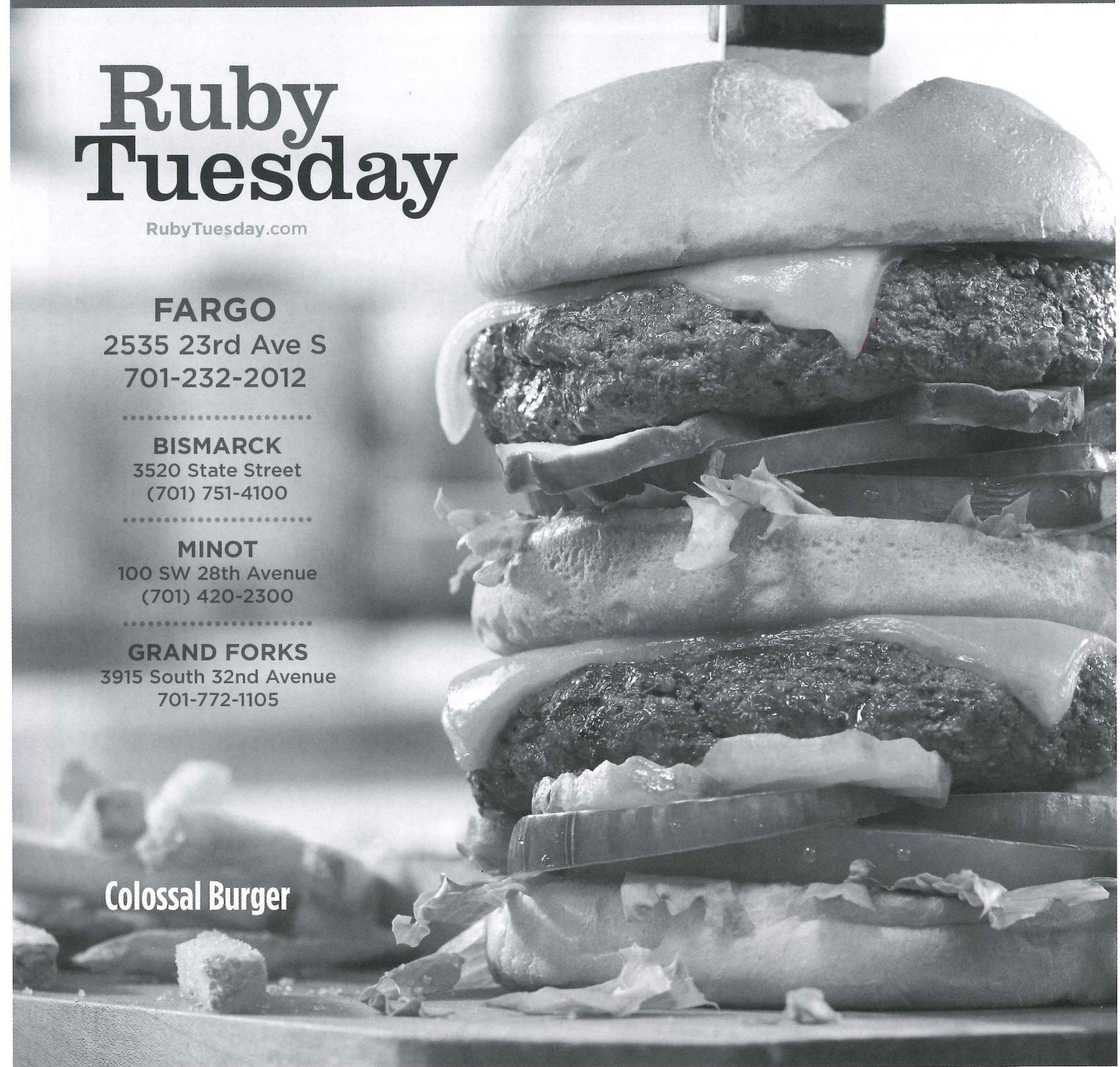

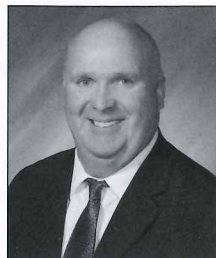

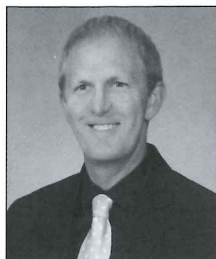

## NDHSAA TOURNAMENT CODE OF CONDUCT

Purpose: To elevate standards of Good Sportsmanship and to encourage the growth of responsible citizenship among the students, member schools, and their personnel.

### Fundamentals of Good Sportsmanship

1. Know, appreciate, and understand the rules of the contest.
2. Show respect for the officials. Good sportsmanship implies the willingness to accept and abide by the decisions of the officials.
3. Show respect for the opponent at all times. Good Sportsmanship is the Golden Rule in action.
4. Recognize and appreciate the skill of performance regardless of team affiliation.
5. Maintain self control at all times. Good sportsmanship is a responsibility of all who are involved in the game.
6. Show a positive attitude in cheering, refraining from intimidation or negative cheering. Good sportsmanship is cheering your own team "on to victory."

### Acts of Misconduct

1. Throwing of any object onto the playing floor or in the stands.
2. Behavior deemed dangerous or which interferes with the rights of others to watch the game.
3. Possessing, consuming, or being under the influence of chemicals.
4. Use of obscene, profane, or abusive language or gestures, signs, posters, or banners which show disrespect for opponent's team, officials, cheerleaders, band or other performing groups.
5. The use of noisemakers.
6. Entry onto the playing surface at any time.

THESE ACTS OF MISCONDUCT WILL NOT BE TOLERATED AND WILL RESULT IN AUTOMATIC REMOVAL WITHOUT REFUND OF ADMISSION.

## 1992 State Class A Champions - Grand Forks Red River



Perfection was attained by the 1992 Grand Forks Red River volleyball team. The Roughriders cruised to a 33-0 record and a NDHSAA Class A state championship.

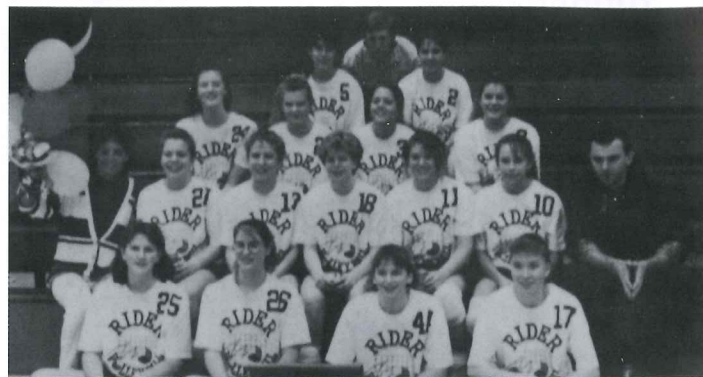
Red River defeated Wahpeton 3-0 (15-3, 16-14, 15-4) in the East Region title match and entered the 1992 state tournament looking for its first championship in program history.

The Roughriders opened state with a 3-0 (15-5, 15-5, 15-4) win over Bismarck St. Mary's in the quarterfinals. Red River punched its ticket to the championship match with a 3-1 (15-4, 15-9, 12-15, 15-4) victory over Fargo Shanley in the semifinals.

For the first time in program history the Roughriders were set to play in the state championship match. Red River's opponent was Bismarck High who had claimed a pair of 3-2 victories to advance to the final.

Red River defeated the Demons 3-0 (15-8, 15-5, 15-10) to complete the perfect season in which the Roughriders had lost only nine sets.

Jill Pollard, Amy Solseng, Kathy Wischer, and Andrea Kelly were named to the All-Tournament Team. Pollard, Wischer, Solseng and Kelly also received All-East Region and All-State honors for the Roughriders.

## 1992 State Class B Champions - Park River-Pisek



The third trip to state in program history proved to be the charm for the 1992 Park River-Pisek Aggies volleyball team. The Aggies had finished second at state in 1989 and 1990. In 1992 Park River-Pisek pushed through and won a state championship.

Just to make it to state out of Region 3 was a big obstacle for the Aggies, who needed to get past top-seeded Langdon in the region title game. The Cardinals had defeated Park River-Pisek five times during the regular season.

Park River-Pisek defeated Langdon 3-2 (12-15, 15-4, 7-15, 15-10, 15-4) in the Region 3 championship match earning the Aggies a trip to Minot for the NDHSAA Class B Volleyball State Tournament.

At state, the Aggies got started with a 3-0 sweep of Nelson County North (Lakota) in the quarterfinals and followed up with a 3-1 victory over Central Cass in the semifinals.

The Aggies were once again one win away from a state title. Park River-Pisek would be matched up against an undefeated Kenmare squad in the title match. To compete against the Honkers and win its first state title, the Aggies needed to play a "fired up" brand of volleyball.

Park River-Pisek hit the court with intensity and defeated Kenmare 3-0 (15-2, 15-5, 15-5) to finish its break-through season 26-6.
