#### MINIMAL BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS FOR REGULAR AND POSTSEASON COMPETITIONS

- · Respect the American flag and the National Anthem.
- · Contesting schools shall each have an authorized faculty representative present who shall be responsible for his/her school's participants, students, and fans throughout the contest.
- · Spectators must wear clothing that covers the entire torso. Those who do not comply or who wear clothing that is vulgar, obscene or that in some other way inappropriate, as determined by school/tournament personnel, will be removed from the facility if they do not cooperate with this behavior expectation.
- The use of appropriate language is expected at all times. Profanity, negative chants, trash talk, name-calling, personal attacks or other acts of disrespect are unacceptable and must be immediately addressed by school/tournament administrators.
- · Any attendee ejected from a NDHSAA tournament venue will be banned from the venue(s) for the remainder of the event.
- Respect the game/contest. Under no condition shall anyone other than the members of the official squad enter the playing surface. No one may interfere with the contest in any way.

- Hand held signs and flags, which do not obstruct the view of others, are permitted provided they are in good taste. Signs or other similar items contest/tournament officials deem to be in poor taste will be removed. Message or "white" boards are prohibited. The carrying of flags around the playing surface is NOT allowed.
- · Artificial noisemakers of any kind (i.e. megaphones, cowbells, sirens, whistles, thunder sticks, and other similar items) are not allowed at any indoor events, including outdoor sports played at indoor venues. Exception-Megaphones appropriately used by cheerleaders are permitted if allowed by contest officials.
- · Laser lights or any other lights deemed distracting to participants are strictly prohibited.
- · Confetti is banned at all NDHSAA tournament venues. Tournament staff is instructed to confiscate such articles at the door.
- · Objects shall not be thrown into the stands at any NDHSAA tournament venue.
- The use of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAV), also known as drones, is prohibited for any persons at NDHSAA tournament venues.



#### 1997 Class A Boys Basketball State Champions – Fargo Shanley Deacons

The 1997 NDHSAA Class A Boys Basketball State Tournament was played at the Bismarck Civic Center. Fargo Shanley, Valley City, West Fargo High, Grand Forks Central, Turtle Mountain (Belcourt), Bismarck High, Bismarck Century and Minot made up the tournament field.

Fargo Shanley entered state with a 17-5 record and the East Region's No. 2 seed after suffering a 75-71 overtime loss to Valley City in the East Region Tournament championship game played at the Fargo Civic Center.


The Deacons were led by sophomore guard Nick Jacobson (22.2 points per game), senior forward Mark Fenstad (10.6 points per game) and sophomore guard Dan Dahl (10.2 points per game). Shanley opened the state tournament with a 76-60 win over Minot in the final quarterfinal game on Thursday night. The Deacons followed up their win over the Magicians with a 56-38 win over the West Fargo High in the semifinals.

The victory over the Packers earned the Deacons an appearance in the program's first state championship game since 1967. Shanley would make the most of the appearance by defeating Turtle Mountain (Belcourt) 70-62 for the program's first ever state championship.

Jacobson, Dahl and Paul Keller represented Fargo Shanley on the All-Tournament team. Jacobson earned Tournament MVP honors averaging 26.6 points per game scored in three games played at the Bismarck Civic Center.

Following the state tournament Jacobson earned NDAPSSA All-State First Team honors and Dahl was named to the All-State Second Team. Shanley finished the season 20-5.

#### 1998 Class A Boys Basketball State Champions - Fargo Shanley Deacons

The 1998 NDHSAA Class A Boys Basketball State Tournament was played at the Bismarck Civic Center. Fargo Shanley, Valley City, Wahpeton, Devils Lake, Bismarck High, Williston, Bismarck Century and Minot made up the tournament field.

Entering the State Tournament, defending Class A state champion Fargo Shanley was the No. 2 seed from the East Region after losing to Devils Lake 76-64 in the East Region title game a week prior at the Fargo Civic Center.

The Deacons' opponent in the quarterfinals was West Region No. 3 seed Williston. Shanley defeated the Coyotes 66-48 and followed up that victory with a 65-49 win over Bismarck High the next night in the semifinals.

The state championship game would be a rematch of the East Region final – Shanley vs. Devils Lake.

Shanley took an early 21-16 lead in the game's opening quarter. At halftime the game had tightened to a 38-35 Deacons advantage. By the end of the third quarter Shanley held a slim 52-50 lead, but would pull away in the fourth quarter to win 77-66 and capture the repeat state championship.

The Deacons were led by Nick Jacobson who finished the game with 35 points, eight rebounds and three assists. Adam Jacobson finished with 13 points and Dan Dahl scored 10 points with five assists. Ryan Danielson added nine points and eight rebounds for the Deacons.

In the State tournament, Nick Jacobson averaged 33 points per game and was named Tournament MVP following the championship game. Nick Jacobson also earned NDAPSSA All-State First Team honors and was an All-Eastern Dakota Conference selection. Dan Dahl was named to the NDAPSSA All-State Second Team.

Shanley was the first team to repeat as state champions since West Fargo High went back-to-back in 1991 and 1992.

The Deacons were back in a state championship game for the second year in a row and their opponent would once again be Mandan – a rematch from the 1996 championship game.

Shanley would capture the repeat championship by defeating the Braves 46-43 in the title game. Following the game, the Deacons trio of Angie Welle, Nikki Leier and Megan Clark were named to the All-Tournament Team. Welle took home Tournament MVP honors for the third straight season. Head coach Rick Fletcher won NDHSCA Coach of the Year honors.

Shanley finished the 1997 season 22-2.

Welle earned NDAPSSA First Team All-State honors and also won the NDAPSSA Miss Basketball Award at the end of the season. Leier was a NDAPSSA All-State second team selection.
