

## School Payments

- I. The School Payment Plan is based on revenue sharing points that a school receives for participating in a regional or state event for which team payments have been approved to be paid. The following chart indicates the number of participants to be paid for each approved event.

- A. Where maximum is indicated, the actual # up to the maximum of participants is paid.
- B. For Class A Region Basketball, after all expenses are paid, any profits excluding sponsorship, media and merchandise income will be divided equally between the Association and all participating schools. Play-in games are considered one day tournaments and are not considered in income sharing.

#### B. Plan Specifics (Approved by the Board of Directors, June 2005)

1. Following each region or state NDHSAA sponsored event, the number of participants from each participating school will be determined.
2. One-way mileage will be used in the formula and will be determined by using MapQuest.
3. The NDHSAA Board of Directors will determine the desired Reserve Balance.
4. After all revenue is received, expenses paid and reserve maintained, the remaining funds will be distributed to qualifying schools.
  - a. Remaining funds will be divided by the total accumulated points throughout the state to determine the value per point
  - b. The value per point times the individual school total will determine the school's payment for the year
  - c. Payments will be made to schools prior to June 30<sup>th</sup>.
  - d. Member school payments for \$24.99 or less will be not distributed. (June 2021)
