NDHSAA Minimal **BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS**

For Regular And Postseason Competitions



- Respect the American flag and the National Anthem.
- Contesting schools shall each have an authorized faculty representative present who shall be responsible for his/her school's participants, students, and fans throughout the contest.
- Spectators must wear clothing that covers the entire torso. Those who do not comply or who wear clothing that is vulgar, obscene or that in some other way inappropriate, as determined by school/tournament personnel, will be removed from the facility if they do not cooperate with this behavior expectation.
- The use of appropriate language is expected at all times. Profanity, negative chants, trash talk, name-calling, personal attacks or other acts of disrespect are unacceptable and must be immediately addressed by school/tournament administrators. Any discriminatory slur will result in immediate removal from the facility.
- Any attendee ejected from a NDHSAA tournament venue will be banned from the venue(s) for the remainder of the event.
- Respect the game/contest. Under no condition shall anyone other than the members of the official squad enter the playing surface. No one may interfere with the contest in any way.
- Hand held signs and flags, which do not obstruct the view of others, are permitted provided they are in good taste. Signs or other similar items contest/tournament officials deem to be in poor taste will be removed. Message or "white" boards are prohibited. The carrying of flags around the playing surface is NOT allowed.
- Artificial noisemakers of any kind (i.e., megaphones, cowbells, sirens, whistles, thunder sticks, and other similar items) are not allowed at any indoor events, including outdoor sports played at indoor venues. Exception – Megaphones appropriately used by cheerleaders are permitted if allowed by contest officials.
- Laser lights or any other lights deemed distracting to participants are strictly prohibited.
- Confetti is banned at all NDHSAA tournament venues. Tournament staff is instructed to confiscate such articles at the door.
- Objects shall not be thrown into the stands at any NDHSAA tournament venue.
- The use of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAV), also known as drones, is prohibited for any persons at NDHSAA tournament venues.

Tournament Recap

After seeing its string of 13 consecutive NDHSAA state championships come to an end at the 1974 state tournament, Grand Forks Central was looking to return to the winning circle when the 1975 postseason came around.

The road back to glory would be a bit bumpy, but in the end Central would once again hoist the state championship trophy.

After a 3-2 loss to Grafton in the North Region championship game, Central would be the North's No. 2 seed at state, pairing up against South Region, No. 3-seed Bismarck High in the quarterfinals.

Central skated to a 9-3 win against the Demons setting up a game against Fargo South in the semifinals. The Bruins had won the South Region tournament championship a week prior and were in Grand Forks to make a serious bid as the first non-Grand Forks team to win a boys hockey state title.

Against the Bruins, Central hung tough and skated to a 5-4 victory sending the squad to the state championship game after a brief one-year hiatus.

In the championship, Central would meet cross-town rival Grand Forks Central – a pairing that would be a rematch of the 1968 final.

Central opened the championship game's scoring with a power-play goal in the first period off a slap shot from Todd Anderson. Red River would get the equalizer courtesy of a goal from Ron Bushy.

Just past the midway point of the second period the Roughriders had successfully killed off a penalty, but when Red River goaltender Scott Anderson made a save off a deflected shot in the seconds following the penalty kill, Central's Mike Lerud – camped out in front of the net – kept the puck from being cleared and got a shot high past Scott Anderson.

Once again, Red River would answer – this time on the power-play before the second intermission horn. At the 13:07 mark of the second period, Red River's Matt Berge got a slap shot to deflect off the glove of Central goaltender Jim Hillier and into the net.

The game-winner would come with only a minute, 39 seconds left in the third period when Central's Todd Anderson got a back-handed shot on net to go through the legs of Scott Anderson for the score.

Red River was unable to get the equalizer and Central eventually would celebrate the program's 14th state championship in 15 seasons.

Tournament Recap

The 1999-2000 boys hockey season would be one in which the Grand Forks Red River Roughriders would claim their program's 10th NDHSAA state championship.

After winning three straight state titles in 1996-98, Red River reclaimed its top spot at the 2000 NDHSAA State Tournament played in Grand Forks. The 2000 state tournament field was made up of Red River, Mandan, Fargo South, Dickinson, Grafton/Park River, Bismarck High, Grand Forks Central and Minot High.

Red River skated into the state tourney with plenty of momentum after winning the East Region Tournament with a 3-0 win over Grafton/Park River a week prior. The Roughriders would match up with Mandan in the quarterfinals and skated to a 9-1 victory to open tournament play.

Red River defeated defending state champions Fargo South 8-1 in the semifinals and would meet Grafton/Park River in the state championship game.

Red River's stingy efforts on defense would prove handy in the state final against the Spoilers as would the goaltending abilities of junior Nathan Ziegelmann.

The Spoilers came out firing in hopes of avenging the loss in the region championship game, but the Roughriders' defensemen and Ziegelmann proved worthy adversaries of the offensive onslaught.

Red River would score the game's lone goal at the one minute, 52 second mark of the second period when junior forward Nick Krebsbach found senior Seth Lothspeich open for a quick shot that found the back of the net.

The Spoilers were unable to get the equalizer despite out shooting the Roughriders 24-14 in the title game. Ziegelmann turned away a pair of point-blank shots by Grafton/Park River's Drew Sando and David Rygh in the first period, but his best and perhaps biggest save of the night came in the second period.

Ziegelmann would make a sprawling glove-side save of a shot fired on net by Sando with 4:53 left in the period to preserve the Roughriders' 1-0 advantage.

Following the game Ziegelmann was named Tournament MVP after finishing the three games with a 0.37 goals against average and .978 save percentage including the brilliant 24-save shutout in the finale. Roughriders joining Ziegelmann on the All-Tournament team were defensemen Tom Bakke and Mike Eickman.

Matt Malm's Roughriders would finish the 1999-2000 season with a 21-4-2 record.
