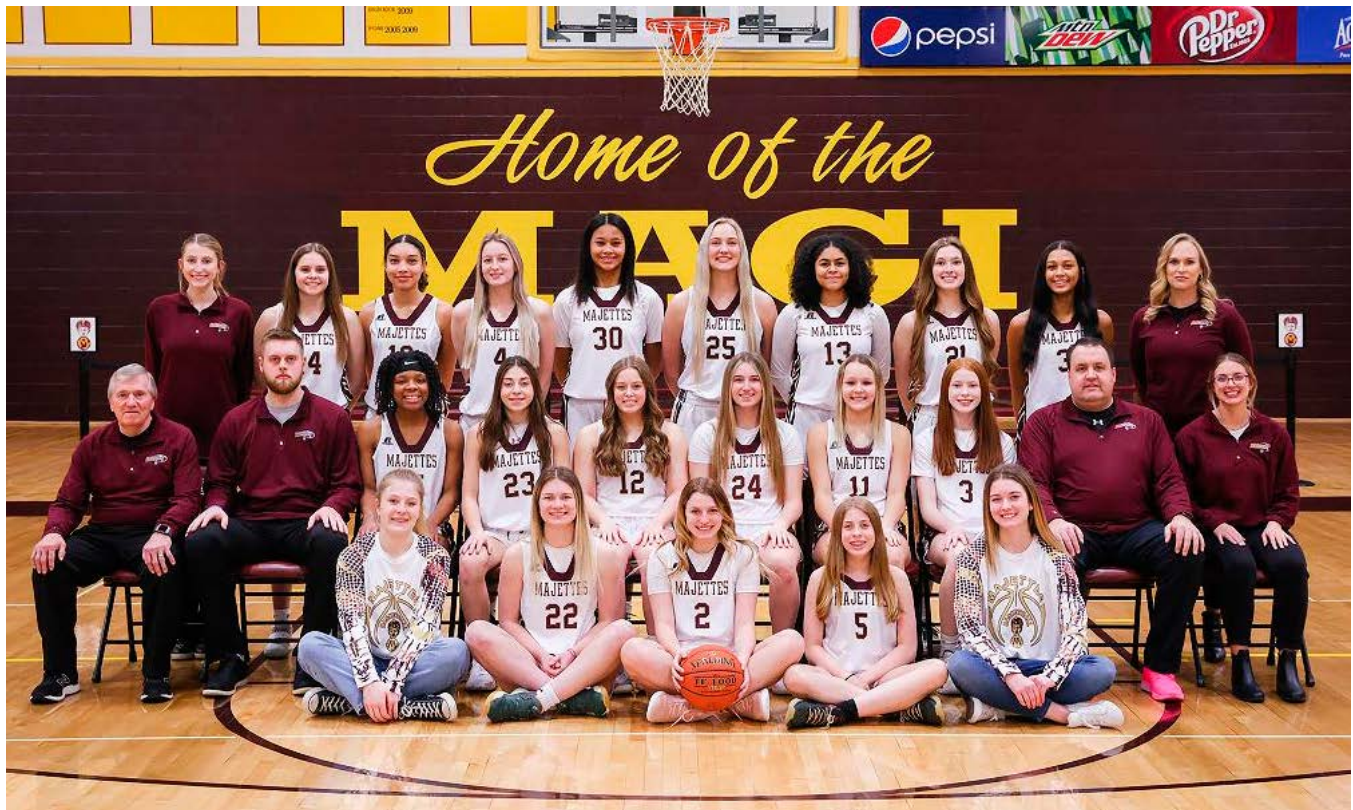

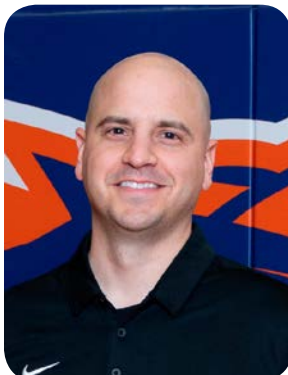



1994 CLASS A GIRLS BASKETBALL CHAMPIONS

FARGO SOUTH BRUINS

In order to ascend to their second NDHSAA Class A girls basketball state championship in three seasons, the Fargo South Bruins needed to turn the tables and defeat two teams that had bested them previously during the 1994 season.

The Bruins sought out to prove their resilience at the 1994 NDHSAA Class A state tournament held at the Fargo Civic Center. Along with South, defending state champions West Fargo, Dickinson, Williston, Fargo Shanley, Bismarck St. Mary's, Mandan and Grand Forks Red River made up the 1994 state tournament field.

South defeated St. Mary's 57-45 in the quarterfinals to set up a meeting with Mandan in the semifinals. Mandan had defeated the Bruins 55-52 in the season opener for both squads. The Braves, one of the state's best shooting teams, were the West Region's top seed at state. South was able to keep the Braves well under their team scoring average (65.2 points per game entering the state tournament) and held on for the 45-44 victory.

West Fargo awaited the Bruins in the state championship game. The Packers – looking to repeat as champions – had split its two conference games with South during the regular season defeating the Bruins 52-45 in the second meeting. West Fargo also had defeated South 47-42 in the East Region Tournament championship game a week prior to state.

Just as it had done with Mandan, South kept the Packers, who had averaged 59 points per game heading into state, out of rhythm on offense. The Bruins hit 11 of 14 free throws in the final four minutes of the title game to edge the Packers 41-34 and pocket the program's third state championship and second of the 1990s. South senior Laura Kelly led the Bruins with 12 points.

The 1994 season was also one that saw the Bruins break 29 team records as South ended the season 22-3.

Kelly, Micaela Bentson and Brenda Baldner were named to the All-Tournament team following the championship game.

Kelly, Bentson and Jenny Olsen were All-Eastern Dakota Conference selections for the Bruins. Kelly and Bentson were named to the Class A All-State team.

Kelly, a North Dakota Miss Basketball finalist, finished her career with 1,104 points and became the program's first player to score over 1,000 points.

1995 CLASS A GIRLS BASKETBALL CHAMPIONS MANDAN BRAVES

The 1995 NDHSAA Class A Girls Basketball State Tournament was played at the Jamestown Civic Center. Mandan, Bismarck High, Williston, Minot, Fargo Shanley, Jamestown, Fargo South and West Fargo High made up the tournament field.

The Braves entered the state tournament with a 20-2 record and was the West Region's No. 1 seed after defeating Williston 55-32 in the West Region Tournament played at Mandan High School.

Mandan was led by senior center Jolene Gartner, a NDAPSSA Miss Basketball finalist, and junior guard Jaye Amundson.

Mandan defeated Jamestown 60-39 in the quarterfinals and followed up with a 67-46 win over Fargo Shanley in the semifinals. The Braves would make their first appearance in a Class A girls basketball state championship game since 1991 and would square off against East Region No. 3 West Fargo.

The Braves edged the Packers 42-40 in the championship game for the program's first ever state title. The 1995 season would be the beginning chapter of an epic 13-year run for the Braves. During that span Mandan would play in 12 state championship games and win nine state championships.

Mandan finished the 1995 season 23-2. Gartner was named to the NDAPSSA All-State First Team. Amundson was named to the All-State Second Team.

1996 CLASS A GIRLS BASKETBALL CHAMPIONS

FARGO SHANLEY DEACONS

The 1996 NDHSAA Class A Girls Basketball State Tournament was played at the Minot Municipal Auditorium. The tournament field consisted of Fargo Shanley, Fargo South, Valley City, West Fargo, Minot, Mandan, Bismarck Century and Bismarck St. Mary's.

Entering the tournament, Fargo Shanley was 20-2 after defeating West Fargo High for the 1996 East Region Tournament championship. The Deacons' two losses were non-conference games to Bismarck St. Mary's and Mandan.

Shanley opened the state tournament with a 66-58 win over Bismarck Century in the quarterfinals and followed up with a 79-71 win over Fargo South in the semifinals.

The Deacons were back in a state championship game for the first time since 1989 when they defeated Turtle Mountain for the program's fourth state championship in 1980s decade.

If the Deacons wanted to add to the trophy case in 1996 they had to go through undefeated, defending state champions Mandan (24-0) who awaited Shanley in the championship game. Shanley edged the Braves 58-57 to capture the state championship and hand Mandan its only loss of the season. Juniors Angie Welle (20.0 points per game, 12.4 rebounds per game), Nikki Leier (11 points per game) and senior Sarah Jacobson (12.6 points per game and 5.6 rebounds per game) were named to the All-Tournament team.

Jacobson was named 1996 North Dakota High School Coaches Association Senior Athlete of the Year and Shanley head coach Rick Fletcher was named 1996 North Dakota High School Coaches Association Coach of the Year following the tournament. Jacobson and Welle were NDAPSSA All-State First Team selections. The 1996 Deacons finished the season 23-2.

1970 Class A Boys Basketball State Champions Grand Forks Central

The 1970 NDHSAA Class A Boys Basketball State Tournament was played at the Bismarck Civic Center. The tournament field included Fargo South, Minot, Dickinson, Grand Forks Central, Rugby, Valley City, Grand Forks Red River and Fort Yates.

Grand Forks Central, coached by Dick Vinger, was ranked No. 1 for most of the season in the media poll. Central had missed state in 1968 and 1969 – Vinger's first two seasons as head coach, but the 1970 squad was determined to make a statement in the postseason.

Central was matched up with Dickinson in the quarterfinals and rolled to an 85-51 victory. Next up was a game with Fargo South in the semifinals that ended with Central posting a 78-68 win to qualify for its first trip to the championship game since 1963.

In the championship, a familiar foe – Grand Forks Red River – awaited Central. The Roughriders were defending state champions and were the only team to beat Central – a 57-47 win in the regular season and a 74-61 win in the Northeast Region Tournament prior to state.

Central would win the final meeting between the crosstown rivals 54-50 and in the process, hoisted the team's first state championship trophy since 1956. Central ended the 1969-70 season with a 25-2 record.

MINOT MAGICIANS

The 1971 Minot Magicians season began with a resounding thud. The senior-dominated team, with little returning experience from the previous season, started the season by losing four of their first seven games. Head coach Nick Olson and his assistant Clarence (Christy) Christenson flirted with numerous lineup changes looking for the perfect fit. In early January, the coaches sat down with the team and shared their thoughts in an attempt to get the squad's attention. Apparently, it worked. From that point forward, the Magicians finished the season on a 17-2 run.

Putting their 3-4 start behind them, the Magicians who were a very good ball-handling club with excellent shooting and tough defense started to gain confidence with each succeeding win. Well-balanced scoring, with seven different players leading the team in scoring over the course of the season, and unselfishness were the hallmarks of the club.

Winning the Northwest Region Tournament over an excellent Williston Coyote team set the stage for the state tournament at the Bismarck Civic Center. At the state tournament, the Magicians' first game pitted them against a Park River team featuring future University of North Dakota Hall of Famer, Don Gunhus. Victorious, the Magicians then met a talented Mandan Braves team in the semifinals. Having won their previous two engagements with the Braves, the Minot coaches feared winning three games against the Braves would be tough. Minot edged the Braves 47-42.

The championship game was one for the archives. Jamestown, a team coached by the legendary Jerry Meyer, held slight advantages at the first three quarter breaks. The fourth quarter saw several lead changes as the teams approached the final minute. Then, Blue Jays guard and future NFL player, Doug Beaudoin, hit a 20-foot jumper with 11 seconds on the clock. Trailing 64-63, Minot called a timeout. Following the inbounds pass, Minot guard Bud Snodgrass navigated the length of the floor to the right baseline where he passed to sophomore sensation, Wayne Whitty. Whitty then sank his fade away jump shot as time expired. The final score was 65-64.

1972 CLASS A BOYS BASKETBALL STATE CHAMPIONS BISMARCK ST. MARY'S SAINTS

50 Years Ago

The Bismarck St. Mary's boys basketball team proved to be a resilient bunch during the 1971-72 season. The Saints started the season 8-0 before a 54-52 loss to Fort Yates in the two squads' second meeting of the regular season. Fort Yates once again got the best of the Saints later in the regular season, but during the Class A Southwest Region Tournament semifinals St. Mary's edged Fort Yates 64-49 to earn a trip to the state tournament and win the season series 3-1 between the two schools.

St. Mary's fell to Dickinson Trinity 57-55 in double overtime of the Southwest Region championship game, but once again proved to have a short memory following a setback.

The 1972 NDHSAA Class A state tournament was played at the Bismarck Civic Center. Bismarck St. Mary's, Grand Forks Red River, Fargo North, Minot, Williston, Wahpeton, Dickinson Trinity and Langdon made up the tournament field.

St. Mary's opened with a 52-49 win over Grand Forks Red River and were led by John Thorpe who poured in 16 points. Next up was a meeting with Williston in the semifinals – a game in which four St. Mary's players (Thorpe-15, Dave Clark-14, Mike Thomas-12 and Steve McDonald-12) all scored in double figures to help the Saints to a 65-55 win over the Coyotes.

The Saints would meet Fargo North in the championship game. St. Mary's jumped out to a commanding 36-8 lead and never looked back. St. Mary's shot 81 percent (17 of 21) from the field in the first half against the Spartans and held a 43-18 lead at halftime. The Saints' were led by Clark who was six-for-eight from the field and led the team with 18 points. The final margin in the 1972 final was 72-48 in favor of St. Mary's who won its second state title in program history – the other coming in 1951. The Saints finished the 1971-72 season 23-4.

Mickey Jordan began officiating basketball in 1986 and continued to do so until his recent retirement following the 2019-2020 season.

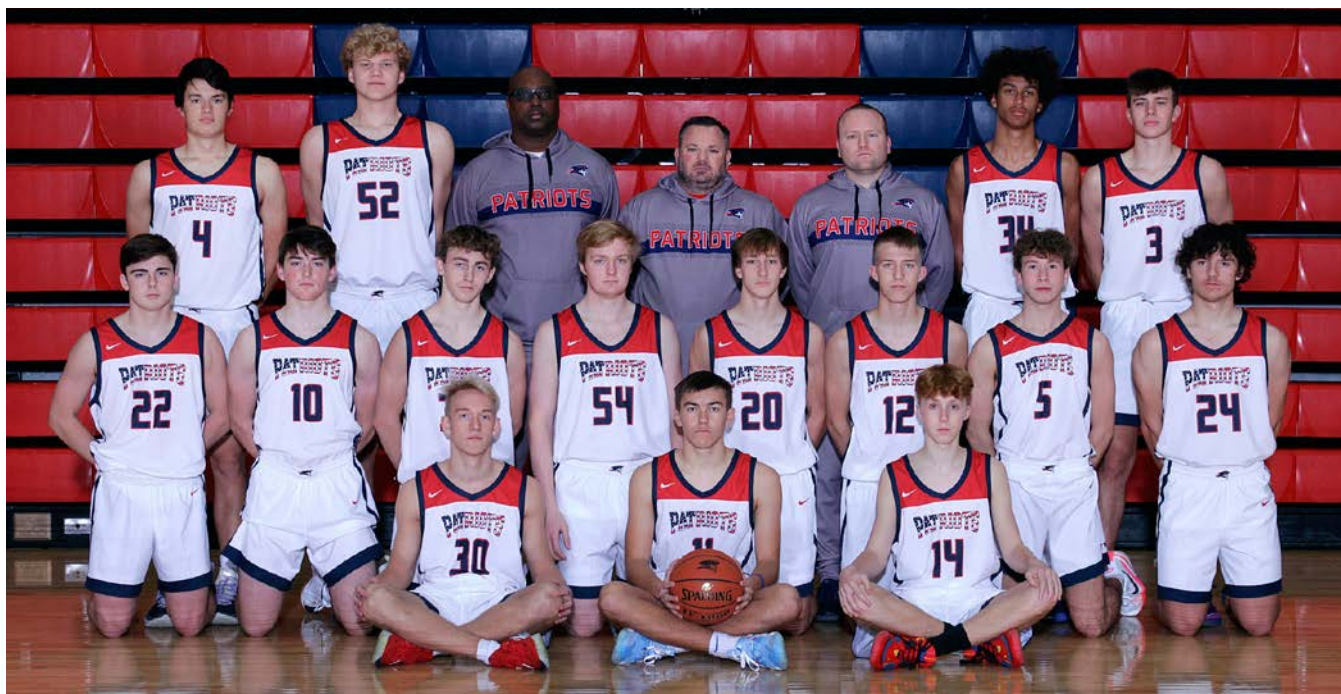

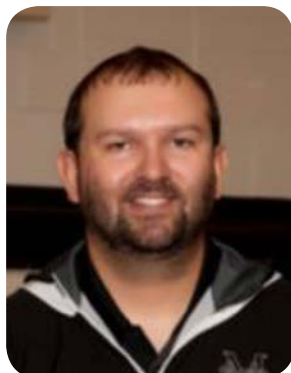

With a 1-2 punch of junior forward Kenny Younger and senior forward Dan Upton the Minot Magicians boys basketball team was a force to deal with on hardwood in 1995.

Minot, coached by Gene Manson, posted a 15-4 record in the regular season and would advance to the West Region Tournament championship game. The Magicians squared off against Bismarck High in the West Region final losing 70-61, however this wouldn't be the only time the two squads would meet in the postseason. Another meeting would take place the next week at the state tournament and a state championship would be on the line.

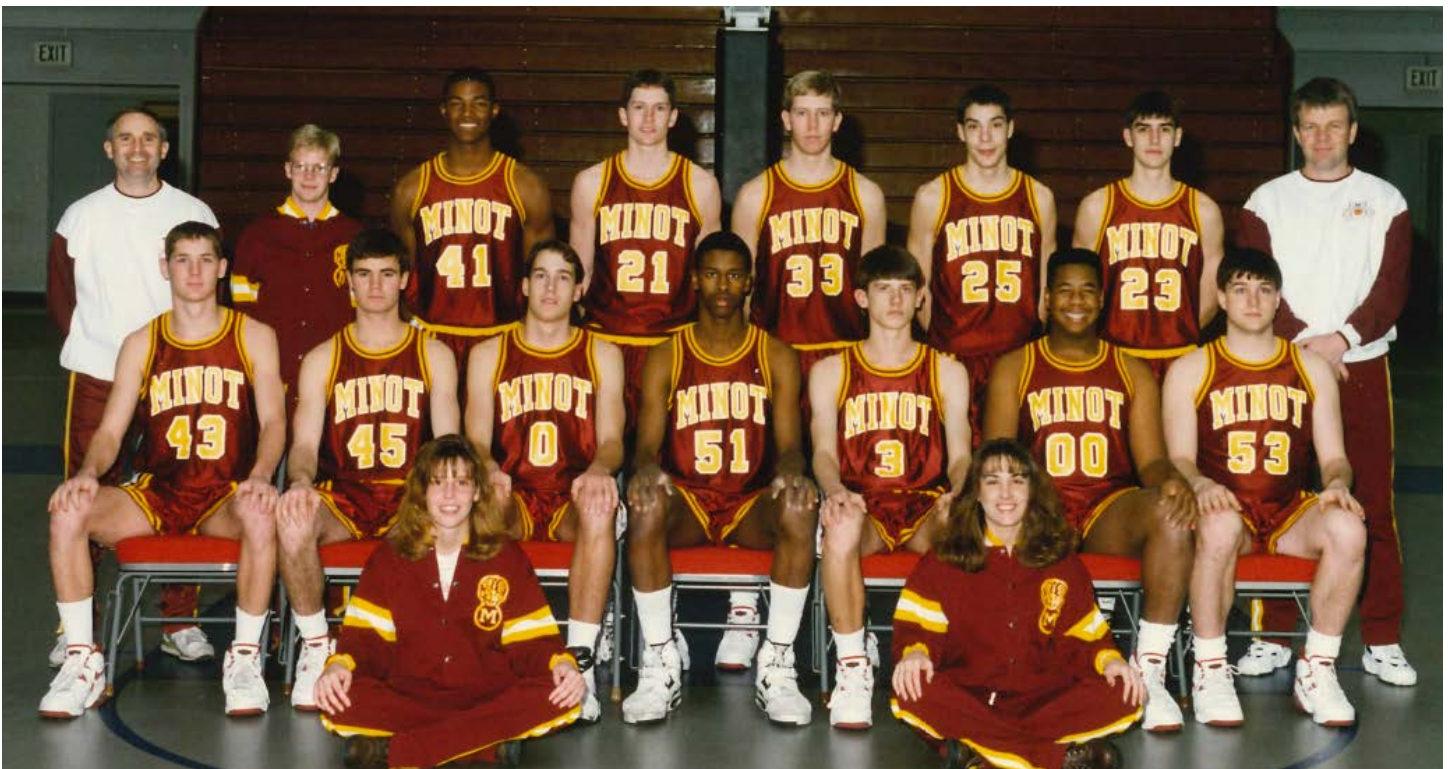
The 1995 Class A State Tournament field was made up of Minot, Bismarck High, Turtle Mountain (Belcourt), Bismarck Century, West Fargo, Fargo South, Valley City and Grand Forks Central.

The Magicians stood out among the crowd with Kenny Younger (19.9 points per game) and Mr. Basketball Finalist Dan Upton (17.5 ppg).

Minot would lock up with Grand Forks Central in the quarterfinals winning 68-44. In the semifinals, Minot met West Fargo High and kept rolling with a 76-48 victory. Bismarck High would win the other semifinal to set up the rematch of the West Region championship.

Minot would win the rematch 66-49 and win the program's 13th state championship and second state title of the 1990s.

The Magicians ended the season 20-5.

GRAND FORKS CENTRAL

The 1996 Grand Forks Central Knights entered the state tournament with a record of 18 – 4. The Knights were the Eastern Dakota Conference Champions and East Region Champions.

In the quarterfinals, Central faced the Williston Coyotes who were the number four seed from the West. After starting the game out strong, the Knights didn't score a field goal for a span of 11:05 in the second and third quarters and trailed by as many as 10 points before mounting a comeback. The comeback was capped by two Mark Hoverson free throws with 1.5 seconds remaining to give the Knights a 45 – 44 victory.

The semifinal match up was with the Mandan Braves who upset the favored Devils Lake Firebirds in triple overtime in the quarterfinals. The Knights jumped out to an early lead using a pressing up tempo style and cruised to a 64 – 48 victory behind Joe Ford's 16 points and 53% field goal shooting. The win earned Grand Forks Central their first championship game appearance since 1978 and a rematch with the Minot Magicians who had defeated the Knights 74 – 63 in the Minot Holiday Tournament.

The championship game was a match up featuring the No. 1 ranked and undefeated Minot Magicians and the No. 2 ranked Grand Forks Central Knights. Minot was trying to become just the third team in Class A history to go through a full season undefeated. Minot started the game by jumping out to a 14 – 3 lead only to have the Knights close the margin to 20 – 16 at the half. Central outscored the Magicians 15 – 7 in the third quarter to lead 31 – 27 with 8:00 to play. The lead went back and forth throughout the fourth quarter with the Knights leading 40 – 39 when Jon Hager was fouled with 10.2 seconds to play. Hager calmly hit both free throws to seal the win on his way to a 13 point performance. Minot missed on two late three point attempts and the Knights were STATE CHAMPIONS. Greg Mask led the Knights with 17 points and was named tournament MVP. He was joined on the All-Tournament Team by Joe Ford and Mark Hoverson.

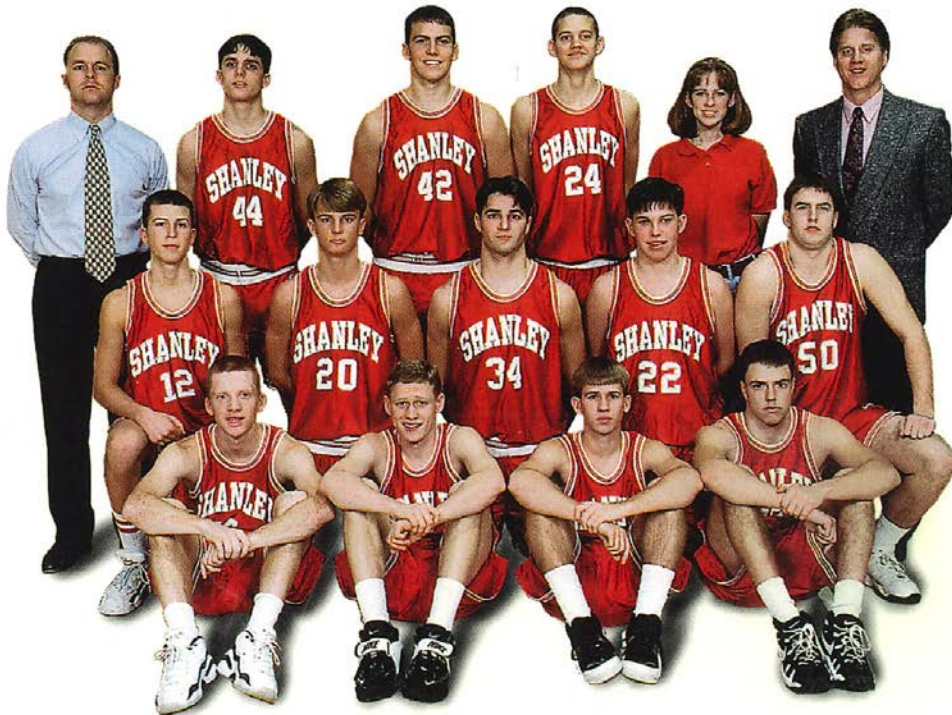
Fargo Shanley entered state with a 17-5 record and the East Region's No. 2 seed after suffering a 75-71 overtime loss to Valley City in the East Region Tournament championship game played at the Fargo Civic Center.

The Deacons were led by sophomore guard Nick Jacobson (22.2 points per game), senior forward Mark Fenstad (10.6 points per game) and sophomore guard Dan Dahl (10.2 points per game). Shanley opened the state tournament with a 76-60 win over Minot in the final quarterfinal game on Thursday night. The Deacons followed up their win over the Magicians with a 56-38 win over the West Fargo High in the semifinals.

The victory over the Packers earned the Deacons an appearance in the program's first state championship game since 1967. Shanley would make the most of the appearance by defeating Turtle Mountain (Belcourt) 70-62 for the program's first ever state championship.

Jacobson, Dahl and Paul Keller represented Fargo Shanley on the All-Tournament team. Jacobson earned Tournament MVP honors averaging 26.6 points per game scored in three games played at the Bismarck Civic Center.

Following the state tournament Jacobson earned NDAPSSA All-State First Team honors and Dahl was named to the All-State Second Team. Shanley finished the season 20-5.

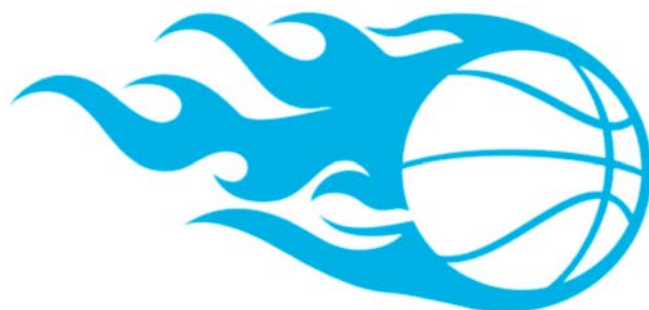

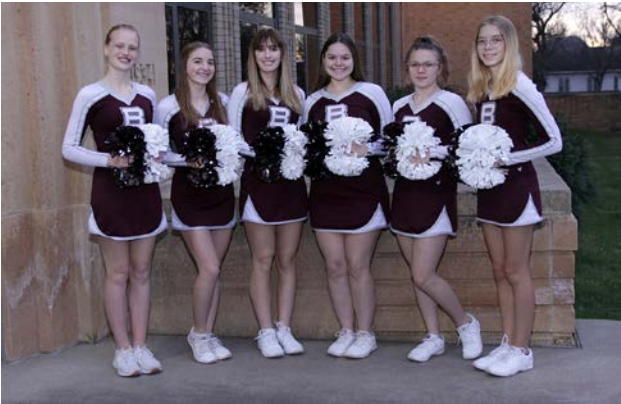

NDHSAA MINIMAL BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS FOR REGULAR AND POSTSEASON COMPETITIONS:

- Respect the American flag and the National Anthem.
 - Contesting schools shall each have an authorized faculty representative present who shall be responsible for his/her school's participants, students, and fans throughout the contest.
 - Spectators must wear clothing that covers the entire torso. Those who do not comply or who wear clothing that is vulgar, obscene or that in some other way inappropriate, as determined by school/tournament personnel, will be removed from the facility if they do not cooperate with this behavior expectation.
 - The use of appropriate language is expected at all times. Profanity, negative chants, trash talk, name-calling, personal attacks or other acts of disrespect are unacceptable and must be immediately addressed by school/tournament administrators.
 - Any attendee ejected from a NDHSAA tournament venue will be banned from the venue(s) for the remainder of the event.
 - Respect the game/contest. Under no condition shall anyone other than the members of the official squad enter the playing surface. No one may interfere with the contest in any way.
 - Hand held signs and flags, which do not obstruct the view of others, are permitted provided they are in good taste. Signs or other similar items contest/tournament officials deem to be in poor taste will be removed. Message or "white" boards are prohibited. The carrying of flags around the playing surface is NOT allowed.
 - Artificial noisemakers of any kind (i.e. megaphones, cowbells, sirens, whistles, thunder sticks, and other similar items) are not allowed at any indoor events, including outdoor sports played at indoor venues. Exception – Megaphones appropriately used by cheerleaders are permitted if allowed by contest officials.
 - Laser lights or any other lights deemed distracting to participants are strictly prohibited.
 - Confetti is banned at all NDHSAA tournament venues. Tournament staff is instructed to confiscate such articles at the door.
 - Objects shall not be thrown into the stands at any NDHSAA tournament venue.
 - The use of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAV), also known as drones, is prohibited for any persons at NDHSAA tournament venues.

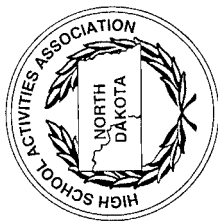

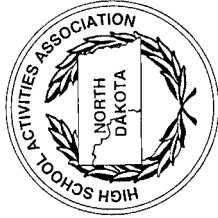
