

#### Purpose:

To elevate standards of Good Sportsmanship and to encourage the growth of responsible citizenship among the students, member schools and their personnel.

#### Fundamentals of Good Sportsmanship

- 1. Know, appreciate and understand the rules of the contest.
- 2. Show respect for the officials. Good sportsmanship implies the willingness to accept and abide by the decisions of the officials.
- 3. Show respect for the opponent at all times. Good Sportsmanship is the Golden Rule in action.
- Recognize and appreciate the skill of performance regardless of team affiliation.
- Maintain self control at all times. Good sportsmanship is a responsibility of all who are involved in the game.
- 6. Show a positive attitude in cheering, refraining from intimidation or negative cheering. Good sportsmanship is cheering your own team "on to victory".

#### **Acts of Misconduct**

- 1. Throwing of any object onto the playing floor or in the stands.
- 2. Behavior deemed dangerous or which interferes with the rights of others to watch the game. Possessing, consuming or being under the influence of chemicals.
- 3. Use of obscene, profane or abusive language or gestures, signs, posters or banners which show disrespect for opponent's team, officials, cheerleaders, band or other performing groups.
- 4. The use of noise makers.
- Entry onto the playing surface at any time.


#### Nicole Sufficool, Valley City Head Coach

#### Girls State Gymnastics Championships **HISTORY**

The first State Girls Gymnastics Championships sponsored by the North Dakota High School Activities Association took place in 1969. The competition included Class A and Class B schools with only 10 schools competing. Jamestown High School came away with the first title.

Competition has changed since the first championships. At the first event, competition took place in tumbling, trampoline, balance beam, uneven bars, side horse, floor exercise and all around. Each event was divided into three levels - novice, intermediate and junior.

The following year, and every year since, the championships have included only five events. The tumbling and trampoline events were eliminated and the side horse became the vault.

The 1974 state meet saw the last novice, intermediate and junior divisions. It was also the year that separate team champions were named in Class A and Class B divisions. In 1975, each class not only received a separate team trophy, but individual champions were also named in both classes.

The number of teams competing in the state championship has also increased since the first meet in 1969. The dedication of the coaches, athletes and officials in the sport has played an important role in the growth of gymnastics in the state. And along with the growth has come a much more intense level of competition.
