1999 Class B Boys Basketball State Champions

The Leeds Lions

After losing to Standing Rock in the 1998 NDHSAA Class B boys basketball state championship game, the Leeds Lions were on a mission to return to the state tournament and get another opportunity to play in a state title game in 1999.

The Lions were a veteran squad with high expectations to begin the 1998-99 season. Leeds, led by senior NDAPSSA Mr. Basketball finalist Brett Moser, had qualified for the state tournament in 1997 and 1998 so the Lions also were seasoned in postseason play.

After an early setback to Stanley in the regular season, Leeds would go onto win its final 17 games prior to the district tournament. A 52-42 win over Cando in its district tournament championship game gave the Lions plenty of steam heading into the Region 4 Tournament in Devils Lake.

Leeds would meet Cando again in the Region 4 championship game winning 73-62 to send Shawn Larson's Lions back to the "B" for a chance to win a state title that had narrowly eluded them in 1998.

Joining Leeds at the 1999 Class B Boys Basketball State Tournament were Bishop Ryan, Center, Dickinson Trinity, Hillsboro, Litchville-Marion/Montpelier, Lisbon and Mandaree.

Entering the State Tournament, Leeds' top scorers were Moser (22 points per game), Travis Wiberg (9.7 ppg) and Shane Anderson (8.8 ppg).

Leeds would open with a 77-63 victory over Mandaree in the quarterfinals and would follow up with a 50-46 overtime victory over Center in the semifinals.

Waiting for Leeds in the state title game would be undefeated, No. 1-ranked Dickinson Trinity.

The Lions found themselves in a tight championship contest with the Titans. Trailing Trinity 53-51 in the final minute, the Lions took their time on what would be their most important offensive possession of the season. The Lions' patience paid off as senior forward Shane Anderson hit an open 3-pointer with 14 seconds remaining. Anderson's 3-pointer gave Leeds a 54-53 lead and sent the Bismarck Civic Center into a frenzy.

Leeds would block Trinity's ensuing game-winning attempt on the other end and held on for the 54-53 victory behind a 23-point effort by Moser.

The state championship was the second in program history for Leeds, who had previously won a Class B state title in 1954.

Leeds finished the season 27-1.

NDHSAA BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS FOR REGULAR AND POSTSEASON COMPETITIONS:

- Respect the American flag and the National Anthem.
- Contesting schools shall each have an authorized faculty representative present who shall be responsible for his/her school's participants, students, and fans throughout the contest.
- Spectators must wear appropriate clothing. Those who do not comply or who wear clothing that is vulgar, obscene or that in some other way inappropriate, as determined by school/tournament personnel, will be removed from the facility if they do not cooperate with this behavior expectation.
- The use of appropriate language is expected at all times. Profanity, negative chants, trash talk, name-calling, personal attacks or other acts of disrespect are unacceptable and must be immediately addressed by school/tournament administrators. Any discriminatory slur will result in immediate removal from the facility.
- Any attendee ejected from a NDHSAA tournament venue will be banned from the venue(s) for the remainder of the event.
- Respect the game/contest. Under no condition shall anyone other than the members of the official squad enter the playing surface. No one may interfere with the contest in any way.
- Handheld signs and flags, which do not obstruct the view of others, are permitted provided they are in good taste. Signs or other similar items contest/tournament officials deem to be in poor taste will be removed. Message or "white" boards are prohibited. The carrying of flags around the playing surface is NOT allowed.
- Artificial noisemakers of any kind (i.e. megaphones, cowbells, sirens, whistles, thunder sticks, and other similar items) are not allowed at any indoor events, including outdoor sports played at indoor venues. Exception – Megaphones appropriately used by cheerleaders are permitted if allowed by contest officials.
- Laser lights or any other lights deemed distracting to participants are strictly prohibited.
- The use of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAV), also known as drones, is prohibited at all contests.
