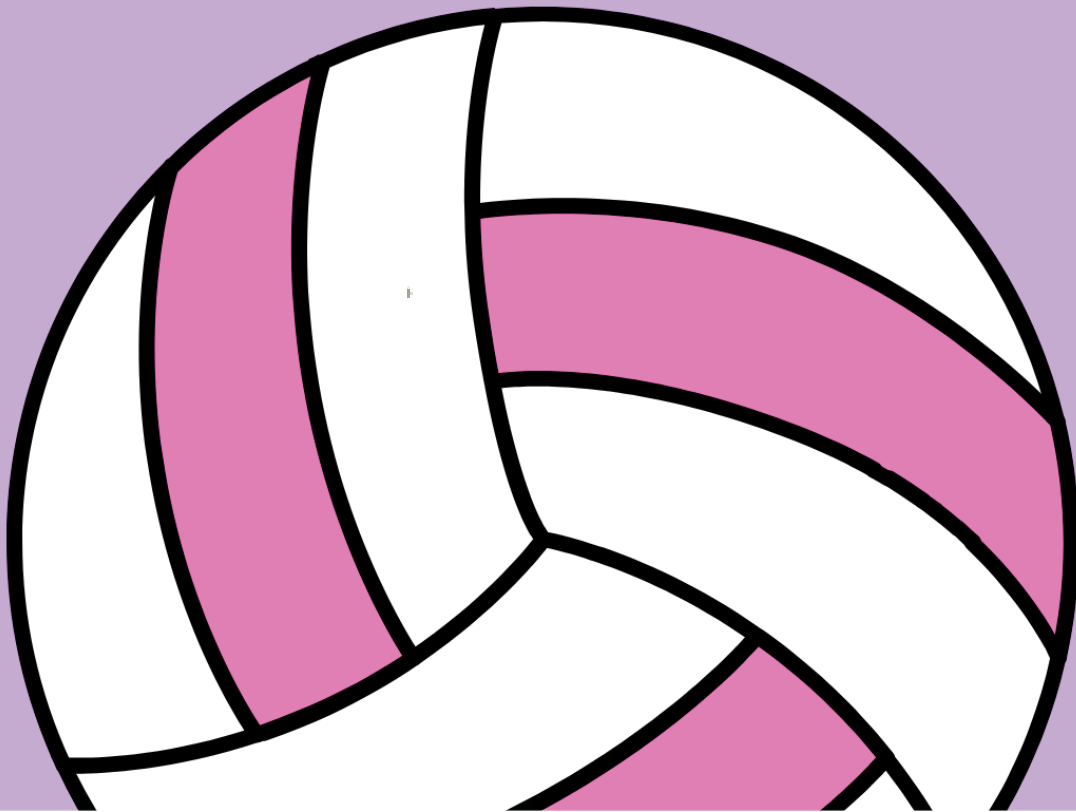

2000 CLASS A VOLLEYBALL STATE CHAMPIONS FARGO NORTH SPARTANS

Few teams in North Dakota high school sports have been as dominant as the 2000 Fargo North Spartans volleyball team.

The 2000 Spartans, coached by Kara Meier, were senior-laden and out to prove it could win a state title after finishing as Class A runners up in 1998 and 1999.

North proved its championship pedigree quite convincingly. In fact, the Spartans executed one of the finest prep volleyball seasons in state history going undefeated 35-0. Even more impressive is the fact that in those 35 matches, the Spartans only dropped two sets out of 92 total played.

The 2000 NDHSAA Class A Volleyball State Tournament was played at the Fargo Civic Center. The state tournament field included Fargo North, Grand Forks Red River, Devils Lake, West Fargo High, Bismarck High, Minot High, Mandan, and Williston.

Coming into state, North was 32-0 and had won 81 straight sets. The Spartans would extend that streak to 84 straight sets with a 3-0 sweep of Mandan (15-1, 15-6, 15-9).

Next up was a meeting with West Fargo High. In the semifinals, the Packers would hand the Spartans their first set loss of the season with the second set of the match to knot the semifinal 1-1 before North regained the momentum and closed it out winning the final two sets and ultimately match 3-1 (15-9, 10-15, 15-8, 15-9).

For the third straight year the Spartans found themselves in the Class A state title match and for the third consecutive year their opponents would be Grand Forks Red River.

North would not be denied a third time in the championship match. Although the Spartans would drop another set, North edged the Roughriders 3-1 (15-5, 15-8, 9-15, 15-4) in the title match. The Spartans' seven seniors Sara Larson, Kristina Vick, Erin Oberholtzer, Lucy Getz, Kim Hehn, Kari Hoss and Johanna Holtan walked out to the middle of the Fargo Civic Center as one to accept the state championship trophy – North's fifth in program history.

North's senior core powered the team all season with great defense and precision offense. In the state title match, Oberholtzer, Hehn and Larson all registered double figures in digs on defense. Holtan led the way on offense with 16 kills followed by Hoss (12 kills) and Larson (11 kills).



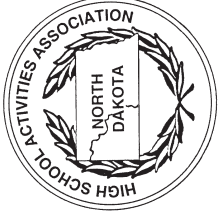

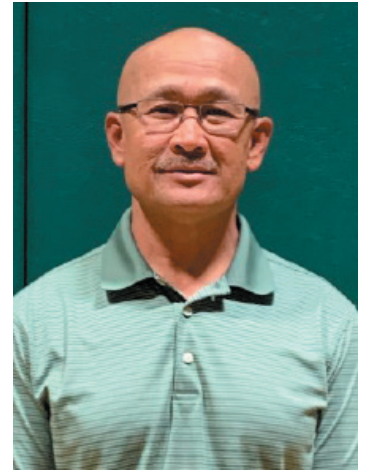

Steven started his officiating career the year after he moved back to Ashley, North Dakota after serving seven years in the United States Marine Corps.

Over the course of his career, Steven has worked four North Dakota High School Activities Association (NDHSAA) state tournaments, 35 district tournaments, 34 regional tournaments and 525 regular season matches and countless weekend tournaments.

Steven received the National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS) Outstanding Official Award in 1991 and was a Volleyball Workshop Supervisor for the NDHSAA for 12 years.

Steven served as a mentor to new officials, helping to develop the next generation of referees across the state.

NDHSAA MINIMAL BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS FOR REGULAR AND POSTSEASON COMPETITIONS:

- Respect the American flag and the National Anthem.
- Contesting schools shall each have an authorized faculty representative present who shall be responsible for his/her school's participants, students, and fans throughout the contest.
- Spectators must wear clothing that covers the entire torso. Those who do not comply or who wear clothing that is vulgar, obscene or that in some other way inappropriate, as determined by school/tournament personnel, will be removed from the facility if they do not cooperate with this behavior expectation.
- The use of appropriate language is expected at all times. Profanity, negative chants, trash talk, name-calling, personal attacks or other acts of disrespect are unacceptable and must be immediately addressed by school/tournament administrators.
- Any attendee ejected from a NDHSAA tournament venue will be banned from the venue(s) for the remainder of the event.
- Respect the game/contest. Under no condition shall anyone other than the members of the official squad enter the playing surface. No one may interfere with the contest in any way.
- Hand held signs and flags, which do not obstruct the view of others, are permitted provided they are in good taste. Signs or other similar items contest/tournament officials deem to be in poor taste will be removed. Message or "white" boards are prohibited. The carrying of flags around the playing surface is NOT allowed.
- Artificial noisemakers of any kind (i.e. megaphones, cowbells, sirens, whistles, thunder sticks, and other similar items) are not allowed at any indoor events, including outdoor sports played at indoor venues. Exception – Megaphones appropriately used by cheerleaders are permitted if allowed by contest officials.
- Laser lights or any other lights deemed distracting to participants are strictly prohibited.
- Confetti is banned at all NDHSAA tournament venues. Tournament staff is instructed to confiscate such articles at the door.
- Objects shall not be thrown into the stands at any NDHSAA tournament venue.
- The use of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAV), also known as drones, is prohibited for any persons at NDHSAA tournament venues.

2000 Class B Volleyball State Champions Hillsboro Burros

Hillsboro defeated Richland 15-11, 6-15, 15-13, 15-13 in the Region 2 Tournament championship match to clinch the program's second ever appearance at an NDHSAA Class B Volleyball Tournament.

The Burros previous trip to state was in 1993 – a season in which they would make the semifinals before finishing fourth. Hillsboro, coached by Scott Toenies, would be looking to advance further at the 2000 state tournament played at the Fargo Civic Center.

Joining Hillsboro at the 2000 NDHSAA Class B Volleyball State Tournament were Oakes, defending state champion May-Port-CG, Langdon, Leeds, Kenmare, Ray and Hazen.

Hillsboro's quarterfinals opponent would be Kenmare. The Burros swept the Honkers 3-0 (17-15, 15-13, 15-1). Awaiting the Burros in the semifinals were the Patriots of May-Port-CG. The two squads had met twice during the regular season – once at a regular season tournament and later in late-season match before District Tournament play in which the Burros scored a 3-0 sweep.

The meeting in the semifinals went the distance with Hillsboro rallying from a 2-set deficit to score the 3-2 victory by set scores of 13-15, 13-15, 15-12, 16-14, 15-9.

Following the five-set thriller, Hillsboro would play Hazen in the championship match, but leading up to the team's biggest match of the season the availability of one of its top players was in doubt. Senior outside hitter Kinsey Coles twisted her ankle in a post-match celebration against May-Port-CG and in the hours leading up to the championship match how effective she'd be as an offensive threat would remain a mystery until Coles and the Burros could step on the court.

The tender ankle ended up not being a major issue as Coles finished the championship match with a team-high 15 kills. Senior middle hitter Sally Ludwig added 11 kills, senior setter Rose Cotton pitched in 15 assists, and senior setter Kayla Thorson collected 15 assists and eight digs to help the Burros score a 3-0 sweep of Hazen (15-10, 15-3, 15-11).

An ace serve by Ludwig sealed the Burros first ever volleyball state title.

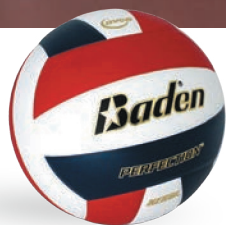
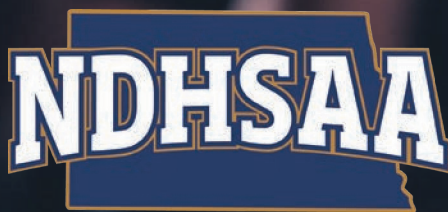
