



- Show a positive attitude in cheering, refraining from intimidation or negative cheering. Good Sportsmanship is cheering your own team "on to victory."


#### Acts of Misconduct






# A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE NORTH DAKOTA HIGH SCHOOL **ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATION**

The activities association was founded in 1908 under the name of the High School League and originally was concerned only with athletics. In 1923, the state organization became affiliated with the National Federation of High School Athletic Associations. A full-time executive director was employed in 1949, and assistant was added in 1963, a girls' sports supervisor in 1973, and a music and speech coordinator in 1978.

In 1950, the Consolidated League, an organization of the smaller schools of the state, affiliated with the High Schools League, thereby uniting all high schools of the state under one organization. Music and speech activities were placed under the direction of the Association in 1955, and the name was changed to the North Dakota High School Activities Association at that time. Schools in the League were all one class for basketball competition from 1908 to 1932. A two- class system was used from 1933 to 1947 and a three- class system from 1948 to 1963. In 1964, the two-class system was restored and this arrangement has been in effect since then up to the present time. Official state champions have been named in track since 1908 and in basketball since 1914. Official champions in other sports were later added as follows: golf and tennis 1938, baseball 1950; wrestling 1959; cross country 1961; hockey 1967; girls' track, golf and tennis 1966; girls' gymnastics 1969; girls' basketball 1974; boys & girls' swimming 1974. State football champions were determined off and on between 1916 and 1959, when the practice was discontinued, but again restored in 1975. Basketball tournaments for girls were conducted by the Consolidated League for a number of years and by the NDHSAA from 1952 to 1960, at which time they were discontinued because of the small number of schools fielding teams. Girls' basketball was reinstated as an Association-sponsored activity in 1973 on a district level, with separate state Class A and Class B champions being named since 1974. Class A girls' volleyball state champions were first named in 1984 and Class B girls' volleyball state champions were first named in 1989. Boys' state soccer champions were first named in 1995 and girls' state soccer champions in 1996. Girls' state hockey champions were first named in 2003. Girls' softball champions were first named in 2009 with separated Division A & B champions in 2012.



# A 25 YEAR TRIBUTE TO THE PAST

The 1993 Lady Lions won regular season and district championships battling with many outstanding teams. One of those teams was the Westhope Sioux. The Lions would face them in an epic battle to win the Region 8 title at the Phil Jackson Fieldhouse in Williston. Bishop Ryan overcame an eight-point deficit in the last three minutes of the game to obtain its first State Class B Tournament berth and first trip to a state girls basketball tournament in 11 years after qualifying for the Class A state tournament in 1982.

The 1993 NDHSAA Class B State Tournament was held across the street from the Bishop Ryan campus at the Minot State Dome, giving the team a home court feel and a tremendous fan backing.

In the quarterfinals, the Lions were powered by Kara Bailey's triple double leading the team to a 39-27 victory over Thompson. Bailey scored 17 points, had 15 rebounds and an incredible 10 blocked shots — a remarkable individual effort that sent the Lions to the semifinals.

In the semifinal nightcap Bishop Ryan led Milnor 31-30 going into the fourth quarter and grinded out a defensive battle with a stingy man-to-man defense to win 44-38. Kara Bailey had 12 points and 17 rebounds, and Marisa Albertson scored 8 of her 11 points in the fourth quarter to lead the Lions into the state championship game against the undefeated New Salem Holsteins. In the title game Bishop Ryan ended New Salem's amazing run at a perfect season with 40-39 victory in a title game thriller. The Lions led by as many as 11 points in the first half, but a determined New Salem team cut the deficit to 23-21 at the half. The Lions pushed the lead to 36-31 at the end of the third quarter with a buzzer beater by Kara Bailey off a perfect full-court pass from Jessica Hackett and screen by Aimee Limke.

New Salem would have a shot to win it down by one with under ten seconds, but the Lions defense held and the championship was secured. Kara Bailey led the team with 19 points and 14 rebounds and Steph Nitch added eight points for the champions. The title win would set the stage for a year in which The Bishop Ryan Lions would win both the Girls and Boys State Class B basketball titles. It was the first state title for the Lady Lions.
