Behavior Expectations for Regular & Postseason Competitions

- Respect the American flag and the National Anthem.
- Contesting schools shall each have an authorized faculty representative present who shall be responsible for his/her school's participants, students, and fans throughout the contest.
- Spectators must wear clothing that covers the entire torso. Those who do not comply or who wear clothing that is vulgar, obscene or that in some other way inappropriate, as determined by school/tournament personnel, will be removed from the facility if they do not cooperate with this behavior expectation.
- The use of appropriate language is expected at all times. Profanity, negative chants, trash talk, name-calling, personal attacks or other acts of disrespect are unacceptable and must be immediately addressed by school/tournament administrators. Any discriminatory slur will result in immediate removal from the facility.
- Any attendee ejected from a NDHSAA tournament venue will be banned from the venue(s) for the remainder of the event.
- Respect the game/contest. Under no condition shall anyone other than the members of the official squad enter the playing surface. No one may interfere with the contest in any way.
- Handheld signs and flags, which do not obstruct the view of others, are permitted provided they are in good taste. Signs or other similar items contest/tournament officials deem to be in poor taste will be removed. Message or "white" boards are prohibited. The carrying of flags around the playing surface is NOT allowed.
- Artificial noisemakers of any kind (i.e. megaphones, cowbells, sirens, whistles, thunder sticks, and other similar items) are not allowed at any indoor events, including outdoor sports played at indoor venues. Exception – Megaphones appropriately used by cheerleaders are permitted if allowed by contest officials.
- Laser lights or any other lights deemed distracting to participants are strictly prohibited.
- Confetti is banned at all NDHSAA tournament venues. Tournament staff are instructed to confiscate such articles at the door.
- Objects shall not be thrown into the stands at any NDHSAA tournament venue.
- The use of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAV), also known as drones, is prohibited for any persons at NDHSAA tournament venues.

Prior to the 1973-74 season, one team – Grand Forks Central – dominated the prep boys hockey scene in North Dakota. Grand Forks Central won the first 13 North Dakota boys hockey state championships (1961-1973), but all dynasties come to an end and in 1974 it was a different team's turn to skate off the rink with a state championship.

The 1974 NDHSAA Boys Hockey State Tournament field was made up of Grand Forks Central, Fargo South, Fargo North, Bismarck High, Grafton, Devils Lake, Grand Forks Red River and Park River.

In the semifinals, Fargo North defeated Grand Forks Central 7-6 ensuring there would be a new program celebrating a state title in 1974 at the University of North Dakota's Winter Sports Center.

Locking up with Fargo North in the state final would be Grand Forks Red River, who was making its second appearance in a state championship game in program history with the previous appearance coming in 1968 – a 5-0 shutout loss to Grand Forks Central.

Red River had skated to an 11-0 win against Park River in the quarterfinals and secured a 5-2 victory against 1973 state runner up Grafton in the semifinals to make its return trip to the championship game.

This time the Roughriders would be victorious as Red River scored a 2-1 win against Fargo North for the program's first ever state title. It would be a prime example of a team getting hot at the right time of the season as the Roughriders entered the state tournament with a 7-11 record.

During the state tournament, the Roughriders received excellent goaltending from Dan Johnson, who had 29 saves in the state championship game, and the team played much more consistent on defense which had not been the case throughout the regular season.

Brad Gador got the Roughriders on the scoreboard 13 minutes, 20 seconds into the first period. Red River's Ron Bachmeier scored at the 8:22 mark of the second period to give the Roughriders a 2-0 lead. North would score late in the third period, but an ensuing penalty by the Spartans thwarted the team's ability to build any significant momentum at trying for the equalizer.

The final buzzer sounded and with it, Red River players hoisted head coach Rick Ulvin on their shoulders as a then record crowd of 5,400 fans watched a new team celebrate a North Dakota high school boys hockey state championship. Red River finished the 1973-74 season 10-11.

The Tommies won the state championship match (7-15, 15-10, 15-8 and 15-8) completing the back-to-back

The 1999 NDHSAA Boys Hockey State Tournament field included Williston, Minot High, Bismarck Century and Bismarck High from the West Region and Fargo North, Fargo South, Jamestown and three-time defending state champion Grand Forks Red River from the East Region.

Entering State, Red River was out to continue its dynasty under first-year head coach Matt Malm who succeeded Gary Purpur as head coach prior to the 1998-99 season. The Roughriders skated to a 2-0 win over Fargo South in the East Region Tournament championship game a week prior to state and appeared to be in good position to add another state title to the school's trophy case. In order to do so, the Roughriders knew they most likely would need to go through the Bruins at state to get their fourth.

Red River was right and the fourth meeting between the two schools during the 1998-99 season occurred in the state championship game – only this time South would emerge victorious after losing the three previous meetings with the Roughriders.

Fargo South skated to an 8-2 win over Bismarck Century in the quarterfinals followed by a 5-2 victory over Bismarck High in the semifinals to set up the championship with Red River.

Red River won the two regular season meetings against the Bruins by scores of 2-1 in overtime and 4-3. If the Bruins were to spoil the Roughrider's try for a fourth state title, they would need to be savvy defensively and cash in on scoring opportunities. Luckily for South, senior goaltender Clay Mannie was brilliant between the pipes and its top line of Matt Hansen, Tanner Corwin and Brandon Askew had a great tournament combining for 22 total points during the three games at state.

In the championship game – which went to overtime – it was Corwin who scored both goals for the Bruins. Corwin scored in the first period getting a pass from Askew. Red River would tie the game up two minutes, 34 seconds into the third period with a goal from Tom Bakke.

In the overtime period, the Bruins wasted little time as Hansen rocketed a pass 21 seconds into play from the end boards that found Corwin in front of the net who got his shot past Red River goaltender Nate Ziegelmann. South got its win over Red River – a 2-1 victory in overtime.

Mannie stopped 31 shots for the Bruins, who celebrated the program's second state championship with the other coming in 1994. South finished the season 20-7. Mannie and Askew were named to the All-Tournament team following the championship game.

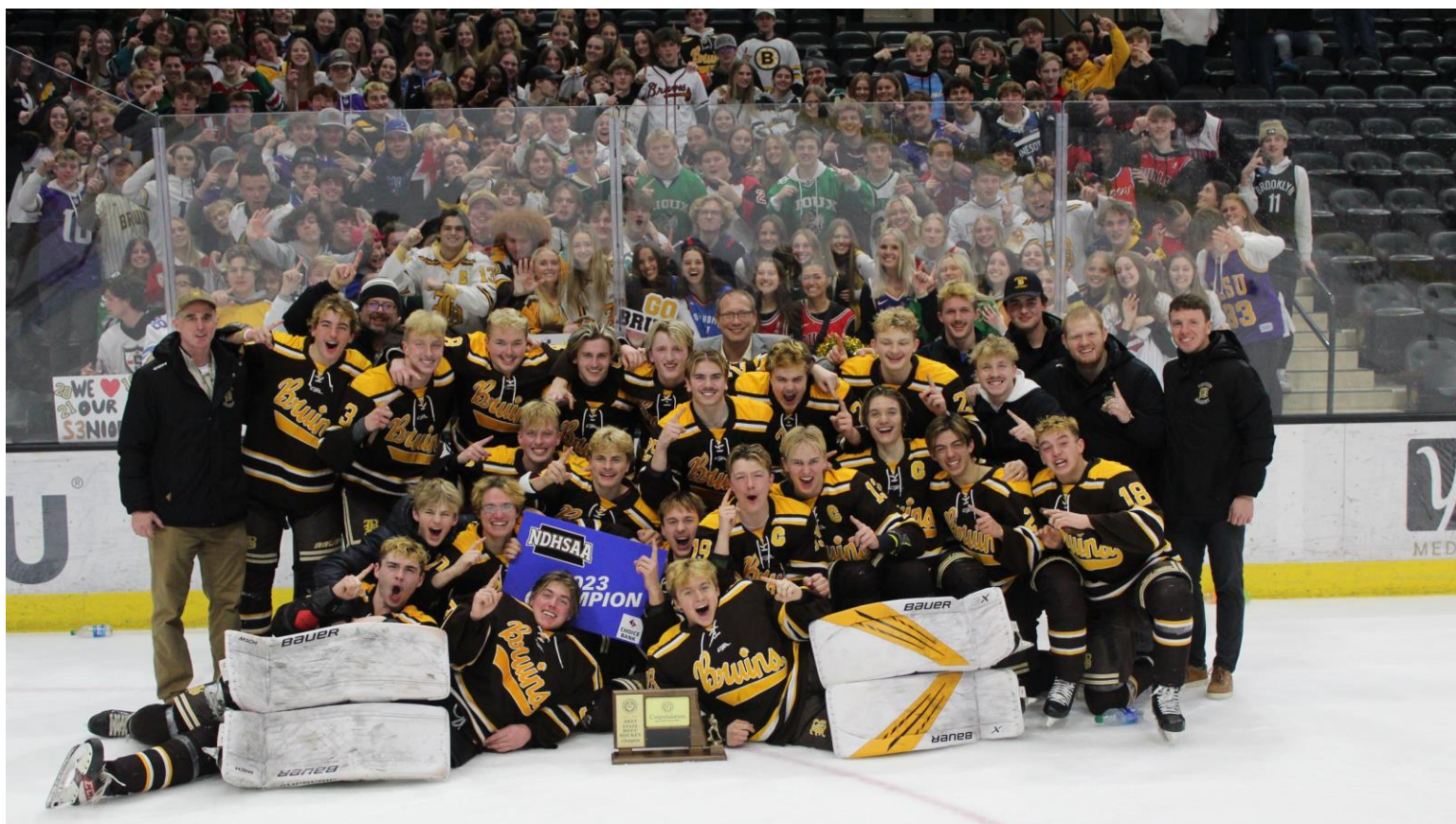

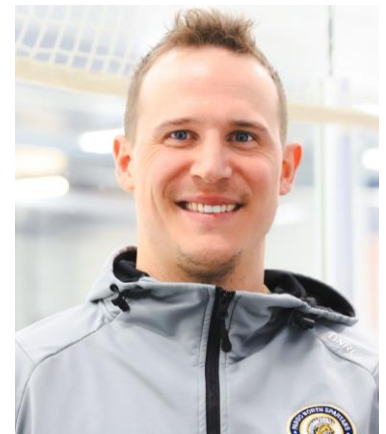

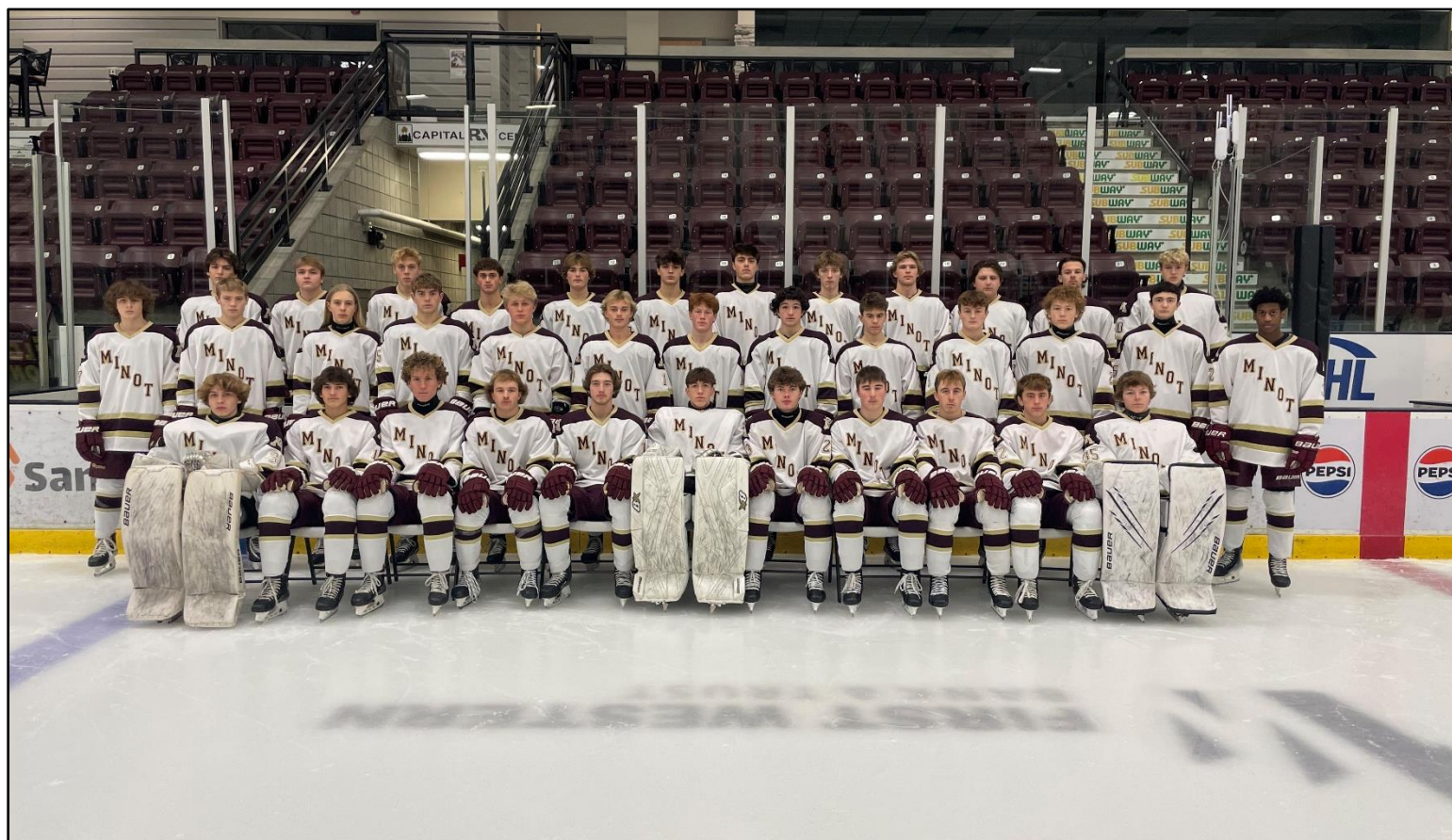
