## Behavior Expectations for Regular & Postseason Competitions

- Respect the American flag and the National Anthem.
- Contesting schools shall each have an authorized faculty representative present who shall be responsible for his/her school's participants, students, and fans throughout the contest.
- Spectators must wear clothing that covers the entire torso. Those who do not comply or who wear clothing that is vulgar, obscene or that in some other way inappropriate, as determined by school/tournament personnel, will be removed from the facility if they do not cooperate with this behavior expectation.
- The use of appropriate language is expected at all times. Profanity, negative chants, trash talk, name-calling, personal attacks or other acts of disrespect are unacceptable and must be immediately addressed by school/tournament administrators. Any discriminatory slur will result in immediate removal from the facility.
- Any attendee ejected from a NDHSAA tournament venue will be banned from the venue(s) for the remainder of the event.
- Respect the game/contest. Under no condition shall anyone other than the members of the official squad enter the playing surface. No one may interfere with the contest in any way.
- Handheld signs and flags, which do not obstruct the view of others, are permitted provided they are in good taste. Signs or other similar items contest/tournament officials deem to be in poor taste will be removed. Message or "white" boards are prohibited. The carrying of flags around the playing surface is NOT allowed.
- Artificial noisemakers of any kind (i.e. megaphones, cowbells, sirens, whistles, thunder sticks, and other similar items) are not allowed at any indoor events, including outdoor sports played at indoor venues. Exception – Megaphones appropriately used by cheerleaders are permitted if allowed by contest officials.
- Laser lights or any other lights deemed distracting to participants are strictly prohibited.
- Confetti is banned at all NDHSAA tournament venues. Tournament staff are instructed to confiscate such articles at the door.
- Objects shall not be thrown into the stands at any NDHSAA tournament venue.
- The use of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAV), also known as drones, is prohibited for any persons at NDHSAA tournament venues.

The 1998 NDHSAA Class A Volleyball State Tournament field was made up of Grand Forks Red River, Mandan, Fargo South, Minot High, Fargo Shanley, Bismarck Century, Fargo North and Bismarck St. Mary's.

The eventual state champion, Grand Forks Red River held the East Region's No. 2 seed entering the State Tournament in Fargo after losing to Fargo North 17-15, 15-11, 14-16, 15-9 in the East Region Tournament Championship Match. The Roughriders would meet West Region No. 3-seed Minot High in the state quarterfinals. Red River swept Minot High 15-5, 15-10, 15-5 to grab some early momentum at the state tournament.

The Roughriders would meet defending state champion Fargo South in the semifinals and that meeting proved to be a five-set thriller as the Bruins would battle back after being down two sets in the match. Red River emerged the victor 15-9, 15-13, 13-15, 13-15, 15-9 and would return to the state championship match for the first time since 1993.

After a tight match in the semifinals, Red River would meet Fargo North in the state final – a rematch of the East Region Tournament championship match a week prior.

This time against the Spartans, Red River wouldn't fall short. Instead the Roughriders would score a sweep defeating Fargo North 15-13, 15-13, 15-10 to win the program's third state championship.

Heidi Kvistad and Annie Leake were named to the Class A Volleyball All-Tournament team following the state championship match.

Kvistad, Kelly Newman, and Tera Bahl were All-Eastern Dakota Conference Team selections for the Roughriders.

Kvistad and Newman were named to the NDHSCA Class A Volleyball All-State squad and Newman was named Co-NDHSCA Class A Volleyball Senior Athlete of the Year.

Red River head coach Carolyn Foster was named East Region and Class A Volleyball Coach of the Year.

Red River finished the 1997-98 season with 28-5 record.

## CLASS B REUNION TEAM

## 1998 THOMPSON TOMMIES

The 1998 NDHSAA Class B Volleyball State Tournament field was made up of Thompson, Ray, Wishek, Bottineau, Central Cass, Dickinson Trinity, Kenmare and Park River.

Thompson – defending Class B state champions – graduated one senior from its 1997 squad leaving the Thompson coaching staff to feel very optimistic about the Tommies' prospects if the team committed to working hard and challenge themselves.

The 1998 season began with success at the Central Cass Tournament finishing second only to Class A team, West Fargo High.

The Tommies continued to enjoy success at the Park River Tournament while being coached by assistant Brian Kollin while head coach Lisa Strand had to leave early to give birth to a daughter. The Tommies went on to capture first place by defeating the Langdon Cardinals.

Thompson also placed first in the Des Lacs-Burlington Tournament by defeating Kenmare.

Thompson finished first in the Red River Valley Conference, first in the District Tournament and first in the Region Tournament by defeating a solid Central Valley team in three sets.

At the State Tournament, the Tommies matched up in the quarterfinals with a strong Bottineau team coming out ahead (15-6, 15-12, 15-8).

In the Semifinals, the Tommies faced the Ray Jays winning in three sets (15-9, 15-6, 15-7)

Thompson would meet Kenmare in the state championship match – a rematch of the Des Lacs-Burlington Tournament final earlier in the regular season.

Kenmare took the first set winning 15-7, but the Tommies found the floor in the next three sets with Jessie Miller and Janelle Burley leading the way in the middle at the net with a combined 41 Kills while Kayla Kollin dished out a state record of 43 assists.

The Tommies won the state championship match (7-15, 15-10, 15-8 and 15-8) completing the back-to-back run of state titles (1997 and 1998).

Thompson finished the 1997-98 season with 38-1-1.

Three members of the team were selected to the State All-Tournament team (Janelle Burley, Jessie Miller and Kayla Kollin).

Miller was also named the 1998 NDHSCA Class B Senior Athlete of the Year. Kollin and Miller were named to the NDHSCA Class B All-State Team.

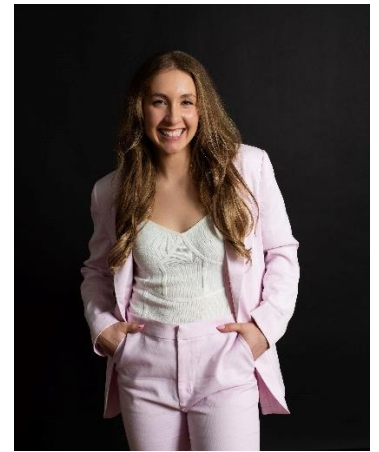

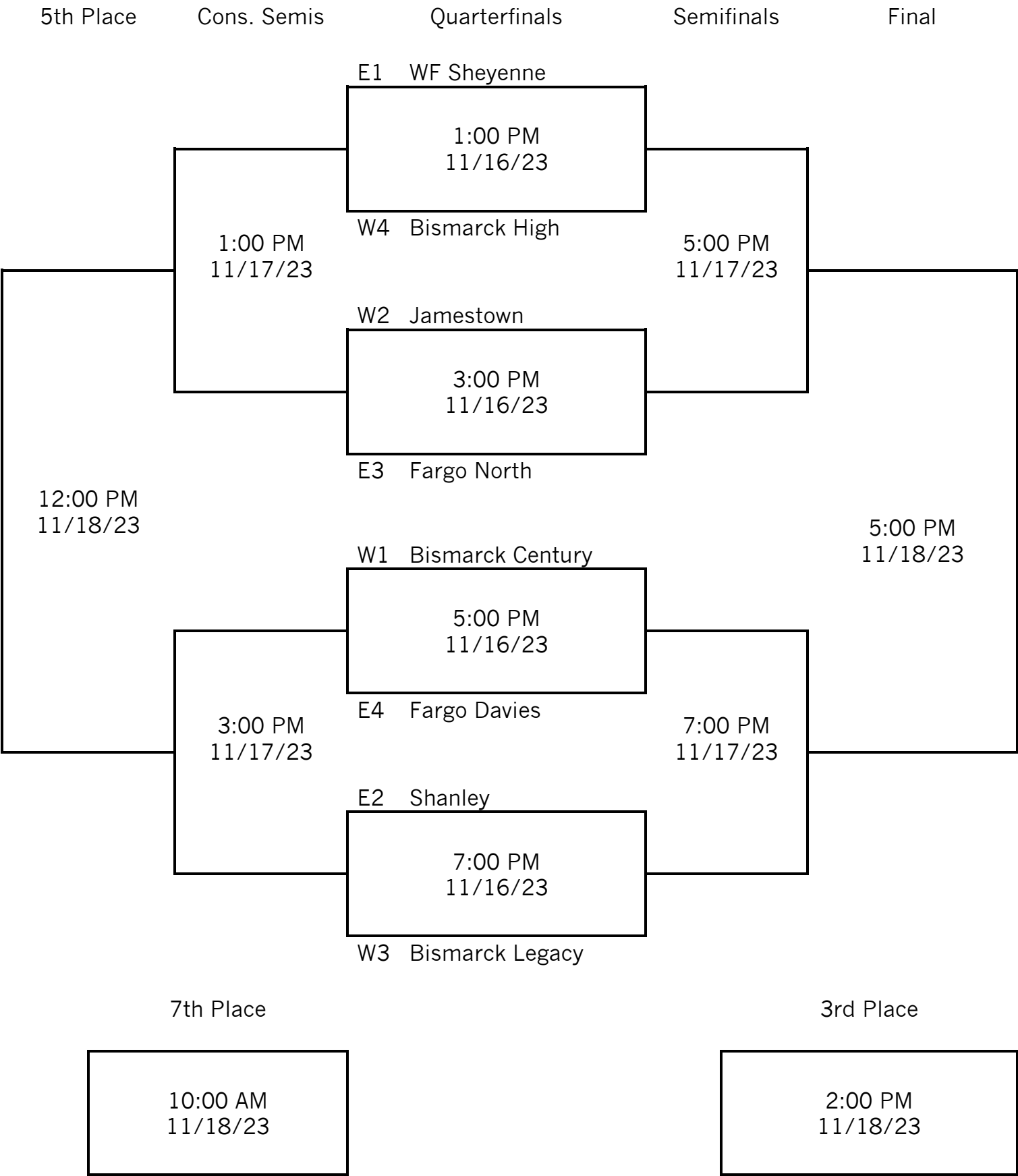

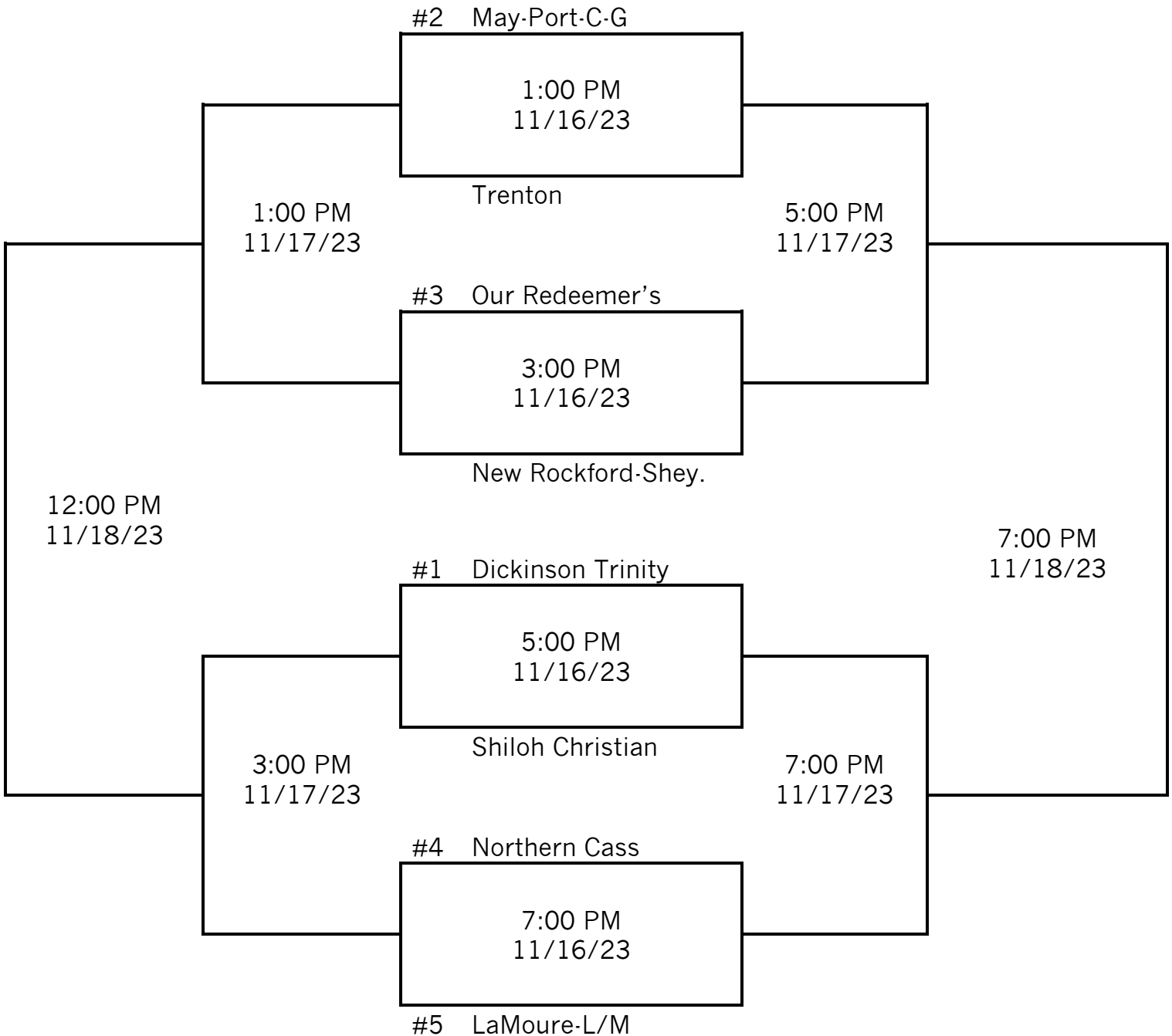
