Behavior Expectations for Regular & Postseason Competitions

- Respect the American flag and the National Anthem.
- Contesting schools shall each have an authorized faculty representative present who shall be responsible for his/her school's participants, students, and fans throughout the contest.
- Spectators must wear clothing that covers the entire torso. Those who do not comply or who wear clothing that is vulgar, obscene or that in some other way inappropriate, as determined by school/tournament personnel, will be removed from the facility if they do not cooperate with this behavior expectation.
- The use of appropriate language is expected at all times. Profanity, negative chants, trash talk, name-calling, personal attacks or other acts of disrespect are unacceptable and must be immediately addressed by school/tournament administrators. Any discriminatory slur will result in immediate removal from the facility.
- Any attendee ejected from a NDHSAA tournament venue will be banned from the venue(s) for the remainder of the event.
- Respect the game/contest. Under no condition shall anyone other than the members of the official squad enter the playing surface. No one may interfere with the contest in any way.
- Handheld signs and flags, which do not obstruct the view of others, are permitted provided they are in good taste. Signs or other similar items contest/tournament officials deem to be in poor taste will be removed. Message or "white" boards are prohibited. The carrying of flags around the playing surface is NOT allowed.
- Artificial noisemakers of any kind (i.e. megaphones, cowbells, sirens, whistles, thunder sticks, and other similar items) are not allowed at any indoor events, including outdoor sports played at indoor venues. Exception – Megaphones appropriately used by cheerleaders are permitted if allowed by contest officials.
- Laser lights or any other lights deemed distracting to participants are strictly prohibited.
- Confetti is banned at all NDHSAA tournament venues. Tournament staff are instructed to confiscate such articles at the door.
- Objects shall not be thrown into the stands at any NDHSAA tournament venue.
- The use of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAV), also known as drones, is prohibited for any persons at NDHSAA tournament venues.

1974 WILLISTON COYOTES

The 1975 NDHSAA Class A Boys Basketball State Tournament was played at the NDSU Fieldhouse in Fargo and the eight teams that qualified were Williston, Grand Forks Central, West Fargo High, Dickinson Trinity, Dickinson High, Jamestown, Grand Forks Red River, and Minot High.

The tournament's opening game featured defending state champion Grand Forks Central matching up against Jim McPherson's Williston squad, who were coming off a 69-53 win over Minot High in the Northwest Region final a week prior.

Against Central, the Coyotes clamped down on defense and held a 28-9 lead at halftime. Ultimately, Williston would grab a 61-40 win in the quarterfinals after having five players score in double figures with the entire team shooting better than 50 percent from the field.

Williston's balanced offensive attack was once again on display during the team's 46-33 win over Dickinson Trinity in the semifinals. Duane Boeck led the Coyotes with 10 points. Rik Fee added nine points and the trio of Kevin Spooner, Tom Conlin and Bruce Beaudry each finished with eight points respectively.

Williston had qualified for the state championship game for the first time since winning the 1968 Class A state title and would be playing a very talented Dickinson High team in the 1975 final.

Dickinson and Williston had battled each other in close games for two years, and the meeting the state championship game seemed inevitable. Both teams had largely started the same players for two years, and there were multiple All-State players on both teams. Dickinson led much of the game, but the Coyotes rallied to gain the lead in the final minutes. Williston Head Coach Jim McPherson, with assistant coach Gary Knutson, devised a good game plan focused on defending Dickinson with a zone defense that was hard to penetrate, slowing down Dickinson's gifted scorers.

In an "Instant Classic," the 1975 Williston Coyotes boys basketball team defeated the Dickinson Midgets by only one point, 45-44. Dickinson's final shot at the buzzer drew iron but missed, and Williston's one-point victory was secured. All-State player Kevin Spooner scored 19 points in the victory. All-State forwards Bruce Beaudry and Gene Johnson also played key scoring and hustle roles in the Coyotes' victory, while center Duane Boeck anchored the middle for the Coyotes. Defensive stalwart, Tom Conlin made the winning free throw. Williston finished the season 21-4.

REUNION TEAM

2000 BISMARCK HIGH DEMONS

The turn of the new century and the new millennium was kind to the Bismarck High Demons.

Bismarck High would put together the program's finest seasons during the 1999-2000 campaign and it all culminated with an impressive showing at the 2000 NDHSAA Class A Boys Basketball State Tournament.

The 2000 state tournament field was made up of Valley City, Minot High, Fargo South, Beulah, Devils Lake, Bismarck Century, Wahpeton and Bismarck High.

The Demons entered state with a 22-1 record with its lone loss coming against an out-of-state opponent. All the momentum the Demons had from winning the West Region Tournament championship a week prior quickly dwindled, as Bismarck High found itself in a tight quarterfinal contest with Wahpeton.

In the end, Bismarck High escaped with a narrow 53-51 win and things wouldn't get any easier as the Demons once again were locked in a competitive, tightly contested tournament game – this time against Valley City in the semifinals.

Again, Bismarck High emerged victorious by a thin 56-54 margin to advance to the state championship game for the first time since 1995.

Waiting for Bismarck High in the state title game was Fargo South – the East Region's top seed at state. Just like the Demons, South played a pair of tight games to advance to the championship leading many to believe the final would go right down to the wire.

It was not meant to be. Bismarck High would prove to have its fill of close calls and left nothing to chance in order to avoid a spoiler of its special season.

The Demons would dominate and when the final buzzer sounded at the Minot State Dome, Bismarck High celebrated a 71-41 win – the largest margin of victory in a state championship game. Matt Thorton led the way for the Demons scoring 18 points in the title game.

It was Bismarck High's first state championship since 1994. The Demons' 24 wins on the season was a program-best mark.

DAVE KLUNDT | FARGO

David Klundt is working his 43rd year as a registered official. He is currently officiating football and baseball. Klundt has dedicated his career to officiating for over four decades, registered in basketball for 41 years, football for 35 years, baseball for 25 years, and softball for three years.

Throughout his officiating journey, Klundt has had opportunities to contribute to the sports community. He served as a basketball workshop supervisor and completed two terms on the North Dakota Officials Association (NDOA) Board and served as a clinician at numerous basketball and football officiating camps. As a member of the Red River Valley Officials Association and currently the High Plains Officials Consortium, he has taken on responsibilities in assigning basketball officials and

currently oversees and assigns baseball umpires. At North Dakota State University, he has taught several basketball and football officiating courses.

Klundt has had the opportunity to officiate 16 NDHSAA Class A Boys Basketball State Tournaments, five NDHSAA Class A Girls Basketball State Tournaments, one NDHSAA Class B Girls Basketball State Tournament, four Class A Boys Basketball State Championship games, has been the white hat for five NDHSAA Dakota Bowl Football State Championship games, one NDHSAA Class A Baseball State tournament, and one NDHSAA Class A Softball State Tournament. He also officiated many high school district and regional playoff games in basketball, baseball, and football. In recognition of his dedication, Klundt was named the North Dakota High School Boys Basketball Official of the Year in 2008. Klundt also received the Special Recognition Award from the North Dakota High School Coaches Association in 2023. Klundt's collegiate officiating career spans 35 years, during which he has officiated football, basketball, baseball, and softball at various levels, including JUCO, NAIA, NCAA Divisions II and III, and NCAA Division I women's basketball and baseball. His highlights include working many collegiate playoff games, including national quarterfinals in NAIA football and NCAA Division III women's basketball.

Currently, Klundt serves as the supervisor of football officials for the NAIA North Star Conference.

In addition to his officiating career, Klundt has dedicated 35 years to the Fargo Park District, where he currently serves as the Aquatics and Recreation Manager. He resides in North Fargo with his wife, Heather, and they are proud parents to two daughters, Kathleen (21) and Jennifer (20).



DALE WESTON | FARGO

Dale Weston began his officiating career in 1987, and was a registered official for 32 years, officiating boys and girls basketball for 32 years and high school football for 15 years. Weston is a native of Sarles, North Dakota, graduating from Border Central High School in 1985. He went on to complete his undergraduate and graduate degrees at North Dakota State University.

Weston worked his first District Tournament in 1993, working the District Boys Tournament in Williston, North Dakota. Weston would go on to officiate over 40 NDHSAA District and Regional basketball tournaments for both Class B and Class A boys and girls basketball. Weston officiated in 10 NDHSAA State Basketball Tournaments, working three state championship games. Weston also officiated one NDHSAA Dakota Bowl Football State Championship game in 2004 as the head linesman. Weston worked seven North Dakota Lion's All-Star basketball games and had the privilege of officiating basketball for the Special Olympics. Weston was recognized as the North Dakota High

School "Official of the Year" in boys basketball during the 2011-2012 season. Weston was the President of the Red River Valley Officials Association and served on the Board two different terms.

Weston also was a women's collegiate basketball official for 17 years, working in the Northern Sun, MIAC, Dakota Athletic, Mon-Dak and MCC conferences. He worked Division II, Division III, NAIA and NJCAA basketball.

Weston loved officiating high school basketball and cherishes the many relationships made with coaches, players, and fellow officials, who all made the job a complete joy. He thanks all of the past officials that gave so much time and effort to mentor him and helped him achieve this award. Weston always tried to "give back" and help younger officials in their careers. He is proud of those he helped along the way.

Weston acknowledges the great support he had along his career from his wife Kristi and daughters Paige and Bailey. Paige is a schoolteacher in Colorado Springs, Colorado and married to Stuart Jackson. They have one daughter, Finley Jackson. Bailey is a speech language pathologist at West Fargo Horace High School and is married to Alex Werk. They have one son, Cameron Werk. Weston currently works as a farmland appraiser and a farmland real estate agent working in eastern North Dakota and NW Minnesota and resides in Fargo.

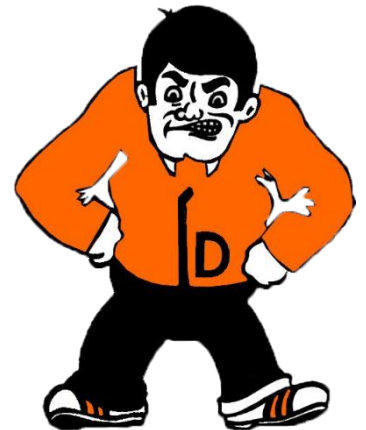
HEAD COACH: DAN GLASSER

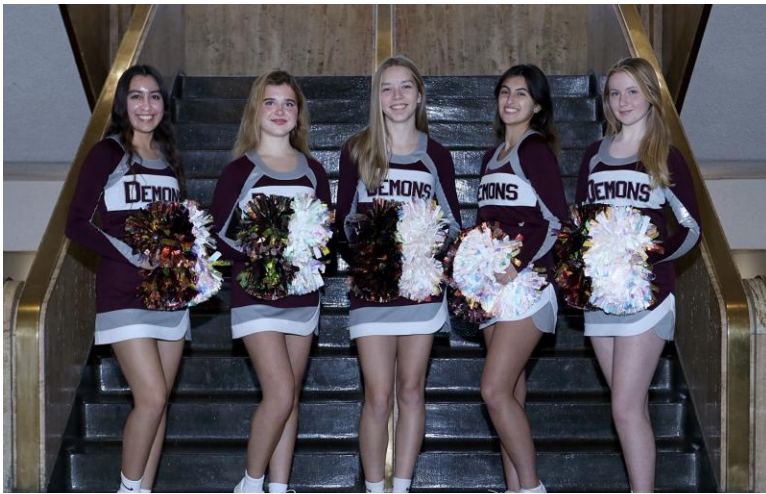

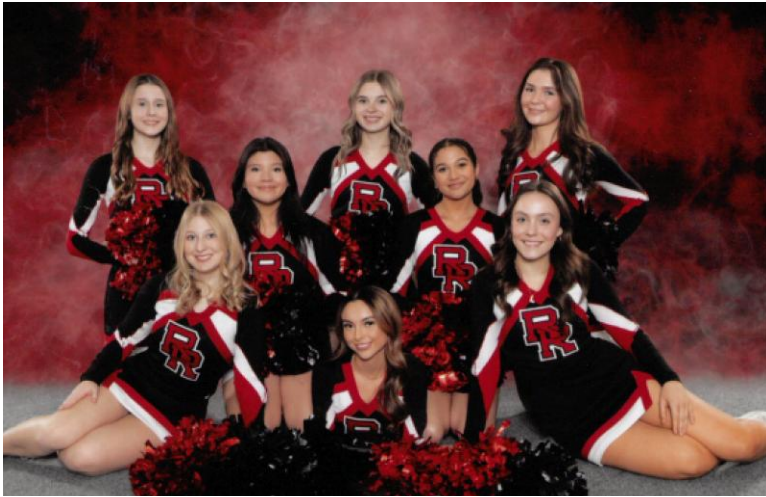
