Fundamentals of Good Sportsmanship


- 1. Know, appreciate and understand the rules of the contest.

- 4. Use of obscene, profane, or abusive language or gestures, signs, posters, or banners which show disrespect for opponent's teams, officials, cheerleaders, band, or other performing groups.

- 6. Entry into the playing surface at anytime.
