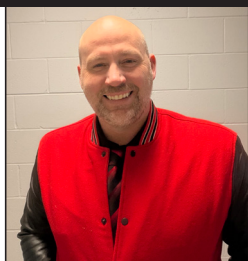

At the 1976 NDHSAA Class B Boys Basketball State Tournament, the best of the best came from LHS. Guided by head coach Terry Olson, the LaMoure Loboes developed a clear identity built on fundamentals, conditioning, and pressure defense. Olson emphasized controlling games through effort and execution, and no tactic symbolized that philosophy more than LaMoure's signature full-court press.

Senior Leon Thielges emerged as LaMoure's on-court leader and was supported by a cohesive core that included Bruce Shockman, Mark Shockman, Derold Haugen, David Olson, 6th man Steve Kennedy and a talented bench that could produce when called upon.

LaMoure High School would qualify for the program's first ever state tournament with a 60-50 win over Fairmount in the Region 1 Tournament in Valley City.

At the 1976 B at the Bismarck Civic Center, the Loboes would put together one of the most dominant postseason performances in state history.

LaMoure was one of three undefeated teams to qualify for the state tournament in 1976. New Town and Lakota both sported unblemished records and the rest of the tournament field included Garrison, Mott, Rolla, Robinson, and Minnewaukan.

The Loboes opened with an 88-64 win over Rolla in the quarterfinals. Leon Thielges (23 points), Derold Haugen (16 points), David Olson (14 points) and Bruce Shockman (14 points) all scored in double figures for LaMoure.

Fellow undefeated Lakota awaited the Loboes in the semifinals. LaMoure held a double-digit lead at each quarter break and won the game 78-54. Thielges led the way again for LaMoure scoring a game high 26 points. Haugen, Olson and Shockman also finished in double figures.

It would be another matchup of undefeated teams in the state final as LaMoure would meet New Town for the coveted state championship trophy.

LaMoure's dominance showed itself once again in the state title game. The Loboes held a 35-20 lead at halftime and a 60-39 advantage heading into the fourth quarter. When the final buzzer sounded, LaMoure celebrated an 86-61 victory.

Thielges scored 26 points in the title game and finished the three-game tournament with 75 points. LaMoure's three-game total of 252 points scored at the state tournament was a new team record in championship bracket play. LaMoure outscored its opponents at state by a total of 73 points and finished the season 29-0.

With a newly minted co-op of Pembina and Neche joining with Walhalla to form North Border, the Eagles were ready to soar during the 2000–2001 boys basketball season. Dave "Cooter" Symington was named head coach on the co-op program and the team would win its first game of the season, but its first home game played in Walhalla would stall the Eagles' early momentum.

Cando would spoil North Border's home opener defeating the Eagles by 27 points. In response to the loss, North Border would get to work and played much better the remainder of the regular season losing only one other game – a road loss to Fordville/Lankin before the District 4 Tournament in Grafton.

The Eagles defeated Midway 74–47 in the District 4 championship game and would travel to Grafton once more in the postseason for the Region 2 Tournament. North Border escaped the Region 2 quarterfinals with a 48–46 win against May-Port-CG and would avenge its loss to Fordville–Lankin in the semifinals with a 78–53 victory. The Eagles punched their ticket to the 2001 NDHSAA Class B Boys Basketball State Tournament in dramatic fashion with a 74–67 overtime victory over Central Valley in the Region 2 championship game.

At State, North Border would matchup with defending state champion Oak Grove in the quarterfinals. The Eagles recovered from a slow start to defeat the Grovers 62–53 and followed up with a 67–58 win over Dickinson Trinity in the semifinals.

Waiting for the Eagles in the state title game was top-ranked, undefeated Cando – the team that had humbled North Border back in December. The Eagles fared much better in the championship game meeting. North Border built a 21-point advantage by the opening minute of the fourth quarter, however Cando stormed back quick rattling off a 16–0 run to cut the Eagles lead to 55–50 with six minutes left to play. Though Cando's Mr. Basketball Finalist Evan Lindahl finished with 24 points and 18 rebounds, North Border's defense slowed him down for a great portion of the game. North Border's Jason Tryan, Dennis Delude and Warren Eagan each took their turns guarding Lindahl.

The Eagles would regain control of the game thanks to back-to-back layups by Delude who finished with a double-double (21 points and 10 rebounds). Nathan Carrier added 17 points for the Eagles. Eagan and Aaron Bonamie each finished with 12 points for North Border who celebrated a 74–65 win before a packed house at the Minot State Dome.

North Border would finish the season 26–2.

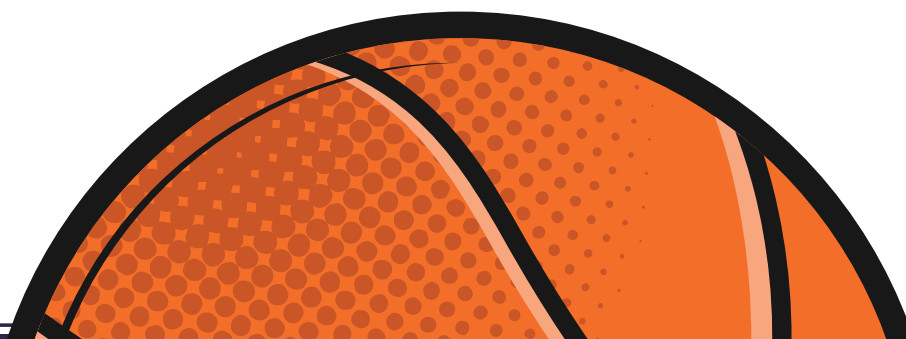

NDHSAA BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS FOR REGULAR AND POSTSEASON COMPETITIONS:

- Respect the American flag and the National Anthem.
- Contesting schools shall each have an authorized faculty representative present who shall be responsible for his/her school's participants, students, and fans throughout the contest.
- Spectators must wear appropriate clothing. Those who do not comply or who wear clothing that is vulgar, obscene or that in some other way inappropriate, as determined by school/tournament personnel, will be removed from the facility if they do not cooperate with this behavior expectation.
- The use of appropriate language is expected at all times. Profanity, negative chants, trash talk, name-calling, personal attacks or other acts of disrespect are unacceptable and must be immediately addressed by school/tournament administrators. Any discriminatory slur will result in immediate removal from the facility.
- Any attendee ejected from a NDHSAA regular season or tournament contest will incur a minimum two (2) calendar week game/event suspension.
- Respect the game/contest. Under no condition shall anyone other than the members of the official squad enter the playing surface. No one may interfere with the contest in any way.
- Handheld signs and flags, which do not obstruct the view of others, are permitted provided they are in good taste. Signs or other similar items contest/tournament officials deem to be in poor taste will be removed. Message or "white" boards are prohibited. The carrying of flags around the playing surface is NOT allowed.
- Artificial noisemakers of any kind (i.e. megaphones, cowbells, sirens, whistles, thunder sticks, and other similar items) are not allowed at any indoor events, including outdoor sports played at indoor venues. Exception – Megaphones appropriately used by cheerleaders are permitted if allowed by contest officials.
- Laser lights or any other lights deemed distracting to participants are strictly prohibited.
- The use of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAV), also known as drones, is prohibited at all contests.
