

NDHSAA TOURNAMENT CODE OF CONDUCT

PURPOSE: To elevate standards of Good Sportsmanship and to encourage the growth of responsible citizenship among the students, member schools and their personnel.

Fundamentals of Good Sportsmanship

1. Know, appreciate and understand the rules of the contest.
2. Show respect for the officials. Good Sportsmanship implies the willingness to accept and abide by the decisions of the officials.
3. Show respect for the opponent at all times. Good Sportsmanship is the Golden Rule in action.
4. Recognize and appreciate the skill of performance regardless of team affiliation.
5. Maintain self control at all times. Good Sportsmanship is a responsibility of all who are involved in the game.
6. Show a positive attitude in cheering, refraining from intimidation or negative cheering. Good Sportsmanship is cheering your own team "on to victory."

Acts of Misconduct

1. Throwing of any object onto the playing floor or in the stands.
2. Behavior deemed dangerous or which interferes with the rights of others to watch the game.
3. Possessing, consuming or being under the influence of chemicals.
4. Use of obscene, profane or abusive language or gestures, signs, posters or banners which show disrespect for opponent's team, officials, cheerleaders, band or other performing groups.
5. The use of noise makers.
6. Entry onto the playing surface at any time.


Mel Fischer, Bismarck Head Coach

Mel Fischer is a graduate of NDSU. He has coached in the Bismarck Public School system for 21 years. He coached at Wachter Middle School for 8 years. He served as the Assistant Varsity Boys coach at Bismarck High from 1995 until 2000. He has served as the Girls Varsity Coach at Bismarck High since 1999. He has been the Bismarck High Boys Varsity Coach since 2003. Mel has coached 4 state championship teams either as a head coach or an assistant coach. He was named the "Girls High School Soccer Finalist Coach of the Year" by the National High School Coaches Association in 2001, 2004 & 2007. Mel's overall record as a head coach is 162-72-44.

Mel is a registered official with the North Dakota High School Activities Association and a member of the Coaches Advisory Committee representing the High School Soccer Community. He is a former member of the Bismarck Public Schools Foundation and Bismarck School Board. He is the Sports Chair representing boy's soccer for the National High School Athletic Coaches Association. He is an active soccer participant in the Bismarck community with emphasis of youth participation and an environment for learning.

Dave Cook, Bismarck Century Co-Head Coach

This is Dave Cook's 4th season as Co-Head Coach with the Patriots. In his last four seasons he has coached the Patriots to three third place finishes in 2004, 2005, and 2006, and to a state championship in 2007. Cook is a 2000 Graduate of Bismarck High School, and played 4 years of college at the University of Mary, earning All-American honors as a forward. He is currently the Director of Coaching for North Dakota Youth Soccer, and recently was named head coach with the University of Mary Men's Soccer Team. Dave holds a USSF B License and a USSF Y and an Advanced National License with NSCAA. His current record with the Patriots is 58-8-5.

**Sarah McNulty, Bismarck Century Co-Head Coach**

This is Sarah McNulty's second season as Co-Head Coach with the Patriots. She helped coach the Patriots to a 2007 state championship. McNulty is a Patriot graduate and played on the 2001 CHS State Championship team; she also played 4 years of college soccer at the University of Mary, earning All-American honors as a defender. Sarah holds a USSF C License and a USSF Y License. Her current record is 25-4-3. McNulty is a science teacher at Simle Middle School and Century HS for the last 3 years.

Tim Mueller, Bismarck St. Mary's Head Coach

Tim Mueller is in his 12th year as the St. Mary's girls soccer coach. His teams have taken 2nd four times, 3rd once, 4th once and 5th once. He was named the WDA Coach of the year on 3 different occasions and was named the North Dakota Coach of the Year in 2002. He was also nominated for National Coach of the Year in 2005 and 2006.


Tim Mueller was born and raised in Minot and graduated from Ryan High School and Minot State College.

**Cordell Sinding, Fargo North Head Coach**

Cordell Sinding is entering his 13th year as the Head Coach of the Fargo North Spartans Girls' Soccer team. Cordell has amassed a 73.7 winning percentage with an overall record of 153 wins, 46 losses, and 27 ties. Cordell won a state title in the spring of 1996 and also in the spring of 2006. He has collected four Coach of the Year awards and was a finalist for National Coach of the Year for 2006-2007. The Shanley girls' soccer team has had an improvement on their record every year since his first year in 2004. **Shea Durham, Jamestown Head Coach**



Grand Forks Central decided not to mark Bismarck Century's Christy Wentz in Saturday's girls soccer championship game. Big mistake. Huge mistake. Wentz made the Knights pay again, and again, and again for that decision, scoring all three goals as the Patriots dethroned Central 3-0 for the state title at the Jamestown Soccer Complex. ""I was surprised," Wentz said. ""I expected to be hip-to-hip (with a defender) all day. They were the first team that didn't mark me this year." It probably wouldn't have made any difference if the Knights had. Century, which became the first West Region team to win it all in the nine-year history of the tournament, made it look so easy. Cathy Peterson and Missy Leno controlled the midfield. Heather Williams (8 saves) was flawless in goal. Natalie Kirchoffner shut down Central's top gun, Jessica Rausch. Not much of anything went right for the Knights. When it threatened to, sweeper Andrea Jespersen was usually there to squelch it. From start to finish, from front to back, from sideline to sideline, the Patriots left no room for argument about which was the better team.

"Century came out wanting it -- that was really evident," Central coach Edgar Ortegon said. ""When you're the defending champs, it's a different position than when you've never had it and you're hungry." The Patriots looked famished. Wentz and Peterson each had big-time scoring chances in the first six minutes, the latter's shot smacking the crossbar. Century kept the heat on, finally breaking the scoreless tie at 17:47. Leno showed some fancy footwork, dribbling her way through the Knights' backfield. Leno then threaded a pass to Wentz, who angled a shot to the lower left corner of the net. The Patriots doubled their lead in the 32nd minute. From deep in the right corner Peterson sent a sky-high, looping cross toward the goal. Wentz was waiting for it at the left post, and headed it past Central keeper Nikki Newton. The Patriots carried the 2-0 lead into the intermission. ""We could feel them going down, kind of letting go," Wentz said. ""We knew we had to keep pushing." The Patriots did. Leno hit the crossbar from a little outside the box, just the best of Century's many second-half chances. Finally, with 17:10 remaining, they salted it away. Central back Lisa Anen fell down, clearing room for Peterson. She used it, working her way inside the box and finding Wentz. Wentz buried it, capping the last game of her high school career with her first hat trick of the season.

This was awesome," Wentz said. Despite Wentz's three goals, Ortegon did not regret his choice to not shadow her. ""You can get to the point where you're getting away from your own game," Ortegon said. ""You spend all your time chasing them around." Central had one last gasp, when Kelly Ford hit the crossbar with 5:50 to go. Way too little, way too late. First-year Century coach Matt Lawrence had only one regret: long-time head coach and current assistant Ron Klecker was at his son's wedding. He missed the Patriots' best effort of the year. ""They progressed all the way through this year right through today," Lawrence said. ""It couldn't be any more picture-perfect."

It's a good thing North Dakota's girls soccer coaches voted Bismarck Century's Christy Wentz Miss Soccer. If they didn't there would have had to be a recall on Saturday. Wentz was the driving force in the Patriots' run to a state title. Century outscored their opponents 7-1 in three tourney games, and Wentz was involved on every goal, notching four goals and three assists. She scored all three goals in the Patriots' 3-0 title-clincher against Grand Forks Central. Wentz, who finished the season with 18 goals and 10 assists, was one of three Patriots named to the all-tournament team. Joining her on the 11-player squad was keeper Heather Williams, who held Century's opponents scoreless for the final 225 minutes and 23 seconds of the tournament. Cathy Peterson, who scored a goal in Century's 2-0 semifinal win over Fargo South, was the third Patriot to make the squad. Peterson had a goal and two assists in the postseason. Century's Missy Leno was the most glaring omission from the team. Leno scored two game-winning goals, the first in dramatic fashion. Her marker with three seconds left in regulation helped Century avoid a first-round upset against Grand Forks Red River. Leno also hit several crossbars and set up the game-winner in the championship game. Other players who did make the squad were Nikki Newton, Jessica Rausch and Melanie Jensen from Grand Forks Central; Amber Clapp, Jodee Iwen and Katie Kelly from Fargo South; Kendra Lee from Jamestown; and Kristen Monroe from Red River.


