NDHSAA MINIMAL BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS FOR REGULAR AND POSTSEASON COMPETITIONS:

- Respect the American flag and the National Anthem.
- Contesting schools shall each have an authorized faculty representative present who shall be responsible for his/her school's participants, students, and fans throughout the contest.
- Spectators must wear clothing that covers the entire torso. Those who do not comply or who wear clothing that is vulgar, obscene or that in some other way inappropriate, as determined by school/tournament personnel, will be removed from the facility if they do not cooperate with this behavior expectation.
- The use of appropriate language is expected at all times. Profanity, negative chants, trash talk, name-calling, personal attacks or other acts of disrespect are unacceptable and must be immediately addressed by school/tournament administrators.
- Any attendee ejected from a NDHSAA tournament venue will be banned from the venue(s) for the remainder of the event.
- Respect the game/contest. Under no condition shall anyone other than the members of the official squad enter the playing surface. No one may interfere with the contest in any way.
- Hand held signs and flags, which do not obstruct the view of others, are permitted provided they are in good taste. Signs or other similar items contest/tournament officials deem to be in poor taste will be removed. Message or "white" boards are prohibited. The carrying of flags around the playing surface is NOT allowed.
- Artificial noisemakers of any kind (i.e. megaphones, cowbells, sirens, whistles, thunder sticks, and other similar items) are not allowed at any indoor events, including outdoor sports played at indoor venues. Exception – Megaphones appropriately used by cheerleaders are permitted if allowed by contest officials.
- Laser lights or any other lights deemed distracting to participants are strictly prohibited.
- Confetti is banned at all NDHSAA tournament venues. Tournament staff is instructed to confiscate such articles at the door.
- Objects shall not be thrown into the stands at any NDHSAA tournament venue.
- The use of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAV), also known as drones, is prohibited for any persons at NDHSAA tournament venues.

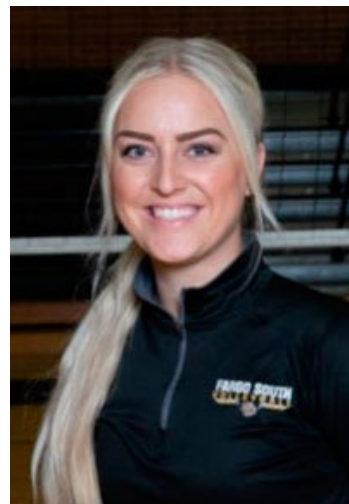

1997 CLASS A VOLLEYBALL STATE CHAMPIONS FARGO SOUTH BRUINS

The 1997 NDHSAA Class A Volleyball State Tournament field was made up of Fargo South, Bismarck Century, Mandan, Devils Lake, Grand Forks Red River, Minot High, Wahpeton and Bismarck High.

Fargo South held the East Region's No. 1 seed entering state in Minot after defeating Wahpeton 15-3, 15-4, 16-14 in the East Region Tournament Championship Match. The Bruins would meet West Region No. 4-seed Bismarck Century in the state quarterfinals. The Patriots pushed the Bruins to the limit forcing a fifth set, but South emerged with the 15-17, 15-3, 15-5, 8-15, 15-7 victory.

After the tight quarterfinals match, there would be no more thrillers at state for the Bruins who would sweep the next two matches on their way to the program's second NDHSAA Class A Volleyball state championship.

The Bruins defeated Mandan 15-2, 15-0, 15-2 in the semifinals to secure a championships meeting with Wahpeton – a rematch of the East Region Volleyball Tournament championship match a week prior. South edged the Huskies once again 15-8, 15-2, 15-6.

South senior co-captain Jessica Schumacher led the Bruins with 56 kills during the state tournament. Schumacher won Gatorade Player of the Year honors following the state tournament and was one of three Bruins to be named to the North Dakota High School Coaches Association's Class A Volleyball All-State Team. The other Bruins to be named to the NDHSCA All-State team were senior setter Meredith Anderson and senior outside hitter Erin Hardy. Schumacher, Anderson, Hardy and Kylene Gowan were also named to All-Eastern Dakota Conference Team.

South finished the 1996-97 season with a 30-3 record under first-year head coach Kristin Gorder.

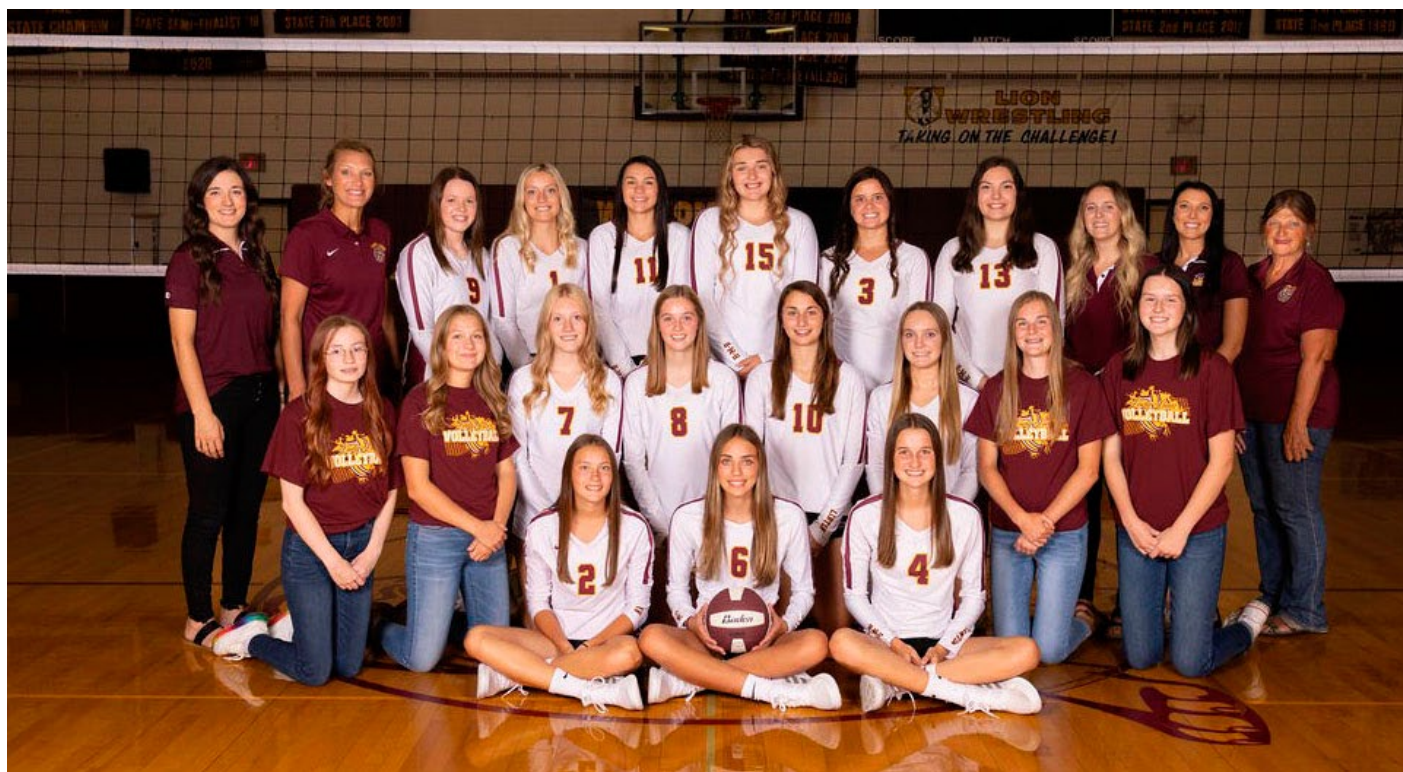

1997 CLASS B VOLLEYBALL STATE CHAMPIONS THOMPSON TOMMIES

The Thompson volleyball team achieved the ultimate goal by winning the 1997 NDHSAA Class B state championship – the program's first ever state title.

The Tommies' season began with a win over Larimore and a first-place finish at their own regular season tournament hosted in Thompson. Undeclared entering the Des Lacs-Burlington Tournament, Thompson split with Stanley and lost two sets to Park River. A week later, Thompson split with Larimore and Griggs County Central in pool play at the Red River Valley Conference Tournament and went on to defeat Larimore in the championship match.

Thompson won the remainder of its regular season matches and entered the Region Tournament as the No. 1 seed from the East Sub-Region.

The Tommies opened the Region III Tournament by defeating May-Port-CG 3-0 in the quarterfinals and followed up with a 3-0 win over Dakota Prairie in the semifinals. A gritty defensive-minded Central Valley squad awaited Thompson in the Region III championship match. The Tommies would outlast the Valiants 3-2 (15-2, 9-15, 9-15, 15-7, 15-9) to qualify for the state tournament for the fourth time in program history.

At state, Thompson started with a 3-0 (15-7, 15-9, 15-11) win over Stanley in the quarterfinals. In the semifinals, Thompson squared off against Central Cass. Strong hitting and a 95 percent serving percentage helped the Tommies to a 3-1 (15-13, 15-10, 13-15, 15-4) win over the Squirrels putting Thompson back in the Class B state championship match for the second consecutive year.

Thompson met an experienced Park River team in the championship. This time, the Tommies played aggressively, blocking the Aggies at the net disrupting their attacks 53 times, frustrating the Aggies and putting them on defense. Meanwhile, the Thompson hitters pounded the ball with confidence and even tied two previously set state records.

Jessie Miller tied the record for the most kills in a match and Kayla Kollin tied the record for the most assists. Playing their best volleyball of the season, the Tommies put it all together to win the championship match 3-1 (15-9, 15-11, 12-15, and 16-14).

Named to the All-Tournament Team at state were Kayla Kollin and Jessie Miller. Mandy Olson was named to the NDHSCA Class B All-State Team.

The Tommies finished the 1996-97 season with a record of 31 wins, one loss, and three tournament ties under head coach Lisa Strand. It was an incredible year celebrated with a multitude of fans, the school band, and family members that experienced the thrill of the ultimate victory – a state championship!

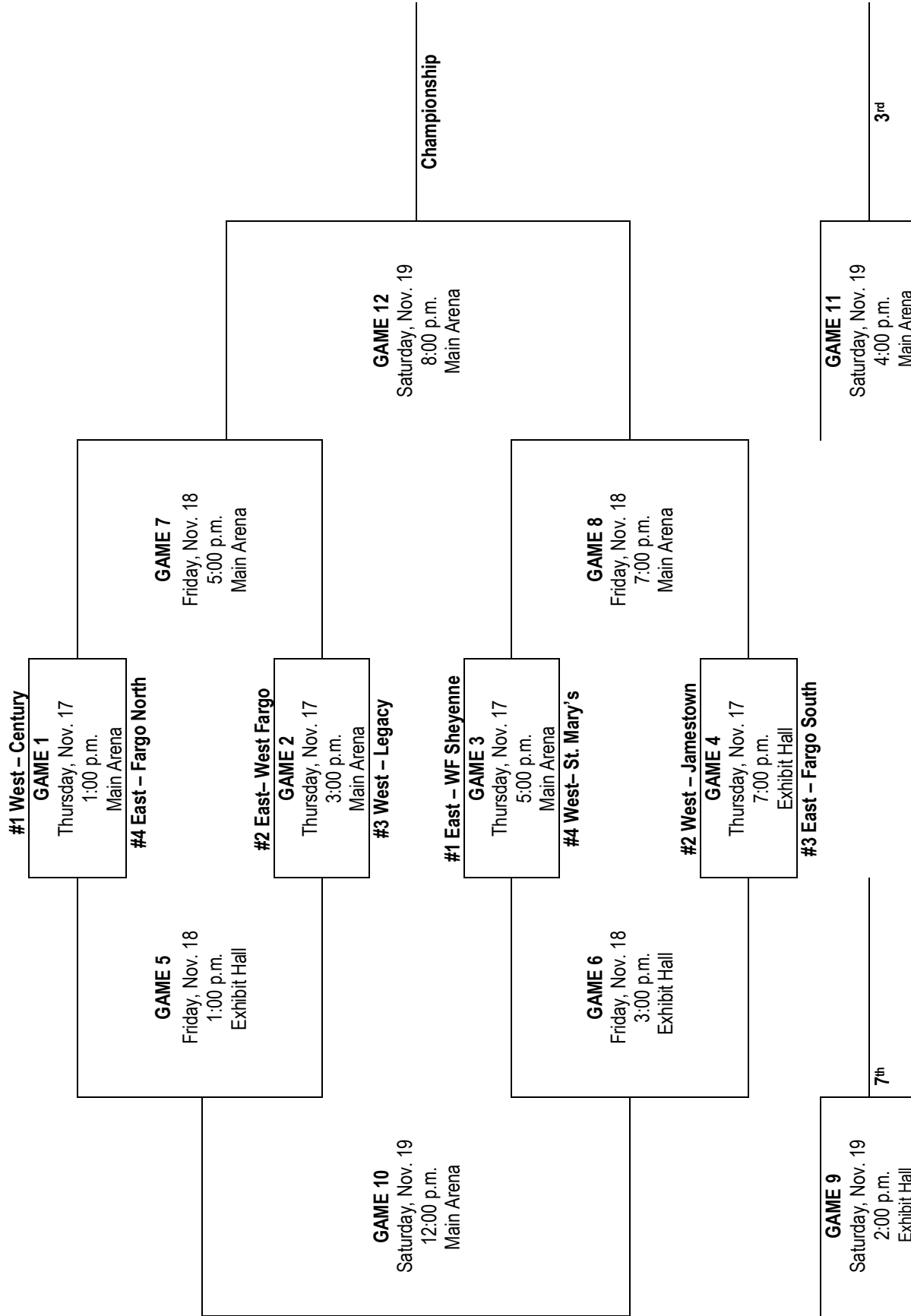
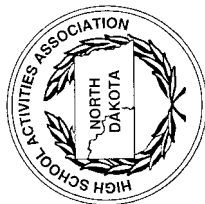

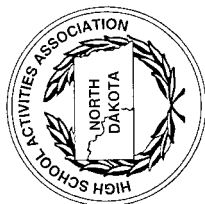
