Behavior Expectations for Regular & Postseason Competitions

- Respect the American flag and the National Anthem.
- Contesting schools shall each have an authorized faculty representative present who shall be responsible for his/her school's participants, students, and fans throughout the contest.
- Spectators must wear clothing that covers the entire torso. Those who do not comply or who wear clothing that is vulgar, obscene or that in some other way inappropriate, as determined by school/tournament personnel, will be removed from the facility if they do not cooperate with this behavior expectation.
- The use of appropriate language is expected at all times. Profanity, negative chants, trash talk, name-calling, personal attacks or other acts of disrespect are unacceptable and must be immediately addressed by school/tournament administrators. Any discriminatory slur will result in immediate removal from the facility.
- Any attendee ejected from a NDHSAA tournament venue will be banned from the venue(s) for the remainder of the event.
- Respect the game/contest. Under no condition shall anyone other than the members of the official squad enter the playing surface. No one may interfere with the contest in any way.
- Handheld signs and flags, which do not obstruct the view of others, are permitted provided they are in good taste. Signs or other similar items contest/tournament officials deem to be in poor taste will be removed. Message or "white" boards are prohibited. The carrying of flags around the playing surface is NOT allowed.
- Artificial noisemakers of any kind (i.e. megaphones, cowbells, sirens, whistles, thunder sticks, and other similar items) are not allowed at any indoor events, including outdoor sports played at indoor venues. Exception – Megaphones appropriately used by cheerleaders are permitted if allowed by contest officials.
- Laser lights or any other lights deemed distracting to participants are strictly prohibited.
- Confetti is banned at all NDHSAA tournament venues. Tournament staff are instructed to confiscate such articles at the door.
- Objects shall not be thrown into the stands at any NDHSAA tournament venue.
- The use of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAV), also known as drones, is prohibited for any persons at NDHSAA tournament venues.

VISION ZERO 

After a decade-plus long hiatus of no high school girls basketball state tournaments in the state of North Dakota, the 1974 season would usher in a new era for the sport.

Beginning in the fall of 1974, schools participating in the sport of girls basketball were divided up into two classes (Class A and Class B) with each culminating in a separate state tournament.

The 1974 Class A State Tournament would be played at the Jamestown Civic Center. The tournament field consisted of Jamestown, Bottineau, Langdon, Dickinson Trinity, Dickinson High, Grand Forks Central, Williston, and Valley City.

Langdon (Northeast), Jamestown (Southeast), Williston (Northwest) and Dickinson High (Southwest) entered state as region champions. On top of its regional championships, the Blue Jays of Jamestown also sported an undefeated record entering the inaugural state tournament. Jamestown had also gone undefeated in its games played during the 1973 season and sported a veteran-laden starting five with four seniors and sophomore.

Jamestown was coached by Tom Gould, who along with his assistant Sandra Nelson put together a squad that emphasized teamwork as its focal point which ultimately led to the Blue Jays winning the 1974 NDHSAA Class A state championship.

The Blue Jays defeated Bottineau 47-39 in the quarterfinals and followed up with a 35-29 win over Grand Forks Central in the semifinals.

Jamestown would meet a talented Williston team in the state championship game. The final was tightly contested and Jamestown emerged with a 34-30 win over the Coyotes.

For the second consecutive season, Jamestown had gone undefeated and its win against Williston marked the team's 33rd consecutive win over two seasons of play. The Jamestown girls basketball program would forever be known as the first to win a Class A girls basketball state championship and the 1974 squad would later be immortalized at the school by being inducted into the Jamestown High School Sports Hall of Fame.

1999 MANDAN BRAVES

The 1999 NDHSAA Class A Girls Basketball State Tournament played at the Jamestown Civic Center was made up of West Fargo High, Bismarck High, Williston, Fargo North, Jamestown, Minot High, Fargo South and Mandan, who was making its ninth consecutive appearance at state.

The Braves entered state with 19-3 record and were looking to advance to the championship game for the fifth consecutive season.

Williston had edged the Braves in the 1999 West Region Tournament championship game a week prior, but Mandan looked to get back in the win column with an opening round matchup with Fargo South.

Mandan edged the Bruins 61-53 and followed up with a 41-30 win over Minot High in the semifinals to once again advance to a state championship game.

Mandan's first ever state championship in program history came in 1995 and the Braves would play in the state final the following three seasons, but were runners up each year losing the three championship games from 1996-1998 by a combined margin of five points.

The Braves would reverse their championship fortunes in 1999. Mandan matched up with Bismarck High in what shaped up to be a physical state title game as both squads battled foul trouble combining for 53 total fouls in the game.

Bismarck High led 31-24 at halftime and held a 10-point advantage in the third quarter. It appeared as though Mandan might be on its way to a fourth straight runner up finish, but a 7-0 run and a special guest appearance by Mandan's girls swimming team who had just won a team state title of their own earlier in the day helped fuel a comeback for the Braves.

The Braves' girls swim team held their trophy as they found their seats at the Jamestown Civic Center and the Mandan crowd cheered. On the court, the Braves were inspired to match their peers on the swim squad and join in on the championship fun.

Mandan junior forward Angie Frenzel led the way for the Braves with 26 points and 12 rebounds. Frenzel outscored the Demons herself 9-7 in the fourth quarter alone.

Ultimately, the Braves' depth tipped the scales in their favor and Mandan celebrated a 55-43 victory.

DAVE KLUNDT | FARGO

David Klundt is working his 43rd year as a registered official. He is currently officiating football and baseball. Klundt has dedicated his career to officiating for over four decades, registered in basketball for 41 years, football for 35 years, baseball for 25 years, and softball for three years.

Throughout his officiating journey, Klundt has had opportunities to contribute to the sports community. He served as a basketball workshop supervisor and completed two terms on the North Dakota Officials Association (NDOA) Board and served as a clinician at numerous basketball and football officiating camps. As a member of the Red River Valley Officials Association and currently the High Plains Officials Consortium, he has taken on responsibilities in assigning basketball officials and

currently oversees and assigns baseball umpires. At North Dakota State University, he has taught several basketball and football officiating courses.

Klundt has had the opportunity to officiate 16 NDHSAA Class A Boys Basketball State Tournaments, five NDHSAA Class A Girls Basketball State Tournaments, one NDHSAA Class B Girls Basketball State Tournament, four Class A Boys Basketball State Championship games, has been the white hat for five NDHSAA Dakota Bowl Football State Championship games, one NDHSAA Class A Baseball State tournament, and one NDHSAA Class A Softball State Tournament. He also officiated many high school district and regional playoff games in basketball, baseball, and football. In recognition of his dedication, Klundt was named the North Dakota High School Boys Basketball Official of the Year in 2008. Klundt also received the Special Recognition Award from the North Dakota High School Coaches Association in 2023. Klundt's collegiate officiating career spans 35 years, during which he has officiated football, basketball, baseball, and softball at various levels, including JUCO, NAIA, NCAA Divisions II and III, and NCAA Division I women's basketball and baseball. His highlights include working many collegiate playoff games, including national quarterfinals in NAIA football and NCAA Division III women's basketball.

Currently, Klundt serves as the supervisor of football officials for the NAIA North Star Conference.

In addition to his officiating career, Klundt has dedicated 35 years to the Fargo Park District, where he currently serves as the Aquatics and Recreation Manager. He resides in North Fargo with his wife, Heather, and they are proud parents to two daughters, Kathleen (21) and Jennifer (20).



DALE WESTON | FARGO

Dale Weston began his officiating career in 1987, and was a registered official for 32 years, officiating boys and girls basketball for 32 years and high school football for 15 years. Weston is a native of Sarles, North Dakota, graduating from Border Central High School in 1985. He went on to complete his undergraduate and graduate degrees at North Dakota State University.

Weston worked his first District Tournament in 1993, working the District Boys Tournament in Williston, North Dakota. Weston would go on to officiate over 40 NDHSAA District and Regional basketball tournaments for both Class B and Class A boys and girls basketball. Weston officiated in 10 NDHSAA State Basketball Tournaments, working three state championship games. Weston also officiated one NDHSAA Dakota Bowl Football State Championship game in 2004 as the head linesman. Weston worked seven North Dakota Lion's All-Star basketball games and had the privilege of officiating basketball for the Special Olympics. Weston was recognized as the North Dakota High

School "Official of the Year" in boys basketball during the 2011-2012 season. Weston was the President of the Red River Valley Officials Association and served on the Board two different terms.

Weston also was a women's collegiate basketball official for 17 years, working in the Northern Sun, MIAC, Dakota Athletic, Mon-Dak and MCC conferences. He worked Division II, Division III, NAIA and NJCAA basketball.

Weston loved officiating high school basketball and cherishes the many relationships made with coaches, players, and fellow officials, who all made the job a complete joy. He thanks all of the past officials that gave so much time and effort to mentor him and helped him achieve this award. Weston always tried to "give back" and help younger officials in their careers. He is proud of those he helped along the way.

Weston acknowledges the great support he had along his career from his wife Kristi and daughters Paige and Bailey. Paige is a schoolteacher in Colorado Springs, Colorado and married to Stuart Jackson. They have one daughter, Finley Jackson. Bailey is a speech language pathologist at West Fargo Horace High School and is married to Alex Werk. They have one son, Cameron Werk. Weston currently works as a farmland appraiser and a farmland real estate agent working in eastern North Dakota and NW Minnesota and resides in Fargo.
