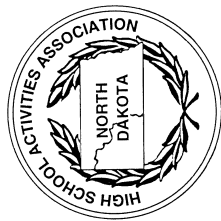

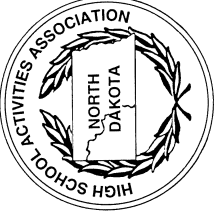

NDHSAA MINIMAL BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS FOR REGULAR AND POSTSEASON COMPETITIONS:

- Respect the American flag and the National Anthem.
- Contesting schools shall each have an authorized faculty representative present who shall be responsible for his/her school's participants, students, and fans throughout the contest.
- Spectators must wear clothing that covers the entire torso. Those who do not comply or who wear clothing that is vulgar, obscene or that in some other way inappropriate, as determined by school/tournament personnel, will be removed from the facility if they do not cooperate with this behavior expectation.
- The use of appropriate language is expected at all times. Profanity, negative chants, trash talk, name-calling, personal attacks or other acts of disrespect are unacceptable and must be immediately addressed by school/tournament administrators.
- Any attendee ejected from a NDHSAA tournament venue will be banned from the venue(s) for the remainder of the event.
- Respect the game/contest. Under no condition shall anyone other than the members of the official squad enter the playing surface. No one may interfere with the contest in any way.
- Hand held signs and flags, which do not obstruct the view of others, are permitted provided they are in good taste. Signs or other similar items contest/tournament officials deem to be in poor taste will be removed. Message or "white" boards are prohibited. The carrying of flags around the playing surface is NOT allowed.
- Artificial noisemakers of any kind (i.e. megaphones, cowbells, sirens, whistles, thunder sticks, and other similar items) are not allowed at any indoor events, including outdoor sports played at indoor venues. Exception – Megaphones appropriately used by cheerleaders are permitted if allowed by contest officials.
- Laser lights or any other lights deemed distracting to participants are strictly prohibited.
- Confetti is banned at all NDHSAA tournament venues. Tournament staff is instructed to confiscate such articles at the door.
- Objects shall not be thrown into the stands at any NDHSAA tournament venue.
- The use of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAV), also known as drones, is prohibited for any persons at NDHSAA tournament venues.

1998 CLASS A GIRLS BASKETBALL CHAMPIONS WEST FARGO PACKERS

The 1998 season was a record-breaking season for the West Fargo High girls basketball team as the team won the Eastern Dakota Conference regular season championship with a 15-0 conference record. The Packers became the first girls basketball team in conference history to garner all 20 possible conference points in the regular season standings.

The Packers won the 1998 Class A, East Region Girls Basketball Tournament and went on to capture the program's second NDHSAA Class A girls basketball state title.

Seniors Meg Holle and Amy Triepke were co-captains for the Packers in 1998. The roster was loaded with talent as multiple players led the team in different statistical categories.

Triepke led the team in assists with 85 and Amanda Krenz led the Packers in steals with 47, points scored 225, and free-throw percentage with 83.1 percent. Krenz also set a program record for career free-throw shooting percentage. Holle led the Packers in rebounds with 126 and Kristen Davidson led the team in 3-point shooting percentage.

As the top East Region seed at State, the Packers defeated Bismarck St. Mary's 52-44 in the quarterfinals and followed up with a 58-43 victory against Bismarck Century in the semifinals.

In the championship at the Jamestown Civic Center, West Fargo High would meet Mandan – a rematch of the 1995 state title game, which the Braves won. By 1998, Mandan had played in four straight Class A state title games losing the Shanley in back-to-back appearances in 1996 and 1997.

The 1998 meeting would go the Packers' way by a score of 39-38. Holle, Krenz, and Triepke were named to the All-Tournament Team following the championship game.

The Packers finished the 1998 season with a 23-2 record – the best win-loss record in program history up to that point, and closed out the season with 22 straight wins, which also set a program record for consecutive games won.

Holle and Krenz were All-EDC Conference selections. Head Coach Collette Folstad was named East Region Coach of the Year and Class A Coach of the Year.

1999 CLASS A BOYS BASKETBALL CHAMPIONS

MINOT MAGICIANS

The Minot High Magicians boys basketball team leaned on its veteran leadership and precision shooting during the 1998-99 season.

Five senior starters – Kent Bloms, Jeff Brandt, Mark Olson, Casey Olson and Steve Grabowski – led Minot High to an impressive list of accomplishments that included a 25-1 win-loss record, a Western Dakota Association (WDA) regular season championship, a West Region Tournament championship and ultimately a Class A state championship.

Minot High set team records for 3-pointers made in a season (217) and 3-pointers made in a single game (16) against Williston late in the season. Grabowski accounted for 73 3-pointers, which set an individual single-season program record. Grabowski also set a single-game program record for 3-pointers in a single game with 10. Brandt, who won NDAPSSA Mr. Basketball honors in 1999, also contributed to the Magicians' shooting prowess ending his impressive prep career with 141 3-pointers, which was a team record.

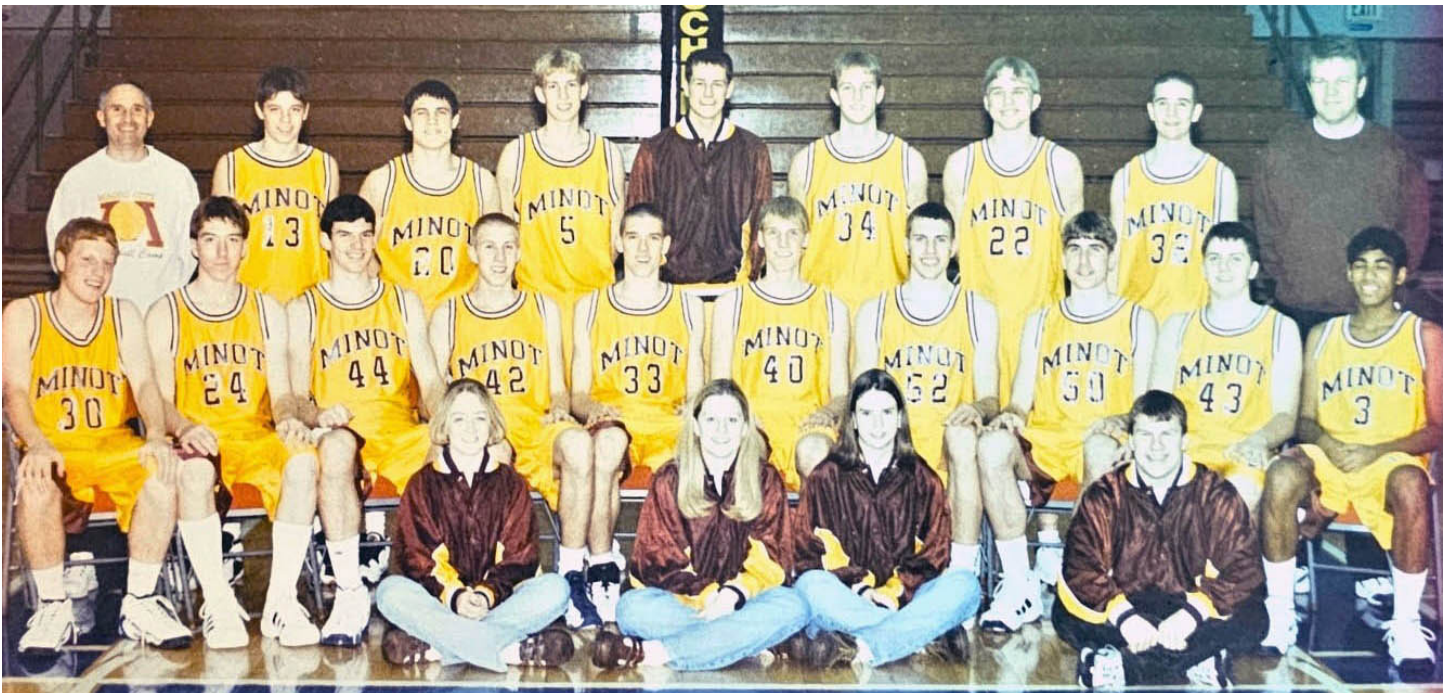
With its senior-laden squad Minot High was a tough squad to defeat. Only one team – Bismarck St. Mary's – got the best of the Magicians, but by the time the postseason rolled around Minot High was playing championship-caliber basketball.

After winning the West Region Championship, Minot High hit the road traveling to Fargo for the 1999 NDHSAA Class A State Tournament at the FARGODOME.

At State, the Magicians opened with a 78-55 win against Valley City in the quarterfinals and followed up with a 70-50 win over Bismarck Century in the semifinals.

Minot High would meet Devils Lake in the Class A state championship game and would emerge victorious for the program's 14th Class A boys basketball state championship and 15th overall boys basketball state title.

Magicians head coach Gene Manson earned coach of the year honors. Bloms, Brandt, and Grabowski were named All-WDA selections. Brandt and Olson earned NDAPSSA All-State First Team honors and Bloms was a NDAPSSA All-State Second Team honoree.

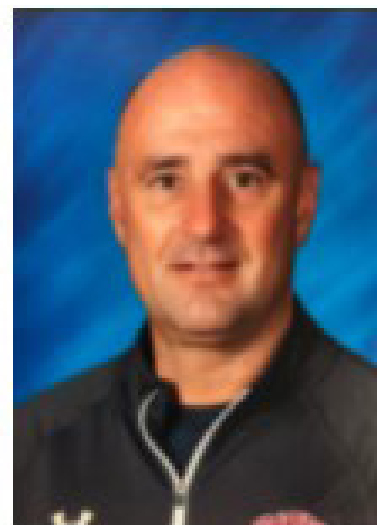

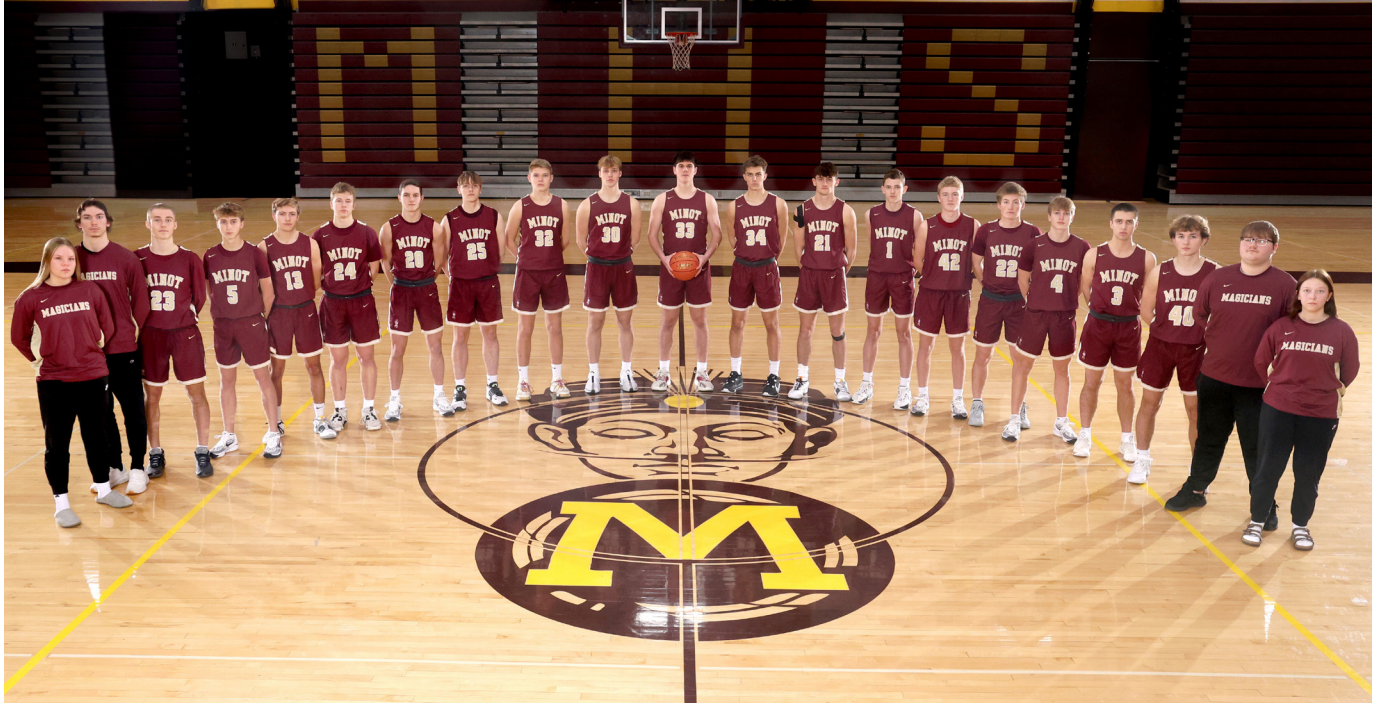

1974 CLASS A BOYS BASKETBALL CHAMPIONS GRAND FORKS CENTRAL

Defense was the calling card of the Grand Forks Central boys basketball team during the 1973-74 season. Central was geared around getting stops and making opponents feel anything but comfortable running offenses against them.

The commitment to playing superb defense took Central to the top as it finished the 1973-74 season with a 21-5 record and a NDH-SAA Class A boys basketball state championship.

Central defeated Devils Lake 58-50 to capture the Class A Northeast Region Tournament Championship and headed to Fargo for the 1974 NDHSAA Class A Boys basketball State Tournament which was held at the NDSU Fieldhouse.

Joining Central at the 1974 Class A State Tournament were Devils Lake, Williston, Bismarck High, Dickinson, Jamestown, Minot High and Wahpeton. Central opened the tournament with a 65-54 win over Bismarck High in the quarterfinals and followed up with a 51-47 victory over Jamestown in the semifinals. Waiting for Central in the championship game was Wahpeton, who had entered the state tournament as the top-ranked team in the final Class A media poll.

Staying true to its defensive philosophy, Central got to work disrupting Wahpeton from doing the things it did best. Central clamped down early and stayed stingy on defense wire to wire. Wahpeton didn't score until four minutes, 48 seconds had elapsed in the game.

Wahpeton never led at any point in the game and closest margin it got to within Central was 49-46 in the second half. Central neutralized Wahpeton's top scoring threat Perry Score, who had combined to score 41 points in Wahpeton's first two games of the state tournament. In the state title game, Score was held to seven points and wasn't able to get many good shooting opportunities.

Wahpeton was 7 of 22 shooting in the first half and allowed Central the opening it needed to separate for an eventual 54-46 victory.

Central was balanced on the offensive end in the state championship game with four players finishing in double figures. Scott Rowe and Bob Demmers led Central with 14 points while Mitch Gibbs and Steve Halas each had 10 points. Rowe also paced Central with 10 rebounds in the championship. Halas and Demmers were named to the All-Tournament team following the championship game.
