contest officials.
- · Laser lights or any other lights deemed distracting to participants are strictly prohibited.
- · Confetti is banned at all NDHSAA tournament venues. Tournament staff is instructed to confiscate such articles at the door.
- · Objects shall not be thrown into the stands at any NDHSAA tournament
- The use of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAV), also known as drones, is prohibited for any persons at NDHSAA tournament venues.



1968 State Champions Williston Coyotes

The 1968 North Dakota High School Activities Association Class A Boys Basketball Tournament was played at the Univeristy of North Dakota Fieldhouse. The tournament field was made up of Bismarck St. Mary's, Grand Forks St. James, Fargo Shanley, Rugby, Grand Forks Red River, Williston, Fargo South and Bismarck.

Williston, Grand Forks St. James, Fargo Shanley, and Grand Forks Red River all won quarterfinal games to open the tournament. Eventual state champion, Williston defeated Fargo South 73-55 in the quarterfinals and followed up with a 75-69 victory over Grand Forks St. James in the semifinals. The victory over the Royals gave the Coyotes their first state title game appearance since 1963 when they defeated Grand Forks Central for the program's second state title.

The Coyotes would add to the trophy case by defeating Grand Forks Red River 92-82 in the 1968 state championship game. It proved to be a record-breaking title game as both teams combined for 174 points – a new tournament record for combined points in a Class A championship game. The new total had smashed the previous record previously held by Bismarck and Bismarck St. Mary's who combined for 148 points in the 1953 final. The combined points total for a state championship game put up by Williston and Grand Forks Red River still stands today.


Williston's point total of 92 in the title game is also a record that still stands today. The previous record had been 84 held by Mandan in the 1966 championship game.

Williston was coached by Jim McPherson, who was in his fifth-year at the school in 1968. He had previously coached Mott to Class B state championships in 1961 and 1962 prior to his tenure at Williston. McPherson recalled his 1968 Coyotes squad as a "tall, athletic bunch" that practiced tough and used size to their advantage.

The Jamestown Blue Jays entered the 1992-93 basketball season with no returning starters, but did have a number of returning lettermen. The eleven-team Eastern Dakota Conference was expected to be very competitive with West Fargo and Valley City the preseason favorites. When the season ended the Blue Jays found themselves in fourth place. Jamestown finished the regular season with a 13-6 win-loss record.

The fourth-place Jamestown Blue Jays opened the East Region Tournament with the No. 5-seeded Fargo Shanley Deacons. The Blue Jays fell to the Deacons 55-46. With their backs against the wall, the Blue Jays bounced back in the double-elimination tournament by defeating Devils Lake 49-48, Grand Forks Red River 51-41 and in a return match defeated Fargo Shanley 53-48 in the third-place game. The East Region qualifiers for the state tournament were No. 1-seeded West Fargo Packers, No. 2 Valley City Hi-Liners, No. 3 Jamestown Blue Jays and No. 4 Shanley Deacons.

The Minot State University Dome was the site of the 1993 North Dakota High School Activities Association Class A Boys Basketball State Tournament. The tournament opened with the No. 2 team from the West Region, Bismarck Century Patriots vs. the No. 3 team from the East Region, Jamestown Blue Jays. The Blue Jays made 52 percent of their field goal attempts and 71 percent of their

free throws on their way to a 66-47 win. Derek Hill, Steve Hockert, Jesse Isaac and Scott Pfaff led Jamestown in scoring with 17, 15, 12 and 10 points, respectively. Derek Hill (7) and Jesse Isaac (6) were the leading rebounders. Eric Meidinger's 20 points and 10 rebounds led Century.

The Jamestown Blue Jays and Mandan Braves faced off in the semifinals. In a close game from beginning to end the Blue Jays prevailed by a 43-41 score. Jesse Isaac led the Blue Jays with 10 points while Jake Reeb, Derek Hill, and Scott Pfaff each contributed eight points. Leading rebounders were Jesse Isaac and Steve Hockert with six each. Jamie Wagner led Mandan with 17 points and Preston Fleck led in rebounding with 10.

The 1993 State Championship game featured the Jamestown Blue Jays and the Minot Magicians. Once again, the game was very close. At the end of regulation, the score was tied at 46. The first overtime saw each team scoring five points resulting in a 51-51 score and requiring another overtime period. In the second overtime the Blue Jays out scored the Magicians 5-2 for a 56-53 victory. Jamestown was led by Jesse Isaac's 20 points and 16 rebounds, Derek Hill's 15 points and nine rebounds and Scott Pfaff's 11 points and eight rebounds. Paul Williams (23 points and 15 rebounds) and Brian Manson (16 points) led Minot.

1992 State Champions Fargo South Bruins _

The 1992 North Dakota High School Activities Association Class A girls basketball state championship game went right down to the wire.

Overtime was needed to decide the final played at the Fargo Civic Center between Fargo South and Grand Forks Red River. Red River hit a basket with six seconds left in regulation to force overtime. The two squads were gridlocked at 46-46 entering the final seconds of overtime and the Bruins set up a play for the win.

Off a pick set by South forward Laura Kelly, South senior point guard Tonah Paulson had an option to shoot or find teammate Elisha Kabanuk on the perimeter for a 3-pointer attempt.

With Kabanuk guarded well and the Red River defense closing in, Paulson instead passed inside to senior center Jill Lovell who got a layup to fall right as the final buzzer sounded. Lovell's layup, her first points of the

game, helped the Bruins grab a 48-46 victory over the Roughriders.

The state championship was South's second in program history with the first coming in 1985.

First-year head coach Craig Flaagan guided a talented group in 1992 as the Bruins returned a senior class made up of Paulson, Lovell, Tara Rheault and Rachel Nyquist in addition to Kabanuk (junior) and Kelly (sophomore).

The Bruins won the Eastern Dakota Conference (EDC) regular-season championship and finished runner up to Red River in East Region Tournament prior to its run at state.

At state, South opened with a 64-44 win over Bismarck St. Mary's in the quarterfinals followed by a 47-38 victory over West Region top-seeded Minot in the semifinals.

A rematch with Red River was set. The Bruins would go onto avenge its East Region championship game loss to the Roughriders a week prior. Leading the way for South was Kabanuk, who finished with 21 points followed by Kelly, who scored 10.

Paulson, Kabanuk and Lovell were named to the All-Tournament team. Flaagan earned both EDC and Class A Coach of the Year honors in 1992.

Paulson and Kabanuk were also named to the Class A Girls Basketball All-State Team.
