





The Watford City Wolves capped a championship season with a victory over the Munich Magicians at the MSU Dome in March of 1991. The Wolves defeated Litchville in the opening round (64-54) and Steele-Dawson in the semi-finals (63-50).

The title game was a much closer affair with the Wolves attempting to hold down Munich's Marty McDonald.

McDonald held game-high scoring honors with 22 points but the Magicians couldn't handle the balanced attack of the Wolves. Senior David Leom and Junior guard Fred Fridley led the Wolves in scoring with 20 points each. The win capped a perfect season for Watford City at 27-0. Other teams in the 1991 state tournament were: Leeds, Central Cass, Westhope-Souris and Reeder.

Fort Yates won the 1956 State Class B title by defeating St. Thomas by a score of 56-54. The 1956 tournament was held in Grand Forks. The Warriors defeated Washburn and St. Mary's in the first two rounds of the tournament.

The 1956 title was the first Class B basketball championship for the Warriors who proudly represented the Standing Rock Indian Reservation. Other teams in the 1956 tournament were: Lansford, Hunter, Ashley and Enderlin.

The Kenmare Honkers won their second consecutive state title and their third title in four years by defeating Milnor in the 1966 championship game at the Minot Auditorium. Milnor was no match for the mighty Honkers as the Kenmare squad won by a score of 69-41. Kenmare had defeated St. Mary's of New England (47-45) and Langdon (43-38) on their way to the title game. The Honkers ended the season with a 27-1 record with their lone loss coming at the hands of Fessenden in a regular season overtime game. Other teams in the 1966 state tournament were: Parshall, Cooperstown, Fessenden and Linton.


**Rick Smith**




Mike Dwyer






Kacy Keysor





# North Dakota Officials Association Hall of Fame Inductees




## Ron Seeley – Williston

Ron Seeley was born in Grand Forks, and graduated from St. Paul Harding High School in 1971. He went on to play baseball at UND, graduating in 1975. After graduating from Creighton Dental School in 1980, he began his private practice in Williston where he worked for 35 years.

As an official, Ron worked almost every Class A State Baseball Tournament from when it was sanctioned until 2006. His football crew also worked numerous playoff games, including four State Championship games. In addition, he worked one American Legion World Series, and three Legion National Regionals. Seeley was the President of the Williston Officials Association for many years.

He is a retired dentist, and he and his wife Kathy have three children Bryan, Amanda, and Alaina, and six grandchildren.



## Mark Luther – Minot

Mark Luther officiated baseball for 37 years, finally retiring last spring after the State B Tournament. Mark umpired in over 20 State High School Tournaments, and numerous State and Midwest Regional Legion Tournaments.

Mark is also a member of the American Legion Baseball Hall of Fame in North Dakota. Mark is retired, and he and his wife Judy have two daughters, Nicole and Sarah.

The NDOA has inducted 132 officials into its Hall of Fame since the inaugural class in 1965. Plaques commemorating all Hall of Fame members are housed in the North Dakota Athletic Hall of Fame, located inside the Jamestown Civic Center.



# A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE NORTH DAKOTA HIGH SCHOOL ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATION

The activities association was founded in 1908 under the name of the High School League and originally was concerned only with athletics. In 1923 the state organization became affiliated with the National Federation of High School Athletic Associations. A full-time executive director was employed in 1949, and assistant was added in 1963, a girls' sports supervisor in 1973, and a music and speech coordinator in 1978.

In 1950 the Consolidated League, an organization of the smaller schools of the state, affiliated with the High Schools League, thereby uniting all high schools of the state under one organization. Music and speech activities were placed under the direction of the Association in 1955, and the name was changed to the North Dakota High School Activities Association at that time. Schools in the League were all one class for basketball competition from 1908 to 1932. A two-class system was used from 1933 to 1947 and a three- class system from 1948 to 1963. In 1964 the two-class system was restored and this arrangement has been in effect since then up to the present time. Official state champions have been named in track since 1908 and in basketball since 1914. Official champions in other sports were later added as follows: golf and tennis 1938, baseball 1950; wrestling 1959; cross country 1961; hockey 1967; girls' track, golf and tennis 1966; girls' gymnastics 1969; girls' basketball 1974; boys & girls' swimming 1974. State football champions were determined off and on between 1916 and 1959, when the practice was discontinued, but again restored in 1975.

Basketball tournaments for girls were conducted by the Consolidated League for a number of years and by the NDHSAA from 1952 to 1960, at which time they were discontinued because of the small number of schools fielding teams. Girls' basketball was reinstated as an Association-sponsored activity in 1973 on a district level, with separate state Class A and Class B champions being named since 1974. Class A girls' volleyball state champions were first named in 1984 and Class B girls' volleyball state champions were first named in 1989. Boys' state soccer champions were first named in 1995 and girls' state soccer champions in 1996. Girls' state hockey champions were first named in 2003. Girls' softball champions were first named in 2009 with separated Division A & B champions in 2012.
